In four games last week, Reilly hit .571 (8-for-14) with seven runs scored, two doubles, a triple and seven RBI as the Golden Eagles were 3-1. He picked up a hit and scored a run at No. 13 Alabama, helping Tennessee Tech top the Crimson Tide, 8-6. Reilly went 3-for-5 in game three versus Bradley, finishing the series with a .636 batting average (7-for-11). Reilly recorded a .857 slugging percentage for the week as well as a .686 on-base percentage.

TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

AUSTIN PEAY (6-6, 0-0 OVC): The Governors played 16th-ranked Ole Miss tough to start the week, losing 4-3 and 9-3 to the SEC's Rebels. The Govs are now 0-3 on the road this season, falling to Ole Miss and No. 1 Vanderbilt. Austin Peay followed that up with a three-game weekend sweep of Wisconsin-Milwaukee at home. Junior outfielder **Will Hogue** hit .389 (7-for-18) with two home runs and six RBI last week; he led APSU with a .833 slugging percentage and was 6-for-8 with runners on base. After striking out nine times in 15 at-bats a week ago, Hogue struck out only twice in 18 at-bats this past week. Senior starter **Shawn Kelly** improved to 2-2 on the season after a complete-game victory over UW-Milwaukee on Friday; Kelly allowed only one run and scattered 10 hits. Senior closer **Ben Wilshire** picked up his third save of the season on Saturday; he has a team-best five appearances this season and a 1.12 ERA in 8.0 innings of work. APSU is tied with Tennessee Tech for the OVC lead in fielding percentage (.972). Austin Peay will play a home-and-home series with Indiana State this week before traveling to Furman for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (3-6, 0-0 OVC): The Panthers continued their 14-game road trip to begin the season with three games against Belmont over the weekend. The Panthers took the middle game of the series 4-3, but dropped one-run games in the other two contests (12-11 and 3-2). Freshman pitcher **Tyler Kehrer** earned the lone EIU victory last week, pitching 5.1 innings, surrendering just two singles and striking out eight Bruin batters. **Richie Derbak** has a current eight-game hitting streak, the third longest streak in the OVC. **Ryan Campbell** moved into third place on Eastern's all-time hits list (217) while his 53 career doubles is three shy of tying the program's all-time record. **Mark Chagnon** has also cracked the all-time hits top 10 (190). Eastern Illinois is on its Spring Break road trip this week as they play lone games at Charleston Southern and College of Charleston and a three-game set at The Citadel this week. The team will finally play a home game on Wednesday, March 21 when they host Division I Independent Chicago State.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-6, 0-0 OVC): The Colonels split a pair of home games last week with non-Division I in-state foes (Georgetown College and Berea) before heading to Bradenton, Florida to play seven games in the Florida All-Star Baseball Challenge. EKU played two of those games this past weekend, losing 4-3 to Army in 12 innings and 4-2 to Georgetown University. Junior catcher **Joe Oliver**, whose current 10-game hitting streak is tops in the OVC, hit .692 (9-for-13) last week with three runs scored and two RBI. That included a 3-for-5 performance in the 12-inning affair with Army. Sophomore pitcher **Christian Friedrich**, who is second in the OVC in E.R.A. (1.42), struck out 10 in six innings of work against Army, allowing four hits and getting a no-decision. EKU's .348 batting average currently leads the OVC, as does their 2.96 team E.R.A. Freshman **Matt Davis** leads the League in individual batting (.457) entering the week. Eastern continues play in the Challenge this week, playing Bucknell, Northern Iowa, Dartmouth and Vermont.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (6-8, 0-0 OVC): The Gamecocks started the week by building a 7-4 lead over Mississippi State before eventually falling 11-9. The team returned home to take two of three games over Northwestern State, including the final two of the series by a combined margin of 21-6. Junior outfielder **Clay Whittemore** hit .533 (8-for-15) with seven runs scored, two doubles, a home runs, six RBI and a slugging percentage of .867. He had three multiple-hit games, including a 2-for-3 performance against Mississippi State. Freshman pitcher **Ben Tootle** appeared in two games last week, including a dominant performance against Northwestern State. Tootle had a career-high 10 strikeouts and scattered five hits in 8.1 innings in a 7-2 JSU victory. He threw just 81 pitches in the win. JSU was batting just .183 as a team two weeks ago but after last week's performance is up to .271, after 10 players hit .333 or better. Senior **Garrett Bass** currently has a seven-game hitting streak, a JSU team high. Jacksonville State will play a pair of home games against Kennesaw State and Alabama State before heading to Florida for a Spring Break trip. In Bradenton, the Gamecocks will play Illinois, Ohio State, Northwestern, UMass and Yale.

MOREHEAD STATE (3-10, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State played five home games last week, topping regional rival Marshall (7-2) before going 1-3 against Canisius. Sunday's 8-4 loss was particularly tough, as Morehead did not give up an earned run in the defeat. Senior pitcher **Henry Mabee** pitched 6.1 innings against the Thundering Herd, allowing five singles and one run in picking up the victory. In the win over Canisius, Mabee came into the game in a relief role, pitching the final 1.3 innings to pick up a save. Senior catcher **Donald Cheney** hit .316 last week, with nine runs scored, six RBI, two doubles and two home runs. The Eagles stole 15 bases last week and have 44 swipes on the season; MSU stole only 52 bases during all of the 2006 season. Morehead State was scheduled to play two games at Tennessee this week, but Tuesday's game was given the axe when UT determined they had scheduled too many games

this season; the teams will meet up for a lone game on Wednesday in Knoxville. Morehead will then return home for a three-game set with Youngstown State.

MURRAY STATE (3-11, 0-0 OVC): Murray State compiled a 2-3 record in five home games last week. The Thoroughbreds lost to nationally-ranked Evansville, topped Southern Illinois and were 1-2 in a three-game set with South Dakota State. Sophomore shortstop **Justin Yount** hit .400 (6-for-15) with three runs, two doubles and four RBI last week. Freshman pitcher **Brad Rowland** picked up the ninth inning victory in game one against South Dakota State on Saturday then went the distance in the second game in a disappointing 4-3 loss. He had nine strikeouts and only one walk in 7.2 innings of work. In each of its last four games, Murray State either got the win in the final inning or had the game-winning run at bat, as they compiled a 2-2 record in those contests. Sophomore third baseman **Tyler Owen** had the last inning game-winning double against Southern Illinois and senior DH **Austin Swain** had a hard single to win against SDSU. MSU will travel to Arkansas State on Wednesday before returning home to host Indiana State for a three-game weekend series.

SAMFORD (9-8, 0-0 OVC): After losing five games in a row earlier this season, the Bulldogs responded by going 4-1 last week, taking a two-game series from Memphis at home and going on the road to win two of three against UNC Asheville. Sophomore hurler **David Knapp** earned OVC Pitcher of the Week honors after pitching seven shut-out innings in Samford's 1-0 win over Memphis. Knapp allowed only a pair of singles and walked one while striking out four. Relief pitchers **Doug Denson** and **Joseph Edens** pitched the final two innings to secure the victory. Senior second baseman **Parker Gargis** hit .353 (6-for-17) during the week, totaling six runs, a double, two home runs and eight RBI; he also stole a pair of bases and was 3-for-4 in Saturday's win over UNCA. The Bulldogs have now won five of six games. They will host Alabama on Wednesday and then Purdue for a three-game set this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (7-6, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri lost at Arkansas State and topped Saint Louis at home early last week before being swept at Capaha Field in a three-game set with Illinois State. Senior second baseman **Omar Padilla** hit .412 (7-for-17) with five runs, a double, four RBI and two stolen bases last week. He is currently riding a four-game hitting streak in which he is batting .500 (7-for-14). Senior lefty **Asif Shah** appeared in two games last week, lasting six innings and giving up three or less runs in each contest. At Arkansas State, he lasted six inning and allowed a run, and later in the contest became the designated hitter and hit a game-tying three-run home run. SEMO eventually lost that contest 6-5 by allowing a run in the bottom of the ninth. The Redhawks continue their eight-game home stand with games against Bethel College on Tuesday and a three-game series with Arkansas-Pine Bluff this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (9-6, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech now holds the OVC's best winning percentage in the early part of the season, having compiled a 9-6 record. The Golden Eagles upset No. 13 Alabama on Wednesday, winning 8-6 in Tuscaloosa. **Michael Roeder** was 4-for-5 with two runs scored and two RBI in the win over the Crimson Tide. Junior **Sean Reilly** was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .571 (8-for-14) with seven runs, two doubles, a triples and seven RBI. He had a hit and a run against Alabama and was 7-for-11 in the weekend series against Bradley. In that series, TTU dropped the opener 11-4 but swept the final two games, winning 7-6 in 11 innings and 9-6. The Golden Eagles will play at East Tennessee State on Tuesday before hosting Saint Peter's for four games over the weekend.

UT MARTIN (2-10, 0-0 OVC): The Skyhawks split a pair of games with South Dakota State before running into an offensive juggernaut in No. 17 Kentucky over the weekend. UT Martin was outscored 49-11 in the three losses to the Wildcats, the defending SEC Champions. Seniors **Scott McLean** (.368), **Lance Renton** (.353) and **Douglas Nicodemus** (.333) each hit .300 or better last week. Renton was 6-for-17 with a double, home run and four runs scored while also driving in four runs. UT Martin committed only one error at Kentucky, while the Wildcats made five miscues. The Skyhawks will host five games this week, beginning with a two-game set with McKendree College on Tuesday and Wednesday. This weekend the team will play a three-game set with IPFW.

Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite: Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists: The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer).

O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again: For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

OVC Players in Major League Baseball: To begin the 2007 Major League Baseball season, five former Ohio Valley Conference players find themselves playing at the highest level of professional baseball. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC), Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington) and Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson (Boston).

OVC Against Ranked Teams: So far this season, OVC schools have matched up in 17 games against ranked foes. That includes Austin Peay playing No. 1 Vanderbilt, Austin Peay playing two against No. 16 Mississippi, UT Martin playing three against No. 17 Kentucky, Jacksonville State playing three games at No. 24 Texas A&M, Murray State playing No. 25 Kentucky and No. 25 Evansville, Samford playing No. 24 Auburn, Tennessee Tech playing three against No. 24 Kentucky and Eastern Illinois playing at No. 25 Evansville. EIU came out on top of Evansville by an 8-6 score and Tennessee Tech topped No. 13 Alabama 8-6, marking the only wins over a ranked foe this season by an OVC school.

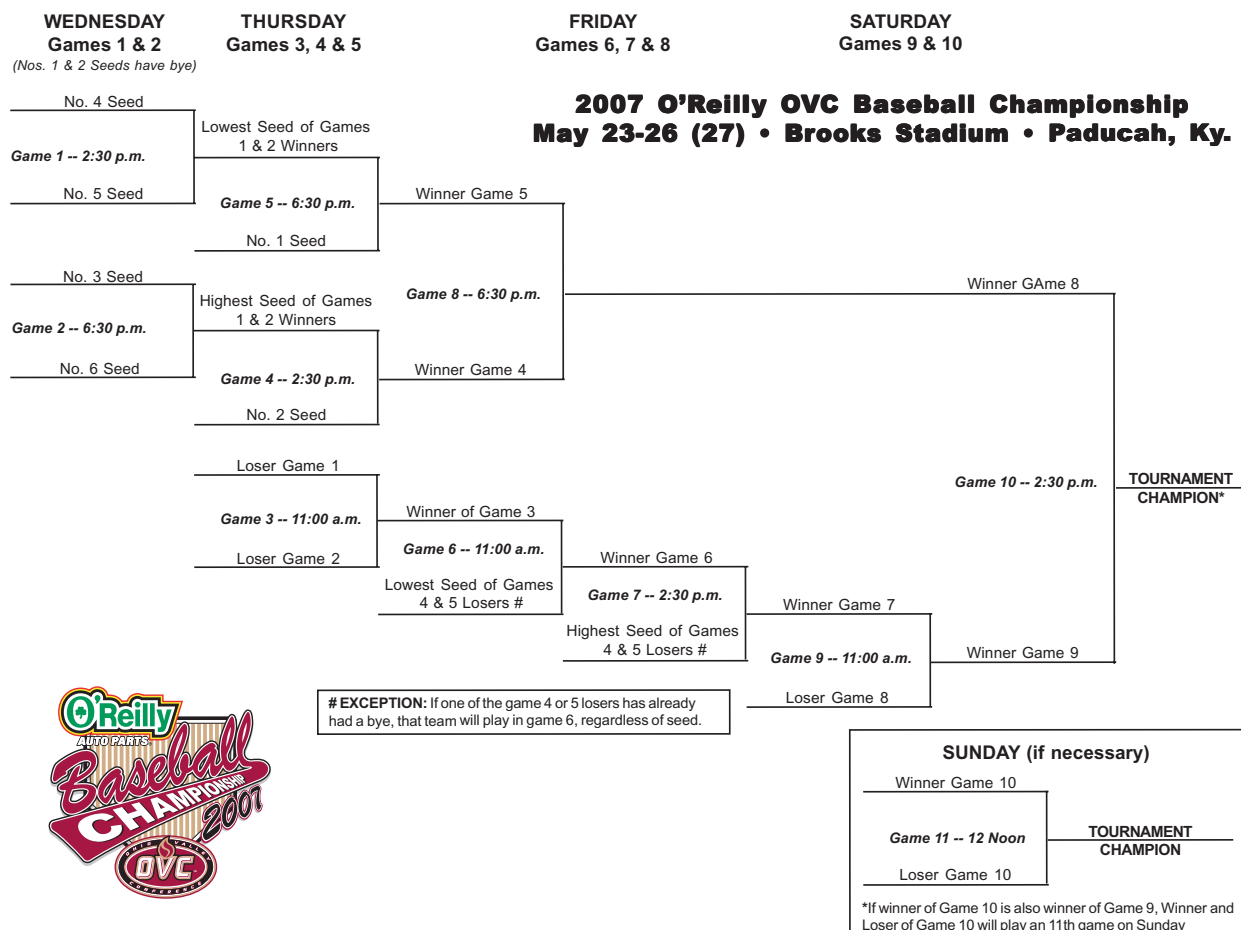
