OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 23

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

BRENT LAWSON • OF, SO. • LAGUNA NIGUEL, CA • SE MISSOURI

Lawson batted .421 (8-for-19) last week, recording team-highs of six runs and eight RBI while helping Southeast Missouri to a 3-2 mark, including an OVC series sweep of Tennessee-Martin. Six of the sophomore outfielder's eight hits went for extra bases as he collected four doubles and two home runs for a .947 slugging percentage. A native of Laguna Niguel, Calif., Lawson racked up 18 total bases and recorded a .400 on-base percentage while extending his hit streak to a season-high nine games.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

DONOVAN HAND • RHP, FR. • HATTON, AL • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Hand picks up his second OVC Pitcher of the Week award after helping deal Austin Peay its first shutout of the season in a 2-0 victory in the series finale. A native of Hatton, Ala., Hand allowed only one extra-base hit among six hits through 8.1 innings, striking out two batters and walking one. The Governors, who entered the game hitting .318 as a team, managed just a .214 effort against the freshman righthander.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (35-21, 16-11 OVC): Austin Peay saw its chance for a third straight OVC regular-season title disappear as the Governors lost all three games of their final Conference series to Jacksonville State, leaving them with a second-place finish. APSU also dropped a midweek contest at Western Kentucky...The Govs' five-game losing streak is the longest entering any of their 17 OVC tournament appearances...Jax State's sweep ended Austin Peay's run of six consecutive series victories in league play. The Govs went 0-3 in their Conference-opening series at Morehead State, then proceeded to win 16 of their next 21 OVC games before going winless at JSU to close out the season...Saturday's 2-0 loss to the Gamecocks in the series finale marked the first time in over a year APSU had been shut out in a contest, ending a streak of 67 games with at least one run that dated back to May 7, 2004...Senior SS **Jared Walker** currently leads the team in batting (.374) and RBI (51)...Junior **Rowdy Hardy** tops the league in wins (10), ERA (2.12), innings pitched (110.1) and shutouts (2) while tying for the OVC lead in complete games (7)...As the No. 2 seed, Austin Peay has a first-round bye for the 2005 O'Reilly OVC Tournament and will play at 2:30 p.m. on Thursday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (17-39, 14-13 OVC): Eastern Illinois closed out the 2005 campaign on a winning note, taking two of three from OVC opponent Tennessee Tech to finish in seventh place at 14-13 (17-39 overall)...Senior hurlers **Kyle Widegren** (5 inn.) and **Ted Juske** (4 inn.) did not walk a batter while combining for a two-hit shutout in Saturday's 7-0 series finale win versus Tech. Juske also threw three scoreless frames in an 8-0 loss to Bradley earlier in the week...Sophomore 3B **Ryan Campbell** carries a 14-game hitting streak into next season after going 7-for-18 (.389) over the four-game stretch with three doubles, two homers, five RBI and five runs...Sophomore OF **Eric Huber** led the Panthers with 13 stolen bases and a .322 batting average this season, while sophomore C **Jason Cobb** belted 12 homers and drove in 42 runs, both team-highs...Head Coach **Jim Schmitz** picked up his 299th career win at EIU, tying former Panther skipper Tom McDevitt for the school record...The Panthers, who won seven of their last nine OVC contests to close out the year, are slated to return their entire starting lineup for the 2006 campaign.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (23-29, 14-12 OVC): Eastern Kentucky took two of three from Morehead State to close out regular-season play with a sixth-place OVC finish. The Colonels also dropped an 8-4 non-conference decision to Cincinnati on Tuesday...Junior OF **Brett Bolger** went 6-for-9 in the series with the Eagles and hit .538 for the week to raise his league-leading average to .421. He also tops the Conference with a .491 on-base percentage...Sophomore RHP **McKenzie Willoughby** (7-3) improved to 6-1 in OVC action, picking up the win against the Eagles in the series opener while holding the league's top-scoring offense to three runs through seven innings...Four EKV players rank among the league's Top 10 in stolen bases, including Bolger and senior OF **Derrick Bussell**, who each went 5-for-6 on the basepaths last week. Bussell leads the Conference with 30 thefts...Three Colonels have registered at least 20 multi-hit outings this season, including senior OF **Bryan Stevenson**, who tops the league with 25 overall. Stevenson was credited with two RBI in the Cincinnati contest, but saw his career-high 18-game hit streak end with an 0-for-4 day at the plate...Sixth-seeded EKV and No. 3 Morehead State meet again Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. in the first round of OVC tournament play.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (32-23, 19-8 OVC): Jacksonville State staged a three-game sweep of Austin Peay to capture its first OVC regular-season baseball title. The Gamecocks also picked up a 10-9 victory over No. 27 Troy, marking JSU's first win over a ranked opponent this season...Freshman OF **Brian Piazza** hit .471 (8-for-17) for the week, scoring the winning run against Troy, and driving in the winning run in game two of the APSU series...The Gamecocks have won 11 games in their final at-bat this season...Freshman RHP **Donovan Hand** (9-3) helped deal APSU its first shutout of the season, scattering six hits over 8.1 innings while holding the Govs to a .214 batting average. He ranks second in the league in ERA (2.92) and wins (9) and third in opponent batting average (.248)...JSU is 11-0 this season when scoring in double figures...Three Gamecocks are enjoying double-digit hit streaks. Sophomore SS **Jake Ball** is riding a team season-best 17-game streak, while Piazza has posted 12 straight games with a hit and junior OF **Jason Horn** has a 10-game run...The top-seeded Gamecocks are one of the league's hottest teams entering postseason play, having won 15 of their last 20 games, including six straight. As the No. 1 seed, JSU has earned a first-round bye and will play Thursday at 6:30 p.m.

MOREHEAD STATE (28-26, 15-11 OVC): Morehead State closed out the 2005 regular-season with a third-place OVC finish after winning one of three at Eastern Kentucky over the weekend...The Eagles, a preseason pick to finish 10th, jumped out to an 10-1 start in Conference play and had the inside track on the regular-season title before hitting a bumpy stretch over the last two weeks, losing five of their final six league tilts...Senior CF **Kevin Bryant** batted .692 (9-for-13) and posted a .714 on-base percentage last week after moving up to the No. 2 spot in the lineup...Senior 2B **Lance Seabor** is wreaking havoc on the school's record book. He has already set a new record for most at-bats in a season (219) while also tying the mark for most runs scored in a career (163). In addition, he has 82 hits this year, one shy of the school record...Senior 1B **Bryan Ingram** had to leave the series finale against EKV on Saturday after suffering a strained knee during an at-bat. He has belted an OVC-best 16 homers this season and also tops the league with 62 RBI and a .695 slugging percentage...The third-seeded Eagles are set for a rematch with No. 6 EKV in first-round tourney action at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday.

2005 OVC Baseball Notes

MURRAY STATE (27-29, 15-12 OVC): Murray State took two of three from Samford in the final weekend of regular-season play to finish tied with Southeast Missouri for fourth place in the OVC standings. The Thoroughbreds won their in-season series with Southeast, giving Murray State the tiebreaker and the No. 4 seed for the OVC tourney. Earlier in the week, the 'Breds dropped an 8-1 decision at Kentucky...Senior 1B **Clint Griggs** helped the team's offensive efforts, going 6-for-10 with a run and three RBI in four outings. He and sophomore 2B **Seth Hudson** each enter the postseason riding 11-game hit streaks... Junior RHP **Billy Fares** threw just 87 pitches, allowing one run on five hits, en route to chalking up his fifth complete game of the season in Saturday's twinbill-opening victory at Samford...Sophomore CF **Tyler Pittman** went 2-for-3 in two games at Samford with a home run, four walks and four RBI for a 1.667 slugging percentage and an on-base effort of .750...Senior C **Dustin Hennigar**, hitless in his previous 24 at-bats, ended the drought in dramatic fashion, hitting a two-run homer on Friday to win the series opener at Samford...The last time Murray State entered the OVC tourney as the fourth seed was 2003, when the 'Breds came home with the tournament crown...Murray State and Southeast Missouri square off in first-round action at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday.

SAMFORD (20-36, 13-14 OVC): Samford closed out the 2005 campaign on a winning note as freshman pinch-hitter **Drew Reagan** hit a three-run, walkoff homer to lift his team to a 4-2 victory over Murray State in the series finale... The Bulldogs end the season with a 13-14 OVC record (20-36 overall) and eighth-place finish in the Conference standings...Sophomore SS **Parker Gargis** went 4-for-6 in two games against the 'Breds, posting a 1.167 slugging percentage with a .667 on-base average...Senior RHP **Michael Neimkin** gave up two hits while tossing three shutout innings in two appearances during the series, picking up the Bulldogs' lone win in the nightcap of Saturday's doubleheader...Gargis and junior OF **Matt Alling** take hitting streaks of nine and seven games, respectively, into next season...Freshman OF **Bear Burnett** had a solid rookie campaign, batting a team-high .331 while collecting 27 runs, 23 RBI and 10 doubles. He also topped the squad with 18 multi-hit outings.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (24-30, 15-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri finished tied for fourth after sweeping its final OVC series with UT Martin. Earlier in the week, the Redhawks dropped a two-game series at SMS...Sophomore OF **Brent Lawson** extended his hit streak to nine games with a .421 effort at the plate. Six of his eight raps went for extra bases as he recorded team-highs of six runs and eight RBI...Freshman RHP **Joey Evans** worked all nine innings of the series opener versus UT Martin en route to his eighth victory and fifth complete game of the season, both team-highs...Southeast is another one of the league's hottest squads entering the postseason, having won eight of its last nine Conference games, including seven straight...After nursing a sore hamstring the last couple of weeks, senior SS **Ernie Bracamonte** returned to the lineup full-time and batted .545 last week...Senior 3B **Eric Horstman** pushed his hit streak to a career-high 24 games, matching the league's best run this season. He also boasts the nation's longest active streak of reaching base safely, currently at 46 games... Junior RHP **Jamie McAlister** tallied his third-straight complete game and second straight win in only his fifth start in game two of the UT Martin series...The fifth-seeded Redhawks lost the tiebreaker to Murray State and will play the No. 4 'Breds in first-round tourney action at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (12-43, 6-20 OVC): UT Martin closed out its 2005 season with an 0-5 week that included two losses at Mississippi State and a three-game OVC slide at Southeast Missouri. The Skyhawks finished the year tied for 10th in the league standings with a 6-20 mark. UT Martin's 12-43 overall record represents the team's fewest wins and most losses since an 8-46 effort in 2001...Saturday's 4-3 loss to Southeast marked the Skyhawks' 13th one-run decision of the season as they finished with a 7-6 record in those games... Freshman OF **Blake Turner** takes a nine-game hit streak into the 2006 campaign after batting .476 for the week, collecting three doubles and 13 total bases during the five-game span. He was the only Skyhawk player to hit better than .300 in 2005, wrapping up with a .304 average... Senior **Nick Bruner** ended his career in fine fashion, hitting safely in his final 14 games and posting a .412 batting average with four RBI over the last five outings. He registered 205 at-bats in 2005, third-best on the school's single-season list...Head coach **Bubba Cates**, who sits two wins shy of his 100th career victory, returns the bulk of his young squad in 2006, losing just four players to graduation.

TENNESSEE TECH (13-42, 6-20 OVC): Tennessee Tech snapped a 10-game OVC losing streak with a 4-3 victory in game two of its season-ending series at Eastern Illinois. The Golden Eagles also lost a midweek decision at Kentucky... Senior 1B **Nathan Marty** belted three home runs over the four-game stretch, a two-run shot against Kentucky and two solo homers in Tech's win over EIU, finishing with four hits, five RBI and three runs for the week. He registered a team-best 11 multi-RBI outings while driving in a team-high 43 runs on the season and tied for fifth place on the school's single-season chart with a squad-best 12 homers...Senior SS **Brandon Selvig** had 21 multi-hit games and 17 doubles while batting .328, all team-highs. Selvig and Marty (.319) were the only two Golden Eagles to hit over .300 for the season...Freshman 3B/DH **Clint Alexander** takes a 12-game hit streak into the 2006 season...Tech finished the year tied for 10th in the Conference standings with a 6-20 mark (13-42 overall).

GIBSON TO THROW OUT CEREMONIAL FIRST PITCH: Major League Baseball Hall of Famer and former St. Louis Cardinals pitcher **Bob Gibson** will throw out the first pitch of Wednesday's 6:30 p.m. first-round contest between Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky.
