**THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK****PLAYER****ERIK HUBER • 1B, SR., 6'6 • BELLEVILLE, ILL. • EASTERN ILLINOIS**

Huber hit .684 (13-for-19) with eight runs, four doubles, a home run and six RBI as Eastern Illinois was 4-1 last week. Huber had multiple hits in all five games in extending his hitting streak to a career-best 21 games. In the doubleheader sweep of UT Martin on Sunday, Huber went 6-for-6 with a two-run homer, three doubles, five RBI and five runs scored. He posted his fourth career four-hit game in the middle game of the series and tied his personal-best with four RBI. He finished the series 8-for-10 to improve to 16-for-23 (.696) in OVC play this season. He leads the Conference in batting average (.468), on-base percentage (.509) and slugging percentage (.798).

**PITCHER****DONOVAN HAND • RHP, JR., 6'4 • HATTON, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE**

Hand picked up his second consecutive Pitcher of the Week award (and fourth of his career) by winning his third straight decision on Sunday. He allowed just four hits in 8.0 innings in a 7-2 road win over Samford. Opponents hit just .133 against the right-hander as he recorded five strikeouts and did not walk a batter. Samford hit just .111 with runners on-base and .125 with two outs. Hand had eight fly ball outs and 12 ground ball outs and did not allow any stolen bases. Hand is 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA in two OVC outings this season as Jacksonville State has started the Conference season with a 6-0 record, the only team to be undefeated after two weekends of OVC play.

## TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

**AUSTIN PEAY (16-10, 3-3 OVC):** A week after being swept in its OVC opening series, Austin Peay completed a three-game sweep of Morehead State to even its Conference record. The Governors also split a pair of non-conference games, losing 9-8 to Middle Tennessee and topping Evansville 7-1. Freshman catcher **Trey Lucas** hit .556 (10-for-18) last week with seven runs, three home runs and 11 RBI. He belted a pair of three-run home runs during the Middle Tennessee contest and followed that with a 3-for-4 performance against Evansville. He drove in four in the sweep of Morehead State. Senior lefty **Matt Reynolds** picked up his fifth victory of the season in a 3-1 pitcher's duel at Morehead State. He allowed a home run to the second batter he faced and trailed into the fifth inning but went seven innings and struck out seven as APSU rallied to win. Reynolds leads the OVC in wins (5) and innings pitched (6.17/game). The Govs scored an impressive 48 runs in the three-game weekend series, including 28 in the finale, a game where they had a school record 33 hits. The 48 runs in the three games is more than six OVC teams have scored so far in Conference play this season. Two players - **Josh Meeker** and **Tyler Farrar** - each went 5-for-7 in the contest, the first time since 1998 that two players had five hits in the same game. Junior **Will Hogue** has a hit in 17 of his last 18 games. Austin Peay leads the OVC in fielding percentage (.972). The Govs will host Western Kentucky on Tuesday and then nationally-ranked Vanderbilt, a team that was as high as No. 3 in last week's polls. Vandy topped Austin Peay 8-0 earlier this season when they were No. 1. The Govs host Samford for a three-game set this weekend.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (11-12, 4-2 OVC):** Eastern Illinois won a pair of non-conference games to begin last week - 9-1 over Saint Louis and 5-4 at Indiana State - before taking two of three on the road at UT Martin over the weekend. Senior first baseman **Erik Huber** had another impressive week, going 13-for-19 (.684) at the plate, scoring eight runs and driving in six in earning OVC Player of the Week honors. Huber, whose .468 batting average, .509 on-base percentage and .798 slugging percentage each lead the OVC and should rank high nationally when the first set of NCAA leaders are released on April 9, had multiple hits in all five games during the week while extending his hitting streak to a career-high 21 games, a mark that is tied for the longest in EIU history since it joined the OVC. He was 6-for-6 with a pair of home runs in Sunday's doubleheader sweep of the Skyhawks. Huber had his fourth career four-hit game in the second game against UTM. Huber is hitting an amazing .696 (16-for-23) in six OVC games this season. Senior pitcher **Chris Vaculik** picked up a victory this week, tossing four shutout innings against Saint Louis. **Richie Derbak** picked up a save against Indiana State and a win in the second game against UTM. At the plate Derbak knocked in the go-ahead run in his three-RBI performance against ISU and tied the UTM finale at four with a two-out, two-run single in EIU's four-run fifth inning. **Ryan Campbell** broke EIU's all-time at-bats record last week and moved into second place on the school's all-time hits list as well. EIU is 7-2 since returning from its spring break trip and will host Saint Xavier in a non-conference game on Tuesday; St. X reached the NAIA World Series a year ago. The Panthers host Murray State in OVC play this weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-11-1, 4-2 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky had not played a true road game this season until last week, when they played all four games away from home. After starting the season with 14 home games and seven games at neutral sites, the Colonels dropped a 6-4 decision at Miami (Ohio) on Tuesday. EKU then lost two of three games at Tennessee Tech to fall to 4-2 in OVC play this year. Sophomore second baseman **Matt Davis** hit .467 (7-for-15) with four runs and five RBI last week. He was 2-for-3 with his first home run of the season in the 6-5 win over TTU in the series opener and 3-for-5 with a RBI in the loss at Miami. Davis slugged .733 and had an on-base percentage of .556 last week. Sophomore **Christian Friedrich** struck out 11 batters in his only appearance last week as he worked seven innings and got a no-decision against the Golden Eagles. Friedrich is second in the OVC in E.R.A. (2.15) while opponents are hitting just .174 against him this season, a mark that leads all OVC hurlers. He is also averaging 11.47 strikeouts per nine innings, also first in the Conference. Junior **Clint Seymour** tallied a career-best five RBI in the 9-8 loss to Tennessee Tech. EKU is 12-0 this year when leading after six innings and 11-2 when scoring six or more runs in a game. The Colonels will have a chance to avenge the loss to Miami (Ohio) this Tuesday, when the RedHawks play in Richmond. Eastern hosts UT Martin for a three-game set this weekend.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (16-13, 6-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State lost a non-conference game at Troy to start the week before sweeping in-state rival Samford to improve to a perfect 6-0 in OVC games this season. JSU is the only remaining undefeated player in the League and will play second place Southeast Missouri this weekend. Junior **Donovan Hand** won his second straight OVC Pitcher of the Week honor and the fourth award in his three-year career. Hand pitched eight innings and struck out five batters and did not walk anyone, in topping the Bulldogs 7-2 on Sunday. Hand is now 2-0 with a 2.12 ERA in OVC games this season. Junior **Clay Whittemore**, last week's Player of the Week, after hitting .429 (6-for-14) with six runs, three RBI and two stolen bases. Whittemore leads the OVC in hits (45) and is third in batting average (.405). Senior **Garrett Bass** currently has the longest active hitting streak in the League at 22 games; he is batting .391 (34-for-87) with 21 runs, 15 RBI, seven doubles, two triples and a home run during the streak. The hitting streak is the second longest under JSU head coach **Jim Case**. Jacksonville State has now topped rival Samford in six straight games and in 15 of its last 18 contests. Senior **Jake Ball** has now played in more games than any over Gamecock, appearing in 192 games during his four-year career (187 which were starts). Ball leads the team and is second in the OVC with 13 multiple-hit games this season and has 57 in his career. Reliever **Alex Jones** is tied for the League lead in appearances (15). JSU's only contests this week are

at Southeast Missouri on Friday and Saturday. The battle between the first and second place teams in the OVC could play a big part in determining a possible OVC champion later in the season. Jax State has won two of three against SEMO in each of the past three seasons.

**MOREHEAD STATE (4-21, 0-6 OVC):** Morehead State had a game with No. 8 Kentucky rained out last week; the two teams will try to reschedule the game for a date later this season. In the action that was not rained out, the Eagles were swept at home by Austin Peay to fall to 0-6 in the Conference. Morehead is the only OVC team without a Conference win so far this season and have lost 10 in a row overall. Freshman **Drew Lee** hit .545 last week, netting a home run and four RBI. Lee had a .909 slugging and a .615 on-base percentage during the week. Junior shortstop **Nick Nail** made his first career collegiate pitching appearance on Sunday. He gave up a home run but has consistently throwing in the upper 80's and may see more pitching action later this season. The Morehead staff could use his help, as they are last in the OVC in E.R.A. (9.42). **Christian Winstanley** ranks ninth in the Conference in hitting (.357). The Eagles lead the OVC in stolen bases (52). Morehead State will host Alice Lloyd in non-conference action on Tuesday before hosting Tennessee Tech this weekend.

**MURRAY STATE (6-19, 3-3 OVC):** The Thoroughbreds lost a non-conference game to Belmont and then dropped two of three to Southeast Missouri State at home over the weekend. Sophomore **Tyler Owen** hit .889 (8-for-9) in three games last week, driving in five runs for Murray State. He slugged 1.333 and had an on-base percentage of .909 for the week and was error-free in eight chances in the field. Owen ranks sixth in the OVC in batting average (.385). Freshman pitcher **Matt McGaha** allowed one earned run in eight innings of work last week as he held Southeast to one run and three hits in middle relief over the weekend. He worked five innings as a starter in the Belmont contest. Murray State will play a three-game set at Eastern Illinois this weekend.

**SAMFORD (14-16, 1-5 OVC):** Samford took a pair from intra-city rival UAB to begin the week and then was swept by in-state rival Jacksonville State over the weekend. The games against UAB were both exciting, as both featured late inning comebacks. Samford trailed entering the ninth inning of both contests but came out on top each time. The Bulldogs trailed Tuesday night at UAB by an 11-7 mark, and scored five times to win 12-11. Wednesday at home they trailed 4-2 but scored three times in the bottom of the ninth for the walk-off victory. The middle game of the JSU series marked a one-run loss for Samford, their fifth one-run loss this season. Junior **Luke Peavy** hit .313 (5-for-16) with a home run and seven RBI during the five games last week. **Parker Gargis** leads the OVC in home runs (10) while closer **Joseph Edens** is the League leader in saves (7) and appearances (15). Samford will play a three-game series at Austin Peay this weekend.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (19-8, 5-1 OVC):** Southeast Missouri was 4-1 last week to improve to 19-8 on the season; the 19 wins are the most among any OVC team at this point of the season. The Redhawks are 5-1 in the Conference, one game behind

leader Jacksonville State; the 5-1 start is the second time the program has achieved that mark since joining the Conference. SEMO won a pair of non-conference games at home against Freed-Hardeman to begin the week, including scoring a school-record 27 runs in the series finale. Southeast hit three grand slams in that contest, tying an NCAA record done seven times previously. The two teams combined for 43 runs in the contest, also a program record. Head Coach **Mark Hogan** made program history on Sunday in his team's 17-3 win over Murray State. The win was the 374th for the skipper at Southeast Missouri, allowing him to pass Joe Uhls (373 wins from 1960-84) for the most wins in school history; Hogan is in his 13th year at SEMO. Murray State won the series finale from the Redhawks, snapping a seven-game winning streak; Southeast is 8-2 in its last 10 games overall and 14-4 in home games this year. Freshman **Nick Harris** hit .348 (8-for-23) with six runs, four home runs and 10 RBI last week. He slugged .913 for the week and increased his home run total to eight on the season (second in the OVC). He hit one of the team's three grand slams against Freed-Hardeman, his second bases loaded blast of the season. Harris leads the OVC in runs (33) while **Asif Shah** leads the League in RBI (31). Junior **Dustin Renfrow**, who leads the OVC with a 1.40 E.R.A., pitched seven scoreless innings against Murray State, but got a no-decision in a contest the Redhawks would win 6-5 in 11 innings after blowing a 5-0 lead entering the ninth inning. As a team, Southeast leads the OVC in 14 different statistical categories. Southeast will travel to Springfield, Mo. to battle rival Missouri State on Tuesday and Wednesday before hosting OVC leader Jacksonville State this weekend.

**TENNESSEE TECH (16-10, 3-3 OVC):** Tennessee Tech had a game with Tennessee rained out early in the week and then won two of three at home against Eastern Kentucky to even its OVC record at 3-3 on the season. Junior **Thomas Nelson** hit .500 (5-for-10) with four runs, two home runs and five RBI last week; Nelson ranks fourth in the OVC in hitting (.394) while teammate **Steve Soper** is second (.418). Senior **Matt Smith** picked up his third victory of the season over the weekend, going six innings and striking out eight against EKU. Smith is fourth in the OVC in E.R.A. (2.45). On Sunday, a two-out single by senior **Brian Sprowl** was the difference, as Tech came from behind to top the Colonels 9-8. As a team Tennessee Tech leads the OVC in batting average (.313) and is fourth in E.R.A. (4.70). Tech is 12-5 in home games this season. The Golden Eagles will play at Middle Tennessee on Tuesday and then host the Blue Raiders on Wednesday in non-conference action. TTU will play at Morehead State in OVC play this weekend.

**UT MARTIN (8-18, 1-5 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin split a pair of non-conference games last week, topping Arkansas State at home and losing to Southern Illinois on the road, before taking one of three games at home to Eastern Illinois over the weekend. The Skyhawks were close against the Panthers, winning a one-run game and losing a one-run affair, both by identical 8-7 margins. Senior **Adam Ledlow** moved up to No. 4 on the school's career innings pitched list (216.2) during the week. He is tied for fourth in career appearances (67) in UTM history. Junior **Chris Rezakabek** hit his first two home runs of the season last week, both against Eastern Illinois. Senior **Chad Green** was a perfect 3-for-3 in stolen bases last week and is 8-for-10 on the season. The Skyhawks will travel to Lipscomb on Tuesday and at Eastern Kentucky in an OVC series this weekend.

**OVCSports.TV:** For the first time this season, the Ohio Valley Conference is offering live and on-demand streaming video/audio straight to your computer during the 2007 season. This feature can be accessed through the league's Official Web Site, OVCSports.com, or directly through OVCSports.TV. Subscription packages for baseball start at \$15.95 for the season. There are no live broadcasts this week.

**Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite:** Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

**Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists:** The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

**O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again:** For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

**OVC Players in Major League Baseball:** To begin the 2007 Major League Baseball season, five former Ohio Valley Conference players find themselves playing at the highest level of professional baseball. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC), Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington) and Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson (Boston).

**OVC Against Ranked Teams:** So far this season, OVC schools have matched up in 21 games against ranked foes. The League schools are 4-17 in those contests. The teams that scored victories so far this season include Eastern Illinois (over No. 30 Evansville and No. 30 College of Charleston), Tennessee Tech (over No. 13 Alabama) and Samford (over No. 22 Alabama).

**Hogan Sets Southeast Missouri All-Time Victories Mark:** Southeast Missouri State head coach **Mark Hogan** established a new Southeast Missouri State head coaching victories mark with his 374th victory at SEMO in a 17-3 victory over Murray State on Saturday, March 31. The victory put his past Joe Uhls, who had 373 victories in his career. Hogan, in his 13th season at Southeast Missouri, has amassed more than 750 career victories in 26 years, which included stops at Lurleen B. Wallace Community College and West Alabama before coming to Cape Girardeau.

**Southeast Ties NCAA Grand Slam Record:** With hitting three grand slams in a 27-16 victory over Freed-Hardeman on March 28, Southeast Missouri State tied the NCAA record for grand slams in a single game. The Redhawks are the eighth team to hit three grand slams in a game and first since Youngstown State did so against Oakland University on May 6, 2001. The grand slams came off the bats of **Asif Shah**, **Phillip Riley** and **Nick Harris**. The 27 runs in the game was a Southeast Missouri record (breaking a mark of 24 set in 1985 and equaled in 2001) as was the combined 43 runs by the two teams (breaking a record of 38 set in 1977).

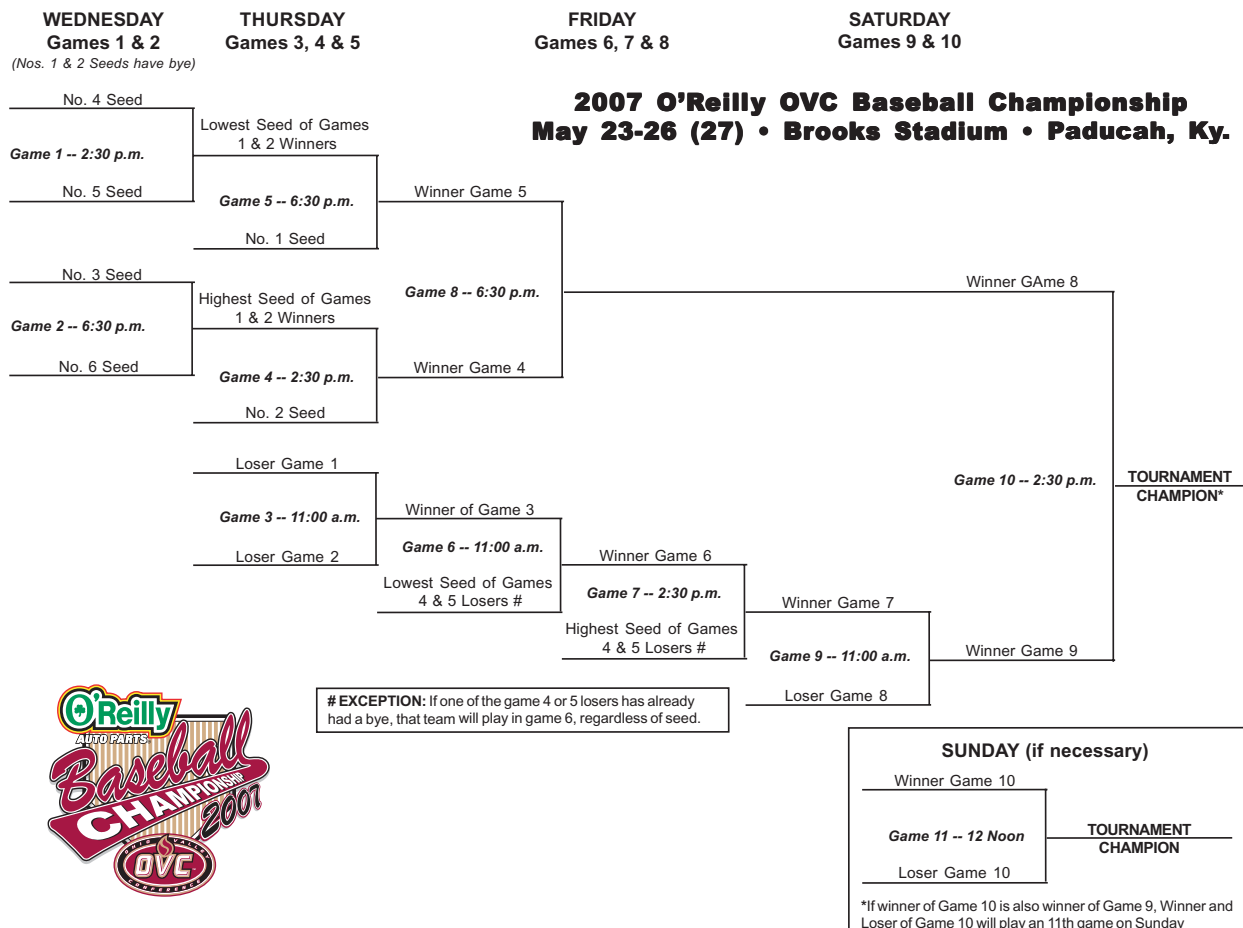
