

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

ERIC HORSTMAN • 3B, SR. • OMAHA, NE • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Horstman posted a .444 batting average (8-for-18) with four runs and eight RBI last week to help Southeast Missouri to a 2-2 record, including an OVC series win against league-leading Morehead State. The senior third baseman struck out only once in 21 plate appearances, registering a .524 on-base percentage while extending his hitting streak to 16 games. In the Redhawks' 4-3 series finale win against the Eagles, he swiped his team-leading 10th base while going 3-for-4 with two RBI and two runs. A native of Omaha, Neb., Horstman has now reached base safely in 38 straight games.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

DONOVAN HAND • RHP, FR. • TOWN CREEK, AL • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Hand picked up his team-leading eighth win of the season as he helped record Jacksonville State's first shutout of the season in an 8-0 OVC victory over Tennessee-Martin. The freshman righthander threw eight innings, allowing no runs on four hits before giving way to the bullpen. He struck out eight batters while issuing one walk and one extra-base hit, limiting the Skyhawks to a .154 effort at the plate. Hand currently ranks second in the league in victories, ERA (2.95) and opponent batting average (.231).

AROUND THE DIAMOND...

AUSTIN PEAY (31-16, 14-7 OVC): Austin Peay won its sixth straight conference series, taking two of three at Murray State over the weekend to pull within a half-game of the Conference lead with two weeks left to play...Senior DH **Jake Peterson** boasts the league's longest current hitting streak at 17 games after going 7-for-10 against the Thoroughbreds...Junior LHP **Rowdy Hardy** picked up his league-leading ninth victory on Saturday. It also marked his 21st career win at APSU, moving him into second on the school's all-time victories chart...Junior LF **Ryan Kane** went 5-for-6 with 6 RBI in game one of the series, becoming the third APSU player to record five hits in a game this season...Junior CF **Cody Youngblood** was 4-for-4 in the same contest before being lifted for a pinch hitter. Both players needed just a home run to complete the cycle...APSU pounded out a season-high 21 hits and tied a season-high with 15 runs in game one...Senior 1B **Chris Hyde** missed the weekend series due to illness...The Govs close out the home portion of their 2005 schedule with games against Evansville, Belmont and OVC foe Eastern Kentucky.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (12-35, 9-12 OVC): Eastern Illinois won its second OVC series of the season by taking two of three from Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. The Panthers also dropped an 11-inning, midweek decision (7-4) to Saint Xavier...Sophomore SS **Adam Varrassi** went 6-for-8 with a homer in Saturday's doubleheader versus EKU and pushed his hitting streak to five games with a 9-for-18, five-run effort on the week...Sophomore C **Jason Cobb** ranks second on the team with seven home runs this season after belting a three-run shot in game two on Saturday. He finished the day with four RBI...Five different Panthers have hit safely in at least five straight games, led by junior SS **Jon Hickey**'s six-game run...Sophomore RHP **Chris Vaculik** came within one out of getting the complete-game win in the series finale, retiring the Colonels in order in three different innings en route to recording his fifth victory of the season...The Panthers outscored their opponents by a 47-36 margin in the four contests...Tied for seventh in the league standings, EIU visits IPFW and hosts Saint Louis before traveling to league-leading Morehead State.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (20-23, 11-9 OVC): Eastern Kentucky pushed its win streak to 10 games with a 7-4 victory in its OVC series opener at Eastern Illinois, but saw the run end as the Colonels dropped the next two to the Panthers...Senior OF **Bryan Stevenson** pushed his hitting streak to a season-long 13 games with a 6-for-11, four-RBI performance in the series. He has collected a team-high 12 multi-RBI games and leads the league with 23 multi-hit outings this season...The Colonels' 10-game win streak was their longest of the season...Junior OF **Brett Bolger** continues to lead the Conference in hitting, going 5-for-9 over the weekend to raise his average to .412. He is the fourth-toughest hitter to get out in the nation, averaging 23.2 at-bats per strikeout with a league-best .480 on-base percentage...The Colonels are hitting an OVC-high .317 as a team...Fifth-place EKU visits Kentucky and entertains Western Kentucky before traveling to Austin Peay for a league series.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (25-21, 14-7 OVC): Jacksonville State now sits just a half-game back of the OVC lead after taking two of three from Tennessee-Martin over the weekend. The Gamecocks also picked up non-conference victories over Samford and Birmingham-Southern, helping stretch their win streak to eight games before Sunday's 4-3 loss to the Skyhawks...Sophomore SS **Jake Ball** collected three doubles and drove in four runs while leading the team with a .471 average at the plate (8-for-17). He currently tops the squad with an eight-game hitting streak...Freshman RHP **Donovan Hand** picked up his team-leading eighth win of the season, combining with fellow frosh **Mitch Miller** to throw JSU's first shutout of the season. Hand, who ranks second in the league in victories, ERA (2.95) and opponent batting average (.231), allowed four hits with eight strikeouts and only one walk in eight innings of work...The Gamecocks' pitching staff has surrendered a league-low 413 hits and sports a Conference-best 4.14 ERA...During its eight-game win streak, Jax State outscored its opponents, 71-20...The Gamecocks play a home-and-home series with UAB, then hit the road for an OVC trip to Murray State.

MOREHEAD STATE (26-21, 14-6 OVC): Morehead State saw its Conference lead dwindle to just a half-game after dropping two of three at Southeast Missouri...The Eagles also lost a 6-0 decision at Louisville earlier in the week...Junior RHP **Shane Lucci** pitched his fourth complete game and first shutout of the season in Saturday's 3-0, game two win at Southeast. He held the Redhawks to a .185 hitting average, giving up four singles and a double...The Eagles have hit a school-record 122 doubles in 2005, ranking third nationally. Morehead State is also among NCAA leaders in scoring (7.4 rpg), home run average (1.2 pg) and slugging percentage (.497)...Senior 2B **Lance Seasor** raised his batting average to .380 with a 9-for-16 effort last week (.563)...Junior DH **Paul Rhodes** leads the league and is tied for 23rd nationally with 14 home runs after hitting two dingers in game one of Saturday's doubleheader...Four Eagles are slugging over .600 for the season. Rhodes leads the quartet

with a Conference-best .684 clip, followed by senior 1B **Bryan Ingram** (.679), Seaso (.635) and sophomore C **Donald Cheney** (.632), who round out the league's top four spots...Junior lead-off hitter **Pete Troyer** was suspended for the Southeast series due to a violation of team rules...The Eagles wrap up the home side of their slate this week with Marshall and OVC foe Eastern Illinois.

MURRAY STATE (24-25, 12-9 OVC): Murray State remains in fourth place, two and a half games back of the Conference lead after going 1-2 in its series with Austin Peay. Earlier in the week, the Thoroughbreds dropped a 10-2 decision to No. 18 Ole Miss...Junior DH **Chaz Ebert** hit .615 (8-for-13) against APSU, including a season-best five-hit effort as part of an 8-4 victory in the series finale...Junior RHP **Billy Fares** held the Governors scoreless over the first eight innings of Sunday's contest before finishing up with two earned runs on nine hits with seven strikeouts...Sophomore 2B **Seth Hudson** let all Murray State hitters with a .471 average (8-for-17) average for the week, including a 6-for-13, five-RBI performance in the APSU series that featured a bases-clearing triple...The 'Breds take a break to concentrate on final exams before closing out the home portion of their schedule this weekend against Jacksonville State.

SAMFORD (17-31, 10-11 OVC): Samford sits all alone in sixth place after picking up its first OVC series sweep of the season against Tennessee Tech. Earlier in the week, the Bulldogs dropped a 10-2 non-conference decision to fellow OVC member Jacksonville State...Freshman 3B **Bill Whitehead** went 6-for-11 with a double and two RBI in the Tech series, finishing the week 7-for-14 overall to extend his hitting streak to six games...In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, sophomore RHP **Parker Gargis** registered his longest outing and first complete game of the season in the 2-1 victory. He gave up just one run on four hits through nine innings, fanning four batters and walking two while holding Tech to a .143 hitting average...Freshman OF **Bear Burnett** currently sports the team's longest hit streak at seven games...Junior RHP **Stephen Artz** recorded his fifth straight complete game in as many appearances, working all seven innings of Saturday's twinbill nightcap. He leads the league with six complete games on the season and is tied for the Conference lead with 13 starts...The Bulldogs play a home-and-home series with Birmingham-Southern this week, then hit the road for an OVC trip to Tennessee-Martin.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (18-28, 9-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri captured its second OVC series win of the season, taking two of three from league leader Morehead State. The Redhawks also dropped a 13-6 non-conference decision to Evansville on Wednesday...Senior 3B **Eric Horstman** struck out only once in 21 plate appearances to finish the week with a .444 batting average (8-for-18), four runs and eight RBI. He has reached base safely in 38 straight games and boasts a team-leading 16-game hitting streak...In Sunday's 16-4 rubber match with the Eagles, junior LHP **Derek Herbig** gave up a lone extra-base rap among eight hits while holding the league's top run-scoring offense to two runs through eight innings...The Redhawks recorded season-highs in both runs (16) and hits (18) in Sunday's series finale...Freshman 1B/DH **James Clayton** hit .583 last week with two doubles and two RBI, while older brother **Bill**, a pitcher, hit a two-RBI single in his first career at-bat...Sophomore OF/RHP **Brent Lawson** and senior 1B/DH **Freddy Lopez** belted two home runs apiece last week with Lopez recording both of his in Saturday's game one, 8-7 win over the Eagles...Tied for seventh in the OVC standings, Southeast travels to Tennessee Tech.

TENNESSEE-MARTIN (11-35, 5-15 OVC): Tennessee-Martin is tied for ninth in the OVC standings after going 1-2 against Jacksonville State. The Skyhawks also split a non-conference twinbill on Tuesday at Belmont...Sunday's 4-3 win in the JSU series finale marked the 11th one-run game of the year for the Skyhawks, who are now 6-5 in one-run decisions...Junior P **Scott Massey** tossed his third complete game of the season on Sunday. He had a no-hitter going into the fifth inning before settling for six hits, three runs, four K's and two walks over nine frames...UT Martin batted .255 as a team for the week with five Skyhawks hitting .300 or better. Freshman OF **Zach Dean** and freshman C **Chris Rezabek** led the group with .400 averages apiece, while senior utility player **Nick Bruner** batted .316 with two home runs and four RBI...The Skyhawks went 5-for-7 in stolen base attempts over the five games with Dean and junior SS **Jason Moore** swiping two each...UT Martin travels to Memphis for a make-up game before returning home to host an OVC series with Samford.

TENNESSEE TECH (11-36, 5-15 OVC): Tennessee Tech was swept in Conference play for the second straight week, losing all three of its outings at Samford. The Golden Eagles also dropped a midweek decision to Belmont, and find themselves in the midst of a seven-game losing skid...Freshman RHP **Matt Kearney** went the distance in Saturday's twinbill opener at Samford but was the tough-luck loser, giving up a one-out single in the bottom of the ninth for the 2-1 loss. He made two appearances on the week, allowing two runs on 10 hits while fanning five batters and walking one in 9.1 innings of work...Tied for ninth in the league standings, Tech closes out the home portion of its schedule this week against East Tennessee State and OVC foe Southeast Missouri.
