## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

#### **WILL HOGUE • OF, JR., 6'3 • GERMANTOWN, TENN. • AUSTIN PEAY**

Hogue hit .529 (9-for-17) with six runs scored, two doubles, a home run, seven RBI and was 3-for-3 in stolen bases last week as the Governors won all five games (four on the road) last week to extend its winning streak to eight games. Hogue extended his hitting streak to nine games with a hit in each contest, including two three-hit games (March 13 vs. Indiana State and March 17 at Furman). He had three RBI against Indiana State (March 13) and two RBI at Furman (March 18). Hogue had a .609 on-base percentage for the week, recording a team-best five walks. His seven RBI led the Gobs for the week as did his .529 batting average.

#### **DUSTIN RENFROW • RHP, JR., 6'3 • WEST PLAINS, MO. • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI**

Renfrow lowered his season E.R.A. to an impressive 1.45 with nine shutout innings against Arkansas-Pine Bluff in a 5-0 win on March 16. He did not allow any hits from the second through eighth innings, as the Golden Lions hit for only a .129 batting average against him. Renfrow had stretches of seven and eight consecutive batters retired during the game. For the contest, he struck out five, walked only one and allowed four total hits (all singles) to improve to 2-0 on the season. Renfrow also won the award two weeks ago (March 5).

## TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

**AUSTIN PEAY (11-6, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay enters the week with the longest winning streak of the season - eight games. The Governors have not lost since dropping a 9-3 decision at nationally-ranked Mississippi on March 7. Austin Peay won all five games a week ago, topping Indiana State at home, then going on the road to top the Sycamores the next day. The week ended with a three-game sweep of Southern Conference Furman. Junior outfielder **Will Hogue** was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .529 (9-for-17) with six runs scored, two doubles, a home run, seven RBI and three stolen bases. Hogue extended his hitting streak to nine games and had two three-hit games during the week; he also had three RBI against Indiana State and led the team with a .609 on-base percentage for the week. Senior lefty **Matt Reynolds** was strong during the week, going 2-0 with a 2.40 ERA in 15 innings of work. Reynolds struck out seven as he won games against Indiana State and Furman. The win against Furman was a complete game victory, as he allowed on unearned run on three hits while striking out four in nine innings. Reynolds is now 4-1 on the year with a 3.82 ERA. Senior **Shawn Kelly** was picked up wins in his last two outings to improve to 3-2 with a 2.36 ERA. The Gobs will host Belmont on Wednesday before beginning OVC play this weekend. They will travel to defending tournament champion Jacksonville State for a three-game series.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-10, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois completed its stretch of playing 14 games on the road to begin the season by finishing a five-game swing through the state of South Carolina. The Panthers lost a lone game to Charleston Southern and three at The Citadel but in-between handed No. 30 College of Charleston a 7-5 defeat. Senior first baseman **Erik Huber**, who's 12-game hitting streak leads the league, hit .478 (11-for-23) with six runs, two doubles, three home runs and eight RBI last week. Huber had multiple hits in four of five games last week, including a four-hit effort against The Citadel. He also homered in three straight games during the week, which was more home runs than he hit all of last season (2). EIU has given up the lead in the final three innings of a game four times in its last eight contests. Head Coach **Jim Schmitz** will go for his 500th career win this week; he currently sits at 498 victories and needs just two to reach that mark. He will look to reach that milestone this week when the team finally opens home play. They do so on Wednesday when they host Division I Independent Chicago State. The team will then host Tennessee Tech in OVC play this weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (9-7-1, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky completed its spring break road trip to Florida by finishing last week 3-1-1, including the first tie for a Conference team since the 2003 season. EKU was tied 1-1 in after six innings with Dartmouth last week when rain forced the suspension of the game and since no make-up date could be made the game ended in a tie. Also on the tie the Colonels topped Bucknell twice, Vermont once and lost to Northern Iowa. Sophomore **Eric Hash** made three appearances last week, recording a pair of saves in 2.2 innings of work. He did not allow a hit in his time on the mound, and secured the wins against Bucknell and Vermont. **Joe Oliver** currently has a nine-game hitting streak to lead the team; he has seven multiple-hit games in 2007. EKU returns home to host in-state rival Louisville on Wednesday before opening up OVC play this weekend. The Colonels host Morehead State for a three-game series.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (8-10, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State split a pair of home games to being last week (falling to Kennesaw State and beating Alabama State) before embarking on a Spring Break trip to Bradenton, Fla. that began with a win over Illinois and saw a loss to Ohio State. Sophomore second baseman **Bert Smith** hit .533 (8-for-15) last week with a pair of doubles and four RBI. He raised his batting average 47 points during the week and now stands at .368 on the season. Smith is currently riding a six-game hitting streak and is hitting .475 with 10 RBI in his last 10 games. Senior lefty **Tony Drinkard** picked up a win last week, going 6.1 innings and allowing six hits while striking out two in a 14-2 victory over Big Ten foe Illinois. Drinkard tossed just 83 pitches and faced 27 batters to improve to 3-0 on the season. JSU was batting just .183 as a team three weeks ago but is now up to .285 as it gets ready to begin Conference play. Senior **Garrett Bass** is riding an 11-game hitting streak. Senior **Richard Turner** hit .556 last week including going 4-for-5 in the victory over Illinois. The Gamecocks are in for a busy stretch as they will play 11 games in a 14-day period after seven contests this week. JSU completes its Spring Break trip with two games against Northwestern, UMass and Yale before playing Alabama State on its way back home. JSU, the defending OVC Tournament Champions, open OVC play this weekend with a three-game set with Austin Peay.

**MOREHEAD STATE (4-13, 0-0 OVC):** The Eagles opened last week by playing a very competitive game with SEC foe Tennessee, losing by one run (10-9) in Knoxville. Morehead then dropped two of three home games to Youngstown State. Morehead had leads in all four games last week. MSU led UT 6-1 after three innings before eventually allowing the Volunteers to come back and win the game. Senior third baseman **Ryan Kinder** hit .462 (6-for-13) with three runs, two doubles, two runs home runs and six RBI last week. He also slugged 1.077 and had a .529 on-base percentage. Junior **Christian Winstanley** hit .583 for the week, including four hits against Tennessee. Freshman infielder **Drew Lee** also hit well - .556 - for the week,

notching five hits and scoring six runs. The Eagles will head west for a two-game set at No. 23 Arizona this Tuesday and Wednesday. Morehead then returns to the Bluegrass State for a three-game set at Eastern Kentucky, the OVC openers for both schools.

**MURRAY STATE (3-14, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State suffered a three-game sweep at home by to Indiana State over the weekend. Senior outfielder **Tyler Pittman** hit .417 (5-for-12) with a double, triple and three RBI last week. **Seth Hudson** hit .400 (4-for-10) last week, with an on-base percentage of .500. Pittman and Hudson combined for all but five of Murray's hits over the weekend. Freshman pitcher **Brad Rowland** pitched 5.1 innings of relief on Sunday, allowing just one earned run and striking out three. The Thoroughbreds with travel to Southern Illinois for a non-conference contest on Wednesday. Murray State topped the Salukis 9-8 in Murray on March 7. The week concludes with the team's first OVC series of the season - at Samford.

**SAMFORD (11-10, 0-0 OVC):** Samford enters the week having won seven of its last 10 games, including topping No. 22 Alabama last week at home. Junior **Luke Peavy** singled to centerfield with two outs in the 10th inning to lift the Bulldogs to the 4-3 victory. Samford became the second OVC team in two weeks (Tennessee Tech being the other) to top the Crimson Tide. For the week, Peavy hit .471 (8-for-17) with two runs, two home runs and four RBI. He was 3-for-5 in the game against Alabama and hit .417 in the series with Purdue. Samford lost two of three at home to the Boilermakers over the weekend. **Michael Marseco** currently has an 11-game hitting streak, a career-long. The Bulldogs will play at Mississippi State on Wednesday this week; the game was originally scheduled for Tuesday but changed due to the fact the Bulldogs are hosting a men's NIT game on Tuesday. Samford returns home for the weekend to host Murray State in the OVC opening series for both squads.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (11-6, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri shook off losing three straight last week by winning all four of its games this week. The Redhawks topped Bethel College 4-2 before sweeping a three-game series from Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Junior **Dustin Renfrow** was named OVC Pitcher of the Week for the second time in three weeks on Monday. Renfrow tossed a complete game shutout against the Golden Lions, scattering four singles in nine innings and striking out five while walking just one. Renfrow did not allow a hit from the second through eighth innings and had stretches where he retired stretches of seven and eight batters in a row. He improved to 2-0 on the season and lowered his ERA to 1.45. Freshman **Jim Klocke** hit .400 (4-for-10) on the week, registering three runs, a double and six RBI. His two-out, three-run double against Bethel lifted SEMO to the 4-2 victory. He also drew five walks and has hit by a pitch and has yet to strike out in 45 at-bats this season. Pitcher **Josh Syberg** struck out 14 Arkansas-Pine Bluff batters in just six innings on Sunday, which was three strikeouts short of the Southeast record. The 19-0 win over UAPB was the largest margin of victory for the team since a 24-3 win over William Woods in 2001. Head Coach **Mark Hogan** is now just seven wins shy of tying Joe Uhl's program record (373). Southeast Missouri will play a two-game set at Central Arkansas this week before returning home to host UT Martin in the OVC series opener for both clubs.

**TENNESSEE TECH (12-7, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech is one of the hottest teams in the Conference, winning eight of its last 10 teams entering this week. Last week the Golden Eagles went to East Tennessee State to win 6-4 and then won two of three games at home against Saint Peter's. In the two wins over SPC, Tech outscored the Peacocks 20-2. **Thomas Nelson** hit .500 (6-for-12) for the week, including six runs, a double and three RBI. He had two hits against ETSU and was 3-for-4 in game one against Saint Peter's. Junior **Blake Forst** picked up his first victory of the season in the win over East Tennessee State. Tech will host Belmont on Tuesday before traveling to Eastern Illinois for its first OVC series of the season.

**UT MARTIN (6-11, 0-0 OVC):** After losing four in a row, the Skyhawks had a very good week last week, winning four of five games. The week began with a pair of wins over McKendree College (6-0 and 17-8) before taking two of three from IPFW over the weekend. First baseman **Scott McLean** hit .556 (10-for-18) with six runs, two doubles and two RBI last week. He had a .667 slugging percentage and a .591 on-base percentage in the five games. Junior lefty **William Blackmon** had his best start of the season, striking out 10 in six innings and combining with **Travis Webb** for the team's first shutout of the season (and first since March 2006), a 6-0 win over McKendree. The team's four-game winning streak is its longest since winning four straight last season. **Eric Walker**, a member of last year's All-OVC Freshman Team, tossed a complete game against IPFW last week. Senior **Chadwick Cameron** netted his first save of the season and eighth of his career against IPFW. Cameron is tied with Frank Perez (1986) for the most saves in UT Martin history. The Skyhawks will play at Saint Louis University on Tuesday before traveling to Southeast Missouri for a three-game set this weekend.

**Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite:** Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

**Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists:** The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

**O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again:** For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

**OVC Players in Major League Baseball:** To begin the 2007 Major League Baseball season, five former Ohio Valley Conference players find themselves playing at the highest level of professional baseball. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC), Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington) and Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson (Boston).

**OVC Against Ranked Teams:** So far this season, OVC schools have matched up in 19 games against ranked foes. The League schools are 4-15 in those contests. The teams that scored victories so far this season include Eastern Illinois (over No. 30 Evansville and No. 30 College of Charleston), Tennessee Tech (over No. 13 Alabama) and Samford (over No. 22 Alabama).


