## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### CO-PLAYER

#### CLAY WHITTEMORE • OF, JR., 6'1 • CULLMAN, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE ST.

For the week, Whittemore hit .419 (13-for-31) with eight runs scored, four doubles and 10 RBI as Jacksonville State was 5-2 overall including an OVC opening weekend sweep of Austin Peay. Whittemore extended his hitting streak to a career-best 15 games while posting back-to-back four-hit games. He added three walks, a hit-by-pitch and stole a base and did not commit an error in the field. He now leads JSU with seven multiple-RBI games this season.

### CO-PLAYER

#### ASIF SHAH • OF/P, SR., 6'1 • CINCINNATI, OHIO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Shah, who garnered OVC Pitcher of the Week honors on Feb. 26, hit .444 (8-for-18) with five runs two doubles, a home run and 12 RBI last week as Southeast Missouri compiled a 4-1 record including an OVC opening weekend sweep of UT Martin. Shah, who leads his team with 23 RBI this year, nearly doubled his season output during the week, registering at least one RBI in each game and having multiple-RBI contests in four of five games. He drove in four on Wednesday at Central Arkansas and also added three multi-hit games during the week. Shah slugged .722 and led the team with a .600 on-base percentage. He also started Saturday's contest against UT Martin on the mound, lasting 5.2 innings and getting a no-decision.

### PITCHER

#### DONOVAN HAND • RHP, JR., 6'4 • HATTON, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

In a pair of games last week, Hand posted a pair of victories and allowed just three runs in 16 innings of work while striking out 20 and walking only two. Hand allowed just three hits and struck out eight in seven innings in Jacksonville State's 13-2 victory over Northwestern in Bradenton, Fla. He opened Conference play by topping Austin Peay 4-3 on Sunday. In that contest he had a career-high 12 strikeouts in earning the nine-inning complete game victory. Six of his strikeouts in that contest game in the sixth through ninth innings. For the week he held opponents to a .161 batting average.

## TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

**AUSTIN PEAY (12-9, 0-3 OVC):** Austin Peay extended its winning streak to a season-high nine games on Tuesday with a 3-2 home victory over in-state rival Belmont. However, the Governors saw the streak end on Saturday with a 7-6 loss at Jacksonville State in the first game of a doubleheader; JSU would go on to sweep APSU, handing the team its first back-to-back losses since early March. The nine-game winning streak was the longest for the team since winning nine in a row in 2005; that year the team won 35 games and the OVC Regular Season and Tournament Championship. Senior starter **Shawn Kelly** struck out six batters in the first game of the JSU series and moved into second place on APSU's all-time strikeout list. He is just 12 strikeouts shy of program all-time leader Rowdy Hardy. Closer **Ben Wilshire** picked up his sixth save of the season in Wednesday's win over Belmont; he has a 0.55 ERA in 10 appearances this season. The opening weekend OVC sweep marked the second time in three years that has happened to Austin Peay; in 2005 the Govs overcame the sweep (to Morehead State) and went on to win the OVC Tournament that season. Austin Peay will play at Middle Tennessee on Tuesday, host Evansville on Wednesday and travel to Morehead State for a three-game Conference series.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (7-11, 2-1 OVC):** Eastern Illinois finally got to play at home this season, playing four games at Coaches Stadium. EIU topped Chicago State 5-2 to begin the week and took two of three games from OVC foe Tennessee Tech over the weekend. Head Coach **Jim Schmitz** made history with the first win over Tennessee Tech (Saturday) by winning his 500th game as a head coach; 337 of his victories have come as EIU's head coach. Senior first baseman **Erik Huber** continues to be hot, as he extended his hitting streak to a career-long 16 games (the second longest current streak in the OVC) and hit .500 (9-for-18) for the week. Huber homered in his first two at-bats in Sunday's game, marking his first career multi-home run game. **Ryan Campbell** enters the week just one double shy of the all-time program record currently held by assistant coach Sean Lyons. **Chris Vaculik** broke the EIU all-time appearances record on Saturday, when he appeared in the second game of the double-dip. Junior **Mike Manns** tossed 5.2 innings of scoreless baseball against Tech on Sunday, as he topped the Golden Eagles for the second straight year. Eastern Illinois will host Saint Louis on Tuesday and travel to Indiana State for a Wednesday tilt before playing at UT Martin this weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (12-8-1, 3-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky lost a non-conference game to Louisville at home to begin the week but game back to sweep Morehead State in its OVC opening series this past weekend. It marked the first time since the 1992 season that the Colonels had swept their in-state rival. Junior **Tyler Barnett** hit .313 (5-for-16) last week with five runs scored, a home run and six RBI. Junior pitcher **McKenzie Willoughby** pitched a season-high 6.1 innings against Morehead in picking up a victory. **Shawn Flora** is tied for the OVC lead with 11 multiple-hit games and leads the Conference in stolen bases (16). Eastern Kentucky will play its first true road game on Tuesday when they travel to Oxford, Ohio to battle Miami University; EKU has previously played 14 home games and seven neutral site contests. The week concludes with an OVC series at Tennessee Tech.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (13-12, 3-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State is one of three OVC schools to remain undefeated in Conference play after the first weekend. JSU started the week by finishing up its spring break trip to Florida, topping Northwestern and Yale and losing to UMass in extra innings. They then dropped a road contest at Alabama State before sweeping Austin Peay. The Gamecocks ended the Governors nine-game winning streak in the process and have now won 9-of-10 against APSU over the past two years. JSU has won nine-straight OVC regular season games dating back to last season and have won six straight OVC series (the last series loss came to Eastern Illinois last season). **Clay Whittemore** was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after hitting .419 (13-for-31) with eight runs, four doubles and 10 RBI. He had back-to-back four-hit games during the week; Whittemore ranks third in the OVC in batting average (.402) and leads the League in hits (39) and RBI (25). Junior **Donovan Hand** earned OVC Pitcher of the Week honors after going 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA in 16 total innings of work. Hand helped the Gamecocks top Northwestern and followed that up with a win over Austin Peay. Against the Govs, Hand had a career-high 12 strikeouts and finished the week with 20 strikeouts versus only two walks. Senior **Garrett Bass** has the League's longest active hitting streak at 18 games and is hitting .414 (29-for-70) with 17 runs and 12 RBI over that stretch; overall his .353 average on the season ranks 13th in the Conference. Jacksonville State will play at Troy on Tuesday and travel to Samford for a weekend OVC series.

**MOREHEAD STATE (4-18, 0-3 OVC):** Morehead State was 0-5 last week, playing once again against some top competition. After playing only two road games before the week (at Louisville and Tennessee) the Eagles traveled to Tucson, Ariz. for a pair of games against No. 21 Arizona. The Eagles led in both games before eventually losing by one run in each contest. Morehead has led in nine of their last 10 losses. The week ended with a three-game sweep at the hands of Eastern Kentucky in the opening weekend of OVC play for both schools. Senior catcher **Donald Cheney** hit .412 last week while freshman **Drew Lee** hit at a .357 clip. **Ryan Kinder** hit .350 and drove in five runs. The road does not get much easier for the Eagles, who will play at No. 8 Kentucky on Wednesday. This weekend MSU hosts Austin Peay.

**MURRAY STATE (5-16, 2-1 OVC):** Murray State split four games last week, losing at Southern Illinois before winning two of three at Samford in the OVC opener for both schools. After losing at SIU, the Thoroughbreds ended a five-game winning streak with a doubleheader sweep of Samford on Saturday. Murray won that twin bill by scores of 6-5 and 4-3. The series finale went to extra innings and the 'Breds took a one-run lead in the 10th inning before a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the inning prevented Murray from sweeping the series. **Tyler Pittman** continued his torrid pace, hitting .571 (8-for-14) with five runs, two doubles, a triple, home run and four RBI. Closer **Brad Rowland** picked up a pair of saves, closing out both of Saturday's games against Samford. Murray State will host Belmont on Tuesday and Louisville on Wednesday before a hosting a weekend OVC series against Southeast Missouri.

**SAMFORD (12-13, 1-2 OVC):** The Bulldogs lost at Mississippi State to begin the week, allowing MSU to score twice in the eighth and four times in the ninth to win 7-6. Samford returned home to lose a doubleheader Saturday to Murray State before winning the finale against the Thoroughbreds, 7-4 in 10 innings. Sophomore **Joseph Ballew** was the hero in that victory, hitting a grand slam to give his team the win after they had fallen behind in the top of the 10th. Ballew had entered the game as a pinch runner in the ninth inning and the blast marked his first long ball of the season. Senior DH **Louis Rojas** hit .400 (4-for-10) on the week, notching a two-run home run on Sunday against Murray State. Senior **Chandler Tidwell** went 8.2 innings on Sunday, striking out 10 and walking just three but got a no-decision. **Parker Gargis** leads the OVC in home runs (9) and total bases (63) while **Bear Burnett** is tied for first in doubles (9). Samford will play a home-and-home series with UAB on Tuesday and Wednesday before hosting in-state rival Jacksonville State this weekend.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (15-7, 3-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri completed a 4-1 week to improve to 15-7 on the season, the best overall record in the Conference; they are also one of three undefeated teams in the OVC after the opening weekend of Conference play. The Redhawks split a two-game at Central Arkansas to begin the week and then topped UT Martin in three straight over the weekend in Cape Girardeau. Senior **Asif Shah** was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after hitting .444 (8-for-18) with five runs and an impressive 12 RBI in five games. Shah leads his team and is third in the OVC in RBI (23) and nearly doubled his season output last week alone. Shah was named OVC Pitcher of the Week earlier this season, marking the first time in at least six years an OVC player has done both in the same season. **Phillip Riley** lowered his season ERA to 2.50 with five innings of one-run ball last week. As a team, SEMO's 3.58 team ERA leads the OVC. Freshman Josh Syberg leads the Conference in wins (4) and strikeouts (380). Head Coach **Mark Hogan** is now just three wins shy of tying Joe Uhls program record (373). Southeast will host Freed-Hardeman for single games on each Tuesday and Wednesday and will play at Murray State this weekend.

**TENNESSEE TECH (14-9, 1-2 OVC):** Tennessee Tech was 2-2 in its contests last week, topping Belmont 17-7 at home and losing two of three at Eastern Illinois in its OVC opening weekend of play. Senior catcher **Steve Soper** hit .563 (9-for-16) with eight RBI last week, going 4-for-5 in the series finale against EIU. Soper had a .917 slugging and .538 on-base percentage in the weekend series against the Panthers. Senior **Matt Smith** tossed seven innings against EIU, striking out four and picking up his second victory of the season. As a team, Tech leads the OVC in batting average (.313), 13 points ahead of second place Jacksonville State. The Golden Eagles will host Tennessee on Tuesday before hosting Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

**UT MARTIN (6-15, 0-3 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin was 0-4 last week, losing a tough one-run game at Saint Louis before being swept at Southeast Missouri over the weekend. The Skyhawks have lost five straight games overall. Despite the swept at SEMO, UT Martin was in each game until the late innings, including the 18-8 loss; the team trailed only 4-2 after six full innings. UTM has now been involved in five one-run games this season and are 2-3 in those affairs. **Lance Renton**, who moved from shortstop to DH for the Southeast series due to an injury, hit .545 with three doubles, a home run and three RBI during the series. The 0-3 start in Conference play in the first time that has happened to UT Martin since the 2001 season. The Skyhawks will host Arkansas State on Tuesday and travel to Southern Illinois on Wednesday before hosting Eastern Illinois this weekend.

This feature can be accessed through the league's Official Web Site, OVCSports.com, or directly through OVCSports.TV. Subscription packages for baseball start at \$15.95 for the season. There are no live broadcasts this week.

**Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite:** Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

**Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists:** The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

**O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again:** For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

**OVC Players in Major League Baseball:** To begin the 2007 Major League Baseball season, five former Ohio Valley Conference players find themselves playing at the highest level of professional baseball. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC), Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington) and Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson (Boston).

**OVC Against Ranked Teams:** So far this season, OVC schools have matched up in 21 games against ranked foes. The League schools are 4-17 in those contests. The teams that scored victories so far this season include Eastern Illinois (over No. 30 Evansville and No. 30 College of Charleston), Tennessee Tech (over No. 13 Alabama) and Samford (over No. 22 Alabama).

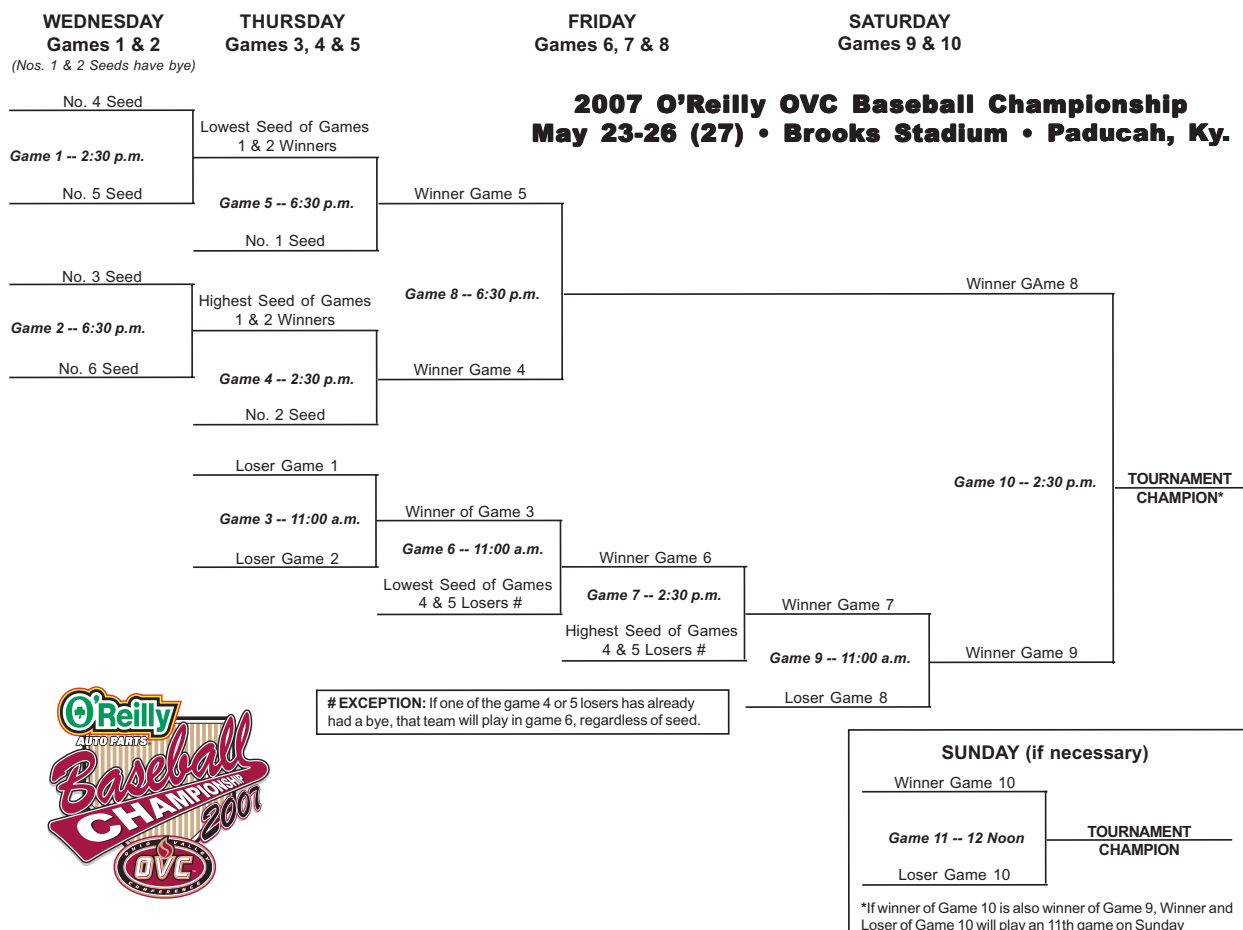
