THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

JAKE BALL • 3B, SR., 6'2 • HOKES BLUFF, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Ball hit .533 (8-for-15) last week with three runs, a double, a home run and seven RBI to help Jacksonville State to a 3-1 record on the week. Ball had three multiple-hit games (he now has 18 on the season and five in his last seven games) and extended his hitting streak to an OVC-best 10 games. He was 3-for-5 with four RBI in a non-conference game against Georgia State and had back-to-back two hit games over the weekend against Eastern Illinois. Ball raised his batting average 24 points on the week, posted a .800 slugging percentage and set the JSU school record by appearing in his 199th career game.

PITCHER

DUSTIN RENFROW • RHP, JR., 6'3 • WEST PLAINS, MO. • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Renfrow won the award for the third time this year by tossing a nine-inning complete game shutout at Samford over the weekend. Renfrow allowed six hits and struck out six (tying a season-high) while walking two in the 4-0 victory. He lowered his OVC-leading E.R.A. to 1.47 as he improved to 3-0 on the year. He retired nine of the first 10 batters he faced and allowed only three base runners to reach scoring position. Renfrow also pitched 1.1 innings of perfect relief in the Redhawks non-conference game against Southern Illinois last week. For the week Renfrow tossed 10.1 innings of shutout baseball. Renfrow is the first OVC pitcher to win the award three times in the same season since Rowdy Hardy of Austin Peay did so in 2005.

TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

AUSTIN PEAY (20-14, 7-5 OVC): Austin Peay made the most of a weekend road trip to Tennessee Tech, sweeping the Golden Eagles to reach 20 wins on the season and improve to 7-5 in the Conference. The Governors began the week with a 5-4 loss at home to Middle Tennessee. APSU is now an impressive 6-3 in road OVC games this season, while only 1-2 at home. APSU will get a chance to play two of its next three OVC series at home. Junior **J.B. Gilbert**, batting in the No. 9 hole for the Govs, hit .529 (9-for-17) last week with three RBI. Senior **Shawn Kelley** picked up his fourth consecutive victory, going seven innings and allowing one earned run while striking out four in topping Tennessee Tech. He also became APSU's all-time strikeouts leader in the process. Kelley ranks sixth in the OVC in E.R.A. (2.78) and leads or shares the Conference lead in wins (6) and innings pitched (64.2). After committing 11 errors during a five-game home stand in which the club was 0-5, APSU committed only one error in the series at Tech. Austin Peay will play at Memphis on Tuesday night, then host the Tigers on Wednesday. The Govs host Conference co-leader Southeast Missouri for a three-game set this weekend. That series pits the League's No. 1 and No. 2 squads as far as E.R.A. goes - SEMO leads the OVC at 3.60 while APSU is second at 3.87.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (14-15, 6-5 OVC): After having back-to-back games cancelled due to weather, Eastern Illinois returned to the field on Thursday and topped Olivet Nazarene 12-3 before traveling to Jacksonville State over the weekend. EIU won game won 10-1 and split Saturday's doubleheader by dropping the second game 9-2. On Sunday, Eastern blew an 8-0 lead, losing 14-13 to the Gamecocks in walk-off fashion in the bottom of the ninth. The series loss to JSU was the first by Eastern Illinois to the Gamecocks. Senior **Ryan Campbell** broke the EIU all-time records for hits (237) and doubles (57) in Sunday's affair. Batting clean-up last week, Campbell hit .545 (6-for-11) with two runs, two doubles and six RBI. Slugger **Erik Huber** saw his 21-game hitting streak come to an end on Thursday, going 0-for-2 before being pinch hit for. He has been slowed by injury and had only one at-bat in the JSU series. In all games, Huber's .454 average still leads the OVC. Senior pitcher **Chris Vaculik** pitched seven innings and struck out three in picking up a win in the 10-1 victory on Saturday and earning his 19th career victory (fourth on the EIU all-time list). Vaculik has a 2.25 E.R.A. in OVC-only games, the third best mark in the League. In the wild 14-13 series finale, Eastern batters drew 14 total walks. In 11 OVC games, EIU ranks third overall in the League in batting (.315). The Panthers will host Millikin in a non-conference game on Tuesday, then travel to Saint Louis for a game on Wednesday. This weekend EIU hosts Samford for a key three-game OVC series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (14-16-1, 5-5 OVC): The Colonels have continued to struggle against OVC opponents and Mother Nature. Eastern Kentucky lost its second OVC game of the season at Murray State when the weather shortened the series by a game. ECU suffered a pair of extra inning losses to the Thoroughbreds and are now 0-3 in extra inning games this season. The Colonels have now lost four straight games overall and three straight OVC contests as they have fallen to .500 in the League and are now in sixth place, a win ahead of UT Martin. Sophomore **Aaron Barrows** hit .444 (4-for-9) last week with a RBI and stolen base in three games. He was 3-for-4 in the 3-2, 11-inning loss to Murray State. His two-out RBI single gave ECU a brief 2-1 lead in the top of the 10th inning, before Murray State tied the game in the bottom of the frame. Sophomore lefty **Christian Friedrich** was strong in his start, pitching six innings and striking out a season-high 11 while allowing only two hits. He left the game with a 5-1 lead only to see Murray score four times in their last at-bat and then once in extra innings to win 6-5, denying him his third victory of the season. Friedrich's 2.06 E.R.A. is second in the OVC while his 59 strikeouts (12.19/game) is first; that mark was 17th in last week's NCAA national rankings (new leaders come out on Tuesday). Eastern will get to play four games at home this week to try to get back on the winning track; ECU is 10-7 overall and 4-1 in OVC games at home this season. The Colonels play non-conference games with Marshall (Tuesday) and Xavier (Wednesday) before hosting OVC co-leader Jacksonville State this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (20-16, 9-3 OVC): Jacksonville State remained in a tie for first place in the OVC with Southeast Missouri by taking two of three from Eastern Illinois this past weekend, the first time they had won a series against EIU since joining the OVC. The Gamecocks also scored a 16-8 non-conference win over Georgia State to begin the week. JSU trailed EIU 8-0 in the finale of the series only to rally for a 14-13 victory; the comeback was the second largest under Head Coach **Jim Case**. Senior **Jake Ball** was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .533 (8-for-15) with three runs, a home run and seven RBI last week. Ball set a JSU record by playing in his 199th career game during the week. He had three multiple-hit games last week (and leads the OVC with 18 on the season) and has had multi-hit games in five of his last seven contests. Senior **Donovan Hand** picked up his 17th career OVC and 23rd career overall victory over the weekend, tossing a complete game in a 9-2 JSU win. Hand struck out five in tossing his second complete game of the season. He has a 2.27 E.R.A. in Conference-only games, a mark that is fourth in the League; his 29 strikeouts in OVC competition is also a league-high. **Clay Whittemore** is second in the OVC in hitting (.410) while **Bert Smith** ranks sixth (.363); in OVC-only contests, **Daniel Adamson** leads the league with a .469 average while Ball is third (.444) and Whittemore seventh (.413). As a team, JSU is first in the OVC in hitting (.306); they also lead the League in at-bats, runs, hits, total bases and double plays. Jacksonville State will play a home-and-home series with in-state rival UAB this week before traveling to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game weekend series.

MOREHEAD STATE (8-24, 3-9 OVC): Morehead State broke through with its first road victory of the season over the weekend, winning 8-0 at UT Martin. The Eagles lost heartbreakers in the other games against the Skyhawks, losing 7-6 in 10 innings and 5-4 in eight innings to bookend the victory. In the win, senior **Henry Mabee** was excellent, tossing a seven-inning complete game shutout in Sunday's first game of the doubleheader. Mabee scattered five hits and struck out seven while not walking a batter.

Senior outfielder **Nick Bobrowski** was 5-for-9 (.556) at the plate last week, and notched a single, double and triple in the final game of the UTM series. Morehead State is now 2-7 in one-run games this season after the UT Martin series. MSU had a 2.28 team E.R.A. and out-hit the Skyhawks .330 to .242 in the series but still lost two of the three games. Morehead is third in the OVC in team batting (.302) and first in stolen bases (70); the Eagles actually have twice as many steals as six of the 10 OVC teams do at this point of the season. Senior **Ryan Kinder** now ranks ninth in the OVC in batting average (.351). MSU will play at Kentucky on Wednesday, a game that was re-scheduled from a rainout a few weeks ago. The Eagles then host Lindsey Wilson on Thursday before welcoming Murray State to town for a three-game OVC series.

MURRAY STATE (11-21, 6-4 OVC): Murray State fell victim to the weather again last week - losing an OVC game for the second straight weekend - but they kept winning on the field, topping No. 39 Memphis twice during the week before winning a doubleheader against Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. The Thoroughbreds have now won three in a row in OVC play and five in a row overall after starting the season 6-21. The 'Breds are 6-4 in OVC play, which places them in third place (up from sixth last week), percentage points ahead of Austin Peay. The winning streak is the longest since a seven-game string from Feb. 21 to March 2, 2001. After 10 games a year ago, the Thoroughbreds were just 2-8 in Conference play. Senior **Seth Hudson** hit .588 (10-for-17) with four runs and six RBI. He was a combined 5-for-9 in the wins over nationally-ranked Memphis and had an on-base percentage of .632 for the week. Hudson currently ranks eighth in the OVC in hitting (.357) while **Tyler Owen** ranks fourth (.372). In Conference-only games, Owen is second in batting (.455) and leads the League in RBI (13) and slugging (.818). On the hill, junior **Lucas Hill** pitched nine innings, allowing six hits and striking out three in a pitchers' duel against EKU; Hill left the game with a no-decision as Murray would go on to win 3-2 in 11 innings. This week the team will play at Evansville before hosting Freed-Hardeman on Wednesday, a game that was re-scheduled from Feb. 27. Murray State will play at Morehead State this weekend.

SAMFORD (17-19, 4-8 OVC): Samford lost two of three games to OVC co-leader Southeast Missouri over the weekend to slip to 4-8 in the Conference, which places them in a tie for eighth overall (with Tennessee Tech). The preseason favorite, the Bulldogs are 11-13 overall this season at home and 2-7 in home OVC games almost halfway through the League schedule. Six of Samford's next nine OVC games are on the road. Senior **Chandler Tidwell** pitched 6.1 innings against Southeast on Sunday, keeping the team in the game in a contest Samford won 2-1 in 11 innings. He struck out seven and walked only one. In the other two games, Southeast's pitching (which has the No. 1 E.R.A. in the OVC) kept the Bulldogs at bay, outscoring them 13-0 and limiting them to just nine hits. Samford is currently last in the OVC in hitting (.236) despite a few hot bats. **Michael Marseco** is fifth in the Conference in hitting (.366) while **Parker Gargis** is first in home runs (10 - a mark that was 31st nationally last week). On the pitching side of things, the Bulldogs are fourth in team E.R.A. (4.74) while Tidwell ranks fourth in individual E.R.A. (2.47). Senior **Joseph Edens** leads the OVC with eight saves, a mark that was eighth in the country last week. Samford will battle in-state foe Auburn at a neutral site (Regions Park) in Birmingham this week. That game precedes a three-game OVC series at Eastern Illinois this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (23-13, 9-3 OVC): The Redhawks won two of three games at Samford last weekend (and lost in extra innings in the finale) to remain the co-leader (with Jacksonville

State) in the Conference. Southeast Missouri's 23 overall victories are also the most of any League team. The 23-13 start is the best for the program since starting 24-12 in 2001. SEMO dropped a 7-2 decision to regional rival Southern Illinois to begin last week and then shutout Samford 4-0 and 9-0 in the first two games in Birmingham. The Redhawks dropped the final game 2-1 in 11 innings. Junior **Dustin Renfrow** picked up his third OVC Pitcher of the Week award of the season after tossing a nine-inning shutout against Samford. Renfrow scattered six hits and matched a season-high with six hits in recording his second complete game shutout of the season. He is the first OVC pitcher to win the award three times in a season since Rowdy Hardy of Austin Peay did so in 2005 (the OVC record is five times in a season by Todd Pennington of Southeast Missouri in 2001). Renfrow leads the OVC in E.R.A. (1.47), a mark that should be in the Top 20 nationally when this week's leaders are released. In the other shutout it was senior **Asif Shah** who limited the Bulldogs to three hits over seven innings in picking up his second complete game shutout of the season. Shah is third in the OVC in E.R.A. (2.26) and first in RBI (38) at the plate. The back-to-back shutouts were the first since April 2006 as SEMO lowered its team-leading E.R.A. to 3.60 on the season. The pitching staff has allowed two or fewer earned runs in each of its last six contests (dating back to the first game of the JSU series). Freshman **Jim Klocke** hit .615 (8-for-13) with two runs and a RBI last week; he had three multi-hit games on the week. Southeast will play at Southern Illinois this Wednesday before traveling to Austin Peay this weekend. APSU currently ranks second in the League in E.R.A. (3.87) as four of the League's top pitchers will match-up over the three-game set.

TENNESSEE TECH (17-18, 4-8 OVC): Tennessee Tech suffered four defeats last season to fall below .500 on the season and to 4-8 and a tie for eighth place (with Samford) in the OVC race. The Golden Eagles lost a non-conference game at Lipscomb and then were swept by Austin Peay in a cold weekend in Cookeville. Tech has now lost six games in a row and eight of nine overall. TTU was competitive all weekend, losing 10-5, 4-2 (in a weather-shortened game) and 3-1 in 11 innings in the finale. Junior righty **Blake Forst** struck out six in six innings on Sunday, allowing just one earned run before leaving with a no-decision. Senior **Brian Sprowl** saw his 16-game hitting streak come to an end on Sunday. Sophomore catcher **Cory Wright** had a pair of doubles and a three-run home run in the opening game of the APSU series. Senior **Steve Soper** continues to lead his team in hitting (.403), a mark that is third in the OVC. TTU will play at Belmont on Tuesday before hosting UT Martin for a three-game set this weekend.

UT MARTIN (12-22, 4-7 OVC): The Skyhawks won three times last week, including a pair of OVC games to improve to 4-7 in the Conference. After losing a 14-12 heartbreaking in 12 innings to Martin Methodist last Monday, Tennessee-Martin rebounded with a 5-1 win over Saint Louis on Wednesday. That momentum led to a 7-6 10-inning win over Morehead State in the series opener. UTM lost the second game to MSU by an 8-0 margin but rebounded for a 5-4 eight-inning win in the finale. The Skyhawks find themselves in seventh place overall, just a win behind Eastern Kentucky for sixth. Senior **Lance Renton** hit .435 (10-for-23) on the week, netting two runs, three doubles and five RBI. He extended his hitting streak to eight games on Sunday and ranks seventh (.363) in the OVC in batting average. Junior **Kyle Dudley** is 10th in the OVC in batting (.349). Senior **Jason Hockaday** caught the series finale on Sunday and threw out four base runners in the second game of the doubleheader. Senior hurler **Jacob Smothers** went over the 100 career strikeout mark on Sunday and is now just 17 strikeouts away from the program's career top 10. UTM will travel to Arkansas State for a Tuesday non-conference tilt before heading to Tennessee Tech for a three-game weekend series.

Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite: Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists: The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again: For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

EIU's Schmitz Picks Up 500th Career Victory: Eastern Illinois head coach **Jim Schmitz** picked up his 500th career victory on Saturday, March 24 as EIU topped Tennessee Tech 9-7 in the opening game of a doubleheader. Schmitz, who is in his 13th year at EIU after stints at Wilmington and Cincinnati, has recorded 336 of his victories at Eastern Illinois. Schmitz has been tabbed OVC Coach of the Year three times in his career (1998, 1999, 2001).

Hogan Sets Southeast Missouri All-Time Victories Mark: Southeast Missouri State head coach **Mark Hogan** established a new Southeast Missouri State head coaching victories mark with his 374th victory at SEMO in a 17-3 victory over Murray State on Saturday, March 31. The victory put his past Joe Uhls, who had 373 victories in his career. Hogan, in his 13th season at Southeast Missouri, has amassed more than 750 career victories in 26 years, which included stops at Lurleen B. Wallace Community College and West Alabama before coming to Cape Girardeau.

Southeast Ties NCAA Grand Slam Record: With hitting three grand slams in a 27-16 victory over Freed-Hardeman on March 28, Southeast Missouri State tied the NCAA record for grand slams in a single game. The Redhawks are the eighth team to hit three grand slams in a game and first since Youngstown State did so against Oakland University on May 6, 2001. The grand slams came off the bats of **Asif Shah**, **Phillip Riley** and **Nick Harris**. The 27 runs in the game was a Southeast Missouri record (breaking a mark of 24 set in 1985 and equaled in 2001) as was the combined 43 runs by the two teams (breaking a record of 38 set in 1977).

Cold/Rain Forces Cancellation of League Games: An early April cold front cancelled the final games of both the Murray State/Eastern Illinois and UT Martin/Eastern Kentucky series on April 7. This past weekend poor weather forced several teams to re-arrange their doubleheader and Murray State and Eastern Kentucky lost one of the three games in their series.

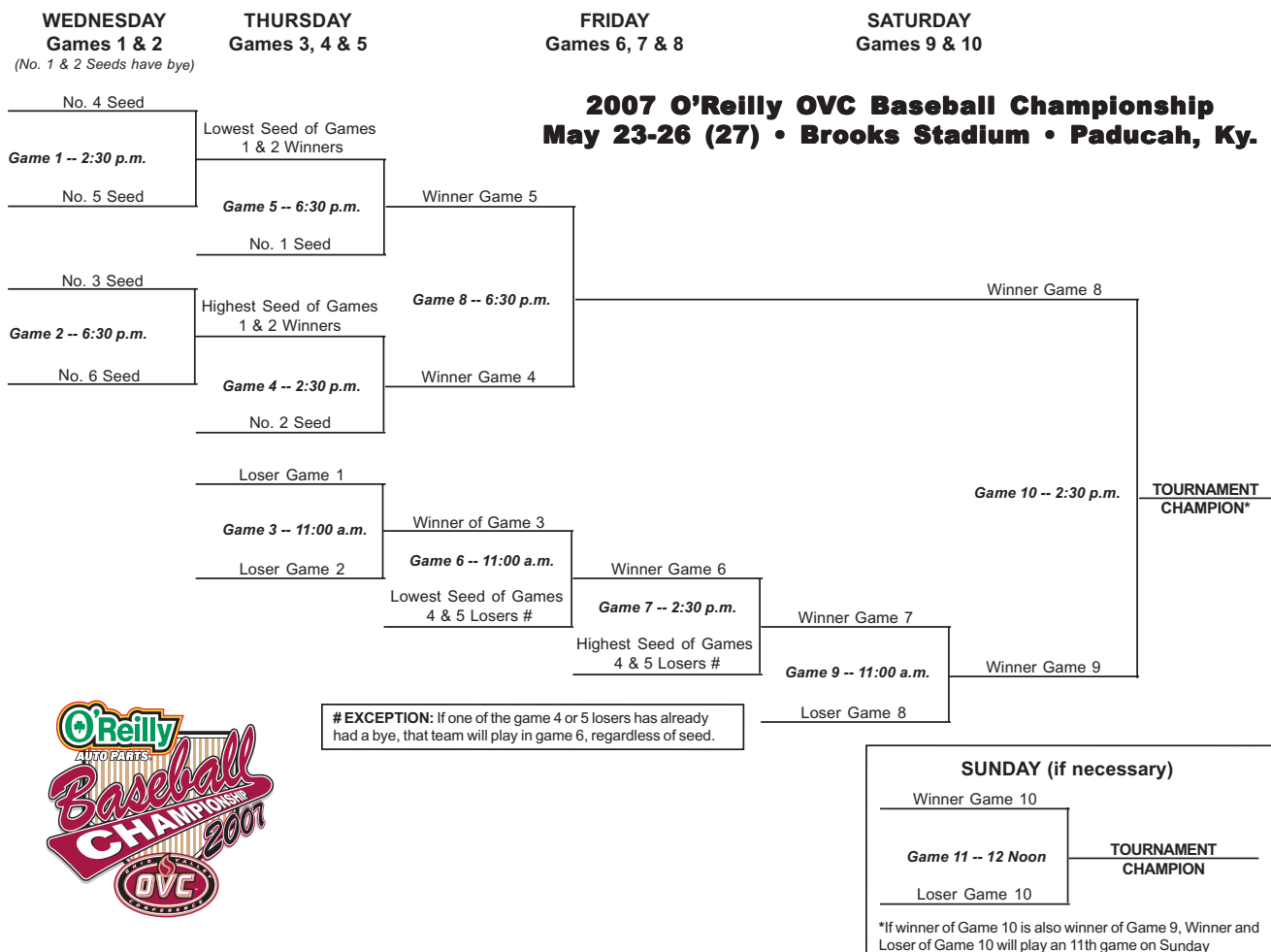
