**THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK****PLAYER****NICK NAIL • SS, JR., 5'10 • LOUISVILLE, KY. • MOREHEAD STATE**

Nail had a batting average of .727 (8-for-11), a slugging percentage of .818 and an on base percentage of .800 in Morehead State's four games last week against Louisville and Oakland. Nail, who hit safely in all four games, was 3-for-3 against Louisville in an appearance in his hometown. The shortstop fielded .939 with one error in 16 chances. He also reached base in 12 of 15 plate appearances, had a sacrifice bunt and was 6-for-8 in stolen base attempts.

**PITCHER****DUSTIN RENFROW • RHP, JR., 6'3 • WEST PLAINS, MO. • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI**

Renfrow picked up the first win in his NCAA Division I career against Cleveland State on Saturday in 3-1 Southeast Missouri victory. He retired the first 10 batters of the game before a batter reached base on an error (that batter scored CSU's only run, which was unearned). He then retired 10 consecutive hitters again, beginning with the second out of the fourth inning. In all, he pitched 7.1 innings and allowed four hits (all singles) and struck out six while not walking a batter.

## TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

**AUSTIN PEAY (3-4, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay took on the nation's top team - Vanderbilt - to start last week, falling 8-0 in Music City. The Governors finished the week by going 1-2 against Ball State. Austin Peay played six of its first seven games at home this season and will go on the road this week to face nationally-ranked Mississippi before returning home to battle UW-Milwaukee in a three-game set. Senior starter **Matt Reynolds** improved to 2-0 on the year with a 7-inning, 8-strikeout performance in the team's win over Ball State on Friday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-4, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois continues a stretch that will see them play their first 14 games of the season on the road. EIU played three games the AutoZone Classic in Memphis, falling to Indiana, Northern Iowa and host Memphis. **Ryan Campbell** moved into third place on EIU's career hits list (214) while **Mark Chagnon** cracked the program's Top 10 for appearances (85). The Panthers play three games at Atlantic Sun foe Belmont this week.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-3, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky, who will play its first 10 games of the season at home, continued that home stand with doubleheaders against Kentucky State and Akron last week. The Colonels swept by KSU, winning 12-6 and 9-0, but were handed a pair of losses by the Zips, falling 7-0 and 8-6. Senior **Tony Wells** has a hit in all eight games this season. Sophomore **Aaron Barrows** was 6-for-11 (.545) last week with five runs scored and three RBI. The team's 5-1 start to the year was its best since the 2004 season. ECU hosts Georgetown (Ky.) College and Berea College this week.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (4-6, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State scored a non-conference road victory at Kennesaw State to begin last week and lost two of three at home to High Point over the weekend. Senior outfielder **Garrett Bass** hit .533 (8-for-15) with four doubles and five RBI last week. Senior pitcher **Tony Drinkard** tossed six innings against High Point, striking out five in picking up a victory. JSU will travel to Mississippi State this week before hosting Northwestern State for a three-game set.

**MOREHEAD STATE (1-7, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State was 1-3 last week, falling at Louisville and going 1-2 at home against Oakland. The Eagles allowed 57 total runs during the week, including 40 in the final two games of their series against Oakland. Sophomore **Tyler Bess** picked up his team's first win of the season, going 7.2 innings and allowing four hits and only one run. Junior **Nick Nail** was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .727 (8-for-11) with seven runs scored, a double, RBI and six stolen bases. Morehead State will host Marshall for a single-game on Wednesday and then Canisius for a four-game series this weekend.

**MURRAY STATE (1-8, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State picked up its first victory of the season last week, taking one of three games at Gardner-Webb. The Thoroughbreds also lost at home, falling 12-7 in its home opener to Arkansas State. Sophomore **Tyler Owen** hit .571 (8-for-14) with three runs and five RBI last week. MSU starts a five-game home stand this week, playing Evansville and Southern Illinois in single games before hosting Division I Independent South Dakota State for a three-game weekend series.

**SAMFORD (5-7, 0-0 OVC):** Samford lost to No. 24 Auburn last week and was 1-2 at Mercer. Senior **Parker Gargis** hit a pair of home runs for his team while senior lefty **Josh Ehmke** pitched 7.2 innings and struck out seven to pick up the lone win of the week. The Bulldogs host Memphis for a pair of games this week and then travel to UNC Asheville for a three-game series.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-2, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri took over the League lead for victories this week winning twice against Cleveland State at home to improve to 6-2 this season. Junior **Dustin Renfrow** was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after tossing 7.1 innings against CSU and allowing only four singles while striking out six. SEMO is off to its best start since starting the 2000 season 8-2. The Redhawks travel to Arkansas State this week before hosting Saint Louis and Illinois State (3 games). The team is in a stretch where they will play 13 of 14 and 18 of 21 at home.

**TENNESSEE TECH (6-5, 0-0 OVC):** The Golden Eagles lost a Lipscomb to begin the week before winning three of four at home against Canisius. **Thomas Nelson** hit .438 (7-for-16) with four doubles and four RBI last week while **Matt Smith** tossed 6.1 innings of relief ball against Canisius, striking out 11 batters. TTU plays at No. 22 Alabama this week before hosting Bradley for a three-game series.

**UT MARTIN (1-6, 0-0 OVC):** The Skyhawks played only two mid-week games last week, losing at Memphis before dropping a home game against Southern Illinois. The team hosts South Dakota State for two this week before traveling to No. 18 Kentucky for a three-game set this weekend.

**Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite:** Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

**Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists:** The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer).

**O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again:** For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

**OVC Players in Major League Baseball:** To begin the 2007 Major League Baseball season, five former Ohio Valley Conference players find themselves playing at the highest level of professional baseball. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC), Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington) and Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson (Boston).

**OVC Against Ranked Teams:** So far this season, OVC schools have matched up in 10 games against ranked foes. That includes Austin Peay playing No. 1 Vanderbilt, Jacksonville State playing three games at No. 24 Texas A&M, Murray State playing No. 25 Kentucky, Samford playing No. 24 Auburn, Tennessee Tech playing three against No. 24 Kentucky and Eastern Illinois playing at No. 25 Evansville. EIU came out on top of Evansville by an 8-6 score, marking the only win over a ranked foe this season by an OVC school. This week Austin Peay battles No. 16 Mississippi, UT Martin plays three at No. 18 Kentucky, Tennessee Tech plays at No. 22 Alabama and Murray State hosts No. 25 Evansville.

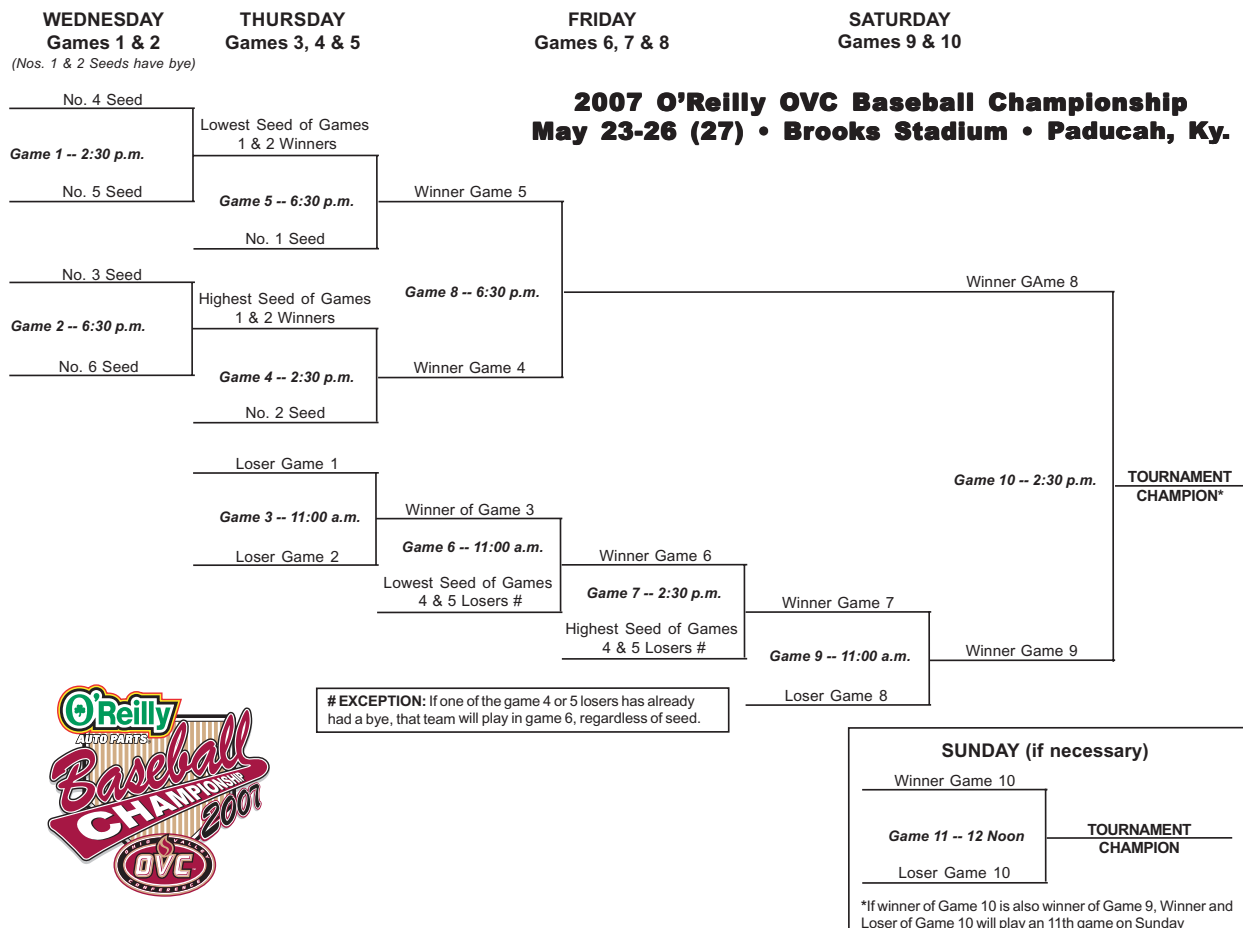
