OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 8

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

GARRETT BASS • OF, JR. • SUGARLAND, TX • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bass went 6-for-10 with two RBI and six runs scored while helping Jacksonville State to an OVC series win against Tennessee Tech. The junior outfielder racked up 14 total bases and posted a 1.400 slugging percentage over the three-game stretch, falling a home run shy of hitting for the cycle in Sunday's series finale and finishing with a double, two triples and a homer for the week. A native of Sugarland, Texas, Bass did not strike out in 12 plate appearances, registering a .667 on-base percentage while extending his hit streak to a career-long six games.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

ALEX GUTTOSCH • RHP, SO. • CHICAGO, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Guttosch provided Eastern Illinois with a solid effort out of the bullpen as the Panthers staged a three-game series sweep of Austin Peay. The sophomore righthander surrendered just two hits over six innings of scoreless relief work, picking up the victory in both the series opener and finale. A native of Chicago, Ill., Guttosch retired 18 of the 20 batters he faced and sat down the side in order in four of the six innings. He pitched back-to-back 1-2-3 innings in both the series opener and finale.

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (27-21, 10-11 OVC): Austin Peay suffered its second conference sweep this season, dropping all three games at Eastern Illinois (4-3, 9-2, 9-4) to sit in fifth place, tied with Tennessee Tech...Defense played a key role in the outcome of the series as APSU's eight errors led to nine unearned runs for the Panthers, while EIU's three miscues resulted in no unearned runs for the Govs...Austin Peay's starting corps of senior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** (8-3, 2.57 ERA), senior RHP **Brad Daniel** (5-2, 2.53 ERA) and junior RHP **Shawn Kelley** (3-5, 2.99 ERA) surrendered a combined 19 runs (11 earned) over 14 innings of work...Hardy had the Govs' best outing, tossing his fifth complete game in the series opener...Sophomore OF **Will Hogue** and freshman 2B **Ryan Gilboy** each had two-run homers in Sunday's finale, marking Gilboy's fourth dinger this season and tying him for the team lead...Senior 3B **Jacob Schroeder** and junior OF **Jacob Crass** each had four hits to pace the APSU offense...The Govs open their final five-game homestand with Lipscomb and OVC foe Murray State.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (27-19, 13-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped a 6-3 decision to Saint Louis before taking all three of its OVC contests against Austin Peay (4-3, 9-2, 9-4)...The series sweep was the Panthers' first of the season and first at home since 2002...All 11 of EIU's hits in the series-opening win against the Governors were singles...Junior C **Jason Cobb** registered back-to-back three-hit outings in the APSU series, finishing the week with two doubles, two RBI, three runs scored and a .467 batting average...Sophomore reliever **Alex Guttosch** (5-0, 4.03 ERA) retired 18 of the 20 batters he faced in two appearances, pitching six scoreless innings to claim wins in both outings...Junior reliever **Chris Vaculik** (5-6, 4.30 ERA, 6 saves) tied the school's all-time saves record with the 15th of his career in game one of the APSU series...Junior OF **Casey Spears** was 7-for-14 over the four-game stretch, collecting three RBI and four runs scored, while senior OF **Pete Stone** drove in a team-high five runs...Junior 3B **Ryan Campbell** moved into third place on EIU's all-time doubles list with his 49th two-bagger...EIU scored 22 runs against an APSU pitching staff that entered the week with a then league-low 4.10 team ERA...The Panthers' May 10 contest against Chicago State has been cancelled...Tied for second in the OVC, EIU visits Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (23-21, 12-8 OVC): Eastern Kentucky posted a 2-2 mark last week, losing a 14-12 home outing to Marshall before going on the road to take two of three from Southeast Missouri in Conference play...The Colonels dropped the series opener (11-2) but bounced back to sweep a Sunday twinbill (8-3, 6-5)...Junior 1B **Charlie Yarbrough** rapped out two hits in each of the three games at Southeast, finishing the week with a .400 batting average, two doubles, four RBI and three runs scored...Yarbrough remains one of the league's heavy hitters, leading the OVC in home runs (15), RBI (56), total bases (121) and slugging percentage (.733)...Freshman LHP **Christian Friedrich** (8-1, 2.18 ERA) registered his fifth double-digit strikeout performance of the season, fanning 10 batters and allowing five hits in 6.0 innings en route to the game two victory over the Redhawks...Friedrich leads the league in ERA, opponent batting average (.215) and strikeouts per nine innings (12.34)...Junior OF **Shawn Flora** leads the OVC with a .479 batting average in league play while senior OF **Brett Bolger** and Yarbrough are hitting .394 and .373, respectively...As a team, the Colonels are hitting .325 against Conference opponents...Fourth-place ECU closes out the 2006 regular-season on a seven-game homestand, beginning with Eastern Illinois.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (26-21, 13-8 OVC): Jacksonville State earned its first shutout of the season with an 8-0 win in its OVC series opener against Tennessee Tech...The Gamecocks split the final two contests, winning game two (7-6) before seeing their seven-game win streak end with an 11-8 loss in the series finale...Junior OF **Garrett Bass** batted .600 with a 1.400 slugging percentage and 14 total bases, counting a double, two triples and a home run among his six hits...Bass, who fell a homer short of hitting for the cycle on Sunday, extended his hit streak to a career-long six games...Sophomore RHP **Donovan Hand** (6-4, 2.35 ERA) allowed just five singles through eight innings during Sunday's combined shutout with fellow hurler **Josh Miller**...Hand has not allowed a run in 15 consecutive

innings and boasts a league-low 1.85 ERA in Conference play...All eight of JSU's runs in game one came with two outs on the board...As a team, the Gamecocks have recorded 114 two-out RBI this season...Junior **Nick Cleckler** sports the OVC's longest active hit streak at 19 games, batting .406 during that stretch with 17 RBI, four doubles and four triples...As a team, JSU is hitting .364 over the last seven games, led by **Eric Beck** (.565) and **Bass** (.414)...Tied for second in the OVC standings, the Gamecocks play a two-game series at home against South Alabama before traveling to UT Martin for a Conference tilt.

MOREHEAD STATE (15-30, 6-14 OVC): Morehead State saw its losing skid stretch to nine games after losing a midweek doubleheader to Cincinnati (12-11, 4-1) and an OVC series to Samford (4-1, 6-3, 12-3)...Junior 3B **Ryan Kinder** batted .368 with four home runs, eight RBI and a 1.000 slugging percentage over the five-game stretch...Kinder, one of three Eagles ranked among the league's top sluggers, belted a grand slam and a two-run shot in the opener of the Cincy twinbill, then homered in games one and three at Samford...Senior 1B **Paul Rhodes** leads the team with 12 dingers this season while Kinder and junior C **Donald Cheney** are tied at eight apiece...Cheney, Rhodes, and Kinder are slugging .549, .531 and .517, respectively, and have combined for 268 total bases...Freshman OF **Mark Ford** also contributed to the Eagles' offensive efforts last week, rapping out five hits in 11 at-bats for a .455 average...The 10th-place Eagles have lost 11 of their last 12 heading into the final two weeks of regular-season play...Morehead State wraps up a six-game road swing with a midweek visit to Marshall, then closes out the home portion of its schedule this weekend against Southeast Missouri.

MURRAY STATE (15-34, 8-13 OVC): Murray State went 2-1 in its final home series of the 2006 season, winning Saturday's OVC doubleheader against UT Martin (6-4, 7-2) before losing the finale on Sunday (9-4)...Earlier in the week, the Thoroughbreds fell to Louisville, 7-1...After opening Conference play with a 1-8 mark, the 'Breds have won seven of their last 12 games against OVC opponents and are part of a three-way tie at seventh place in the league standings...Junior **James Akin** continues to hit well since taking over at second base for the injured **Seth Hudson**, batting .462 on the week, including going 6-for-9 in the UT Martin series with a triple, three runs, an RBI and a .750 on-base percentage...Junior OF **Tyler Pittman** also hit .462 for the week, while senior DH **Chaz Ebert** batted .412...Sophomore RHP **Michal Perconte** (4-5, 4.46 ERA) went 1-1 with a save in three appearances last week...Perconte earned the save in Saturday's twinbill opener, then came back to pitch a complete-game, four-hit gem for the win in the nightcap, retiring the final 13 Skyhawk batters he faced...All six of Murray State's final regular-season games are on the road and against Conference opponents, beginning with Austin Peay.

SAMFORD (27-21, 16-5 OVC): Samford moved out to a three-game lead atop the OVC standings after sweeping Morehead State in league play over the weekend...Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs lost an 8-4 outing at Birmingham-Southern...Junior DH **Garrett Rice** went 5-for-10 against Morehead State, homering twice while driving in four runs and scoring five more...Junior LHP **Josh Ehmke** upped his OVC record to 7-0 by earning the game one victory on Saturday...Ehmke boasts a 9-2 record with a 2.97 ERA in 13 appearances, tying the school's single-season records for wins while also matching the mark for strikeouts (98)...Fellow hurler **Joseph Edens** (0-0, 2.08 ERA) picked up his 10th career save, setting a new Samford mark...Junior 3B **Parker Gargis** continues to swing a hot bat, leading the team and ranking second in the OVC with a .390 clip at the plate...Gargis is also among Conference leaders in RBI (41), while sophomore OF **John Morgan** is in the Top 10 for runs scored (40)...The Bulldogs go on the road for the final time in regular-season play, visiting Georgia State and Tennessee Tech.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (17-28, 8-13 OVC): Southeast Missouri suffered its fifth consecutive OVC series loss, winning game one against Eastern Kentucky, 11-2, before losing two to the Colonels on Sunday (8-3, 6-5)...Wet field conditions forced the second game of Saturday's twinbill to be moved to Sunday...The Redhawks also had a midweek contest against Arkansas State rained out...Senior SS **Jordan Payne** registered a hit in all three

games of the ECU series, finishing with a .444 batting average, one double, one homer, five RBI and three runs scored...Senior RHP **Anthony Maupin** (6-4, 4.60 ERA) limited the hot-hitting Colonels to just two runs and four hits over nine innings en route to the victory on Saturday, striking out five while registering his sixth complete game of the season...The win over ECU snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Colonels that dated back to the 2003 season...Senior DH **Andrew Johnson** belted his team-leading sixth homer on Saturday...Senior RHP **Jamie McAlister** (4-10, 4.47 ERA) is tied for the league lead after picking off his seventh runner in game two of the series...Tied for seventh, Southeast plays its final road series this week with a visit to Morehead State.

UT MARTIN (19-29, 8-13 OVC): UT Martin took a 4-1 decision from Belmont before going 1-2 in its OVC series at Murray State...The Skyhawks dropped both contests on Saturday (6-4, 7-2) before avoiding the series sweep with 9-4 victory on Sunday...Sophomore OF **Zach Dean** went 5-for-5 in the series finale with a double and a triple to finish the week with a .562 batting average, nine hits, four RBI and three runs scored...Dean leads the team in both slugging (.425) and on-base (.370) percentage while batting from the No. 2 spot...Junior 3B **Douglas Nicodemus** is hitting a team-high .311, followed by Dean (.310) and junior SS **Lance Renton** (.301)...Senior LHP **Derek Link** (2-3, 6.55 ERA) had a hand in both Skyhawk victories, picking up the win in an eight-inning start at Belmont, then pitching 3.0 scoreless frames in relief at Murray State...Link has surrendered only one run over his last 20.0 innings of work...The Skyhawks batted .315 as a team over the four-game stretch while registering 40 hits to their opponents' 38...Tied for seventh, UT Martin plays its final home series this weekend when OVC foe Jacksonville State pays a visit.

TENNESSEE TECH (17-31, 10-11 OVC): Tennessee Tech saw its OVC record slip back below .500 after going 1-2 in its Conference series at Jacksonville State over the weekend...The Golden Eagles lost both ends of Saturday's twinbill (8-0, 7-6) before rallying for an 11-8 victory on Sunday...The game one loss marked the third time this season Tech had been shut out by a Conference opponent...Sophomore 1B **Jake New** paced the team with a 5-for-12 effort in the series, extending his hit streak to six games while recording three doubles, two RBI and two runs scored...New leads the Golden Eagles with a .301 batting average and 12 doubles this season...Sophomore 2B **Matt Mihoci** is the only Tech player to start and play in all 48 games thus far in 2006...Hitting .292 from the No. 2 spot, Mihoci leads the team with 26 walks...Cleanup hitter **Steve Soper** is batting .301, leading the Golden Eagles with 55 hits and 33 RBI...Junior 3B **Brian Sprowl** sports a .458 on-base percentage in Conference play and .416 overall...Tied for fifth, Tech kicks off its final homestand of the season, beginning a five-game stretch at the Averitt Express Baseball Complex with outings against East Tennessee and league-leading Samford.
