PLAYER

LUCAS WATERS • INF, JR., 6'0 • STEARNS, KY. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Waters hit .600 (12-for-20) last week with 10 runs scored, three doubles, a home run and nine RBI in five games. He had a .600 on-base percentage, a .900 slugging percentage and was a perfect 5-for-5 in stolen bases. Waters was 8-for-13 (.615) with five RBI in the Colonels three-game OVC series with Jacksonville State over the weekend. He was 3-for-4 with three runs scored and two RBI in EKU's 16-9 victory over the Gamecocks on Sunday. He was also 3-for-4 with two RBI and four runs scored in a 14-3 win over Marshall on Tuesday. Waters' .439 batting average in 10 total Conference games ranks third in the OVC.

PITCHER

SHAWN KELLEY • RHP, SR., 6'2 • LOUISVILLE, KY. • AUSTIN PEAY

Kelley picked up his second honor in three weeks after tossing a nine-inning complete game against Southeast Missouri on Saturday. Kelley notched his fourth complete game of the season and OVC-best seventh victory in the 4-2 win over the Redhawks, who had entered the weekend in first place in the Conference. Kelley allowed a one-out single in the first and then retired the next 21 batters he faced before allowing a one-out single and a two-out, two-run home run in the eighth. His lone walk came to the leadoff batter in the ninth, but he induced a double play and then a groundout to complete the effort. He faced just three batters over the minimum and struck out a season-high eight batters. Kelley ranks fifth in the League in E.R.A. (2.69) and first in innings pitched (73.2). Kelley has now been named OVC Pitcher of the Week four times in his career.

TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

AUSTIN PEAY (22-17, 9-6 OVC): Austin Peay lost a two-game home-and-home set with Memphis during the week and then won two of three games against then first-place Southeast Missouri over the weekend. The weekend matchup featured the top two pitching teams in the Conference and the Governors came out on top 4-2 and 4-0 in a doubleheader on Saturday before dropping a crazy 16-14, 12-inning game on Sunday. That final game lasted five hours and seven minutes and saw APSU blow an eight-run lead in the seventh inning. The teams combined for 30 runs and 43 hits in the affair. Senior **Shawn Kelley** earned his second OVC Pitcher of the Week honor in the past three weeks, tossing a nine-inning complete game in the 4-2 Saturday win. Kelley (who won the award for the fourth time in his career) allowed a single in the first inning then retired the next 21 batters before allowing two hits in the eighth. He walked his only batter in the ninth and finished with a season-high eight strikeouts to improve to 7-2 on the season. Kelley leads the OVC in wins (7) and innings pitched (73.2) and is fifth in E.R.A. (2.69) and second in complete games (4). As a team the Govs still rank second in E.R.A. (4.12) as well as leading the Conference in fielding (.968), a mark that was in the top 50 nationally in last week's NCAA statistical rankings. Austin Peay has had 10 or more hits in seven of its last nine games and is hitting .309 in that stretch. APSU will travel to Western Kentucky and Evansville for non-conference games this week before playing a three-game set at UT Martin this weekend. The Governors find themselves in fourth place in the OVC, just percentage points behind Murray State in third. UT Martin enters the weekend in ninth place overall.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (17-17, 7-7 OVC): Eastern Illinois won a pair of non-conference games to begin last week - against Millikin and at Saint Louis - and won the first game of a Conference series with Samford before dropping the final two games against the Bulldogs. EIU has now evened its overall record and OVC record at .500. Sophomore **Brett Nommensen** blistered the baseball at a .643 (9-for-14) clip last week, netting five runs, three doubles and two RBI. He was 8-for-10 (.800) in the Samford series. Senior pitcher **Chris Vaculik** won his 20th career game with a nine-inning complete game effort in the 3-2 victory over Samford. Vaculik struck out eight, walked only one and surrendered just six hits. As a starter in OVC play, Vaculik is 3-0 with a 1.57 E.R.A. and 18 strikeouts in 23 innings of work. Overall his 2.17 E.R.A. in six OVC appearances ranks third in the League. **Brandon Murphy**, the last Panther pitcher to toss a nine-inning complete game prior to Vaculik, pitched five shutout innings last week in the 12-1 win over Millikin; he also pitched on Sunday, allowing just two runs through seven innings but took the defeat in the 4-2 loss to Samford. In that game he retired 13 of the first 14 batters he faced and did not allow a hit until the fifth inning. **Ryan Campbell** had three extra-base hits in the extra-inning win over Saint Louis and finished the week 8-for-20 (.400) with four RBI. Senior **Erik Huber** continues to battle injuries and had to settle for two pinch-hit opportunities over the weekend; he has a .454 batting average in 28 games this season. The Panthers will play at Illinois on Tuesday then host Illinois State on Wednesday. The team travels to second-place Southeast Missouri for a weekend series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (16-19-1, 6-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split non-conference games last week, topping Marshall and losing in extra innings to Xavier, before losing two of three at home to Jacksonville State. After dropping the first two games to JSU by margins of 8-4 and 9-6, the Colonels rebounded with a 16-9 victory in the finale to remain in seventh place in the OVC standings, percentage points behind Tennessee Tech for sixth place (the top six teams make the OVC Tournament). Junior infielder **Lucas Waters** was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .600 (12-for-20) with 10 runs, three doubles, a home run and nine RBI last week. Waters had a .600 on-base percentage and a .900 slugging percentage and was a perfect 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts. He was 8-for-13 in the JSU series, including a 3-for-4 performance with three runs and a pair of RBI in Sunday's victory. Waters is hitting .478 in 10 Conference games this season, a mark that is third in the OVC. EKU has hit 13 home runs in its last five games after hitting just eight in its first 31 games of the season. In the fifth inning of the 16-9 win over the Gamecocks, **Dylan McMaine**, **Clint Seymour** and **Shawn Flora** hit back-to-back-to-back home runs. Sophomore Christian Friedrich is still second in the OVC in E.R.A. (2.40), he leads the OVC in strikeouts (66) and is second in opponent batting average (.179). In last week's NCAA statistical rankings, Friedrich was fifth in strikeouts-per-nine-inning (12.22), a spot he should remain in this week. Offensively, freshman **Matt Davis** is sixth in the OVC in batting (.371). McMaine leads the OVC in triples (4). The Colonels will play at Marshall and host Western Kentucky this week before playing three at Samford this weekend. It will be a key series for both teams, as the squads both have six wins in Conference play with four weekends of play left.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (23-18, 11-4 OVC): Jacksonville State split a home-and-home non-conference series with in-state foe UAB last week before winning two of three games at Eastern Kentucky to reclaim sole possession of first place in the OVC. The Gamecocks are now a game in front of Southeast Missouri a little more than halfway through the League schedule. JSU continues to be an offensive juggernaut, leading the OVC in team batting (.309) as well as runs, hits, RBI, doubles and triples. Junior **Clay Whittemore** had another good week, hitting .526 (10-for-19) with four runs, three doubles, a home run and 10 RBI in five games. He had four multi-hit games (and leads the OVC with 21 on the year) last week and has eight in his last nine games overall. For his career he has 40 multiple-hit games in 95 career games (42.1%). His .424 batting average is now second in the League, while his .448 average in OVC-only games is second. Whittemore leads the OVC in hits (67) and RBI (46). Senior hurler **Tony Drinkard** earned his fifth victory of the season, notching a career-high seven strikeouts in an 8-4 road win at EKU. He did not allow a walk and scattered six hits in 6.2 innings of work. Senior **Jake Ball** extended his hitting streak to 15 games, the longest active streak in the Conference and the fourth longest streak overall this season in the OVC. Ball increased his school records for games played (204) and career starts (199) last week and he needs just

14 hits to tie the school record in that category. JSU will host Troy on Tuesday night before hosting Morehead State this weekend for three games.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-27, 4-11 OVC): Morehead State had an up-and-down week, beginning with a 9-6 victory over No. 27 Kentucky in Lexington. They followed that up by dropping a 23-5 decision to Lindsey Wilson at home before losing two of three at home to Murray State over the weekend. Murray State outscored the Eagles 32-21 in the three games. Junior **Nick Nail** had a good week, hitting .500 (5-for-10) while not committing an error at shortstop. Senior **Nick Bobrowski** hit .375 a week ago and drove in a team high 11 runs. Against Murray on Sunday, Bobrowski had a triple and his first career home run. Senior **Dustin Miles** has tied the Morehead State record for career stolen bases (47); Miles is tied for third in the OVC in stolen bases this season (14). As a team Morehead ranks first in the OVC in stolen bases (78), a mark that was in the top 12 nationally in last week's NCAA rankings. The 78 steals is seven away from the program's single-season record of 85 set in 1993. Senior pitcher **Henry Mabee** has completed four of his five OVC starts; he is tied for second in the League in complete games. MSU will host Berea on Tuesday afternoon before traveling to league-leading Jacksonville State for three games this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (14-23, 8-5 OVC): Murray State continues to be one of the hottest teams in the League, having won eight of its last 10 games and jumping into third place in the OVC standings. The 8-5 Conference start is nice after having a 6-18 non-conference mark so far this season. Senior **Seth Hudson** hit .609 (14-for-23) with seven runs, a double, two triples, four RBI and two stolen bases in five contests last week. He extended his hitting streak to 13 games, the second longest active streak in the Conference. Hudson is fourth in the OVC in batting (.395), just behind teammate **Tyler Owen**, who ranks third (.409). Owen was 5-for-5 in Sunday's 13-6 win over Morehead State. He hit .692 (9-for-13) in the MSU series and .571 (12-for-21) for the week. In OVC-only games, Owen's .522 batting average is tops in the League while Hudson is 10th (.396). Junior **Austin Swain** leads the Conference in walks (27). **Tyler Pittman** is just two doubles away from tying Murray's career record (54). Freshman pitcher **Brad Rowland** appeared in three games last week, pitching 9.2 innings and striking out nine, while picking up a victory and a save. Murray State's .327 batting average in OVC-only games is first in the League. The Thor-oughbreds will travel to No. 18 Ole Miss on Tuesday before hosting Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

SAMFORD (20-20, 6-9 OVC): Samford won three of its four games last week, including two of three OVC games at Eastern Illinois, to even its record at 20-20 on the season. The Bulldogs topped Auburn in a non-conference game before traveling to EIU last week. Junior **Bill Whitehead** hit .667 (4-for-6) with two RBI in the weekend series against the Panthers. He was 3-for-4 in the 7-6 win on Saturday and smashed a home run on Sunday to tie the game at 1-1 (Samford would go on to win 4-2). Senior hurler **Chandler Tidwell** pitched 8.2 innings on Sunday, allowing 10 hits and striking out three in picking up the victory. Tidwell is now 3-3 on the season and his 2.42 E.R.A. ranks third in the OVC. Senior **Joseph Edens** increased his League-leading saves total to 10 last week. So far this season, Samford has won both of its road OVC series and dropped all three of its home OVC series. The Bulldogs will play at Alabama on Wednesday before

hosting Eastern Kentucky this weekend. Samford and ECU have the same number of wins in the OVC race (6), setting this weekend up to potentially be crucial to which team may or may not make the OVC Tournament this season.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (25-15, 10-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri topped regional rival Southern Illinois in non-conference action before losing two of three games at Austin Peay over the weekend. The losses to the Governors dropped SEMO from first place in the Conference, as the Redhawks are now a game behind Jacksonville State. DH **Phillip Riley** hit .571 (4-for-7) with a pair of home runs and four RBI last week; Riley slugged 1.429. He hit a two-run, pinch hit home run in game one of the series, the Redhawks only runs of that game. In the finale, Southeast trailed Austin Peay by eight runs in the seventh inning but rallied for a 16-14 victory in 12 innings. The game lasted five hours and seven minutes, the longest game for the Redhawks since joining the Division I ranks in 1992. **Omar Padilla** set a new Southeast record with eight at-bats in the marathon contest (the old record was 7). **Nick Harris** tied a school record with five runs scored, becoming the fourth player in program history to achieve that feat; Harris leads the OVC in runs scored (44) and total bases (91). **Matt Wagner** and Riley hit back-to-back home runs in a six-run sixth inning on Sunday, the first Southeast players to do so since May 2005. Despite allowing 24 runs in the three games to APSU, Southeast continues to lead the League in E.R.A. (3.91). Taking a loss against Austin Peay, **Dustin Renfrow** saw his E.R.A. fall slightly to 1.69 (his 1.47 E.R.A. was 11th nationally last week). **Asif Shah** also suffered a loss against APSU and saw his E.R.A. slip to 2.69 (from 2.26), which is now fourth in the OVC. Southeast will play a two-game home set with Memphis this week before hosting Eastern Illinois for three this weekend. EIU is now 7-7 in the OVC, three games behind the Redhawks.

TENNESSEE TECH (20-19, 7-8 OVC): Tennessee Tech began the week by losing 8-6 at Belmont, the team's seventh consecutive loss. But the ship was righted over the weekend, as the Golden Eagles swept past UT Martin in a crucial OVC series. That improved Tech to 7-8 in the Conference, putting them in sixth place just over halfway through the schedule. Junior **Jake New** hit .438 (7-for-16) with five runs, a double, two triples and four RBI last week. New's 11-game hitting streak is the third longest active streak in the OVC. TTU continues to hit the ball well, as they are second in the OVC in batting average (.307). Senior **Steve Soper** is fifth in batting average (.392); his 17 multi-hit games this season in fourth in the OVC. Soper also leads the League in doubles (17). Senior **Matt Smith** ranks sixth in the OVC in E.R.A. (3.20) while freshman **Jared Dobbs** is seventh (3.43). Tennessee Tech will battle No. 1-ranked Vanderbilt on Wednesday before traveling to Murray State for a three-game OVC series this weekend.

UT MARTIN (13-26, 4-10 OVC): Tennessee-Martin lost to Arkansas State and topped Lyon College in non-conference action this week before being swept in OVC play at Tennessee Tech over the weekend. As a team the Skyhawks hit only .248, although **Blake Turner** (.455) and **Jason Hockaday** (.429) both hit over .400 in the six games. Senior **Chad Green** stole four bases during the week. He has successfully stolen 14 of 17 bases on the year and is two steals away from the UTM single-season top 10. Green has 19 career swipes and needs nine more to move into the Skyhawk career steals top 10. Junior **Kyle Dudley** is 10th overall in the League in batting average (.347). UT Martin will host in-state foes Belmont and Lipscomb mid-week before hosting Austin Peay for three over the weekend.

Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite: Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists: The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again: For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

EIU's Schmitz Picks Up 500th Career Victory: Eastern Illinois head coach **Jim Schmitz** picked up his 500th career victory on Saturday, March 24 as EIU topped Tennessee Tech 9-7 in the opening game of a doubleheader. Schmitz, who is in his 13th year at EIU after stints at Wilmington and Cincinnati, has recorded 336 of his victories at Eastern Illinois. Schmitz has been tabbed OVC Coach of the Year three times in his career (1998, 1999, 2001).

Hogan Sets Southeast Missouri All-Time Victories Mark: Southeast Missouri State head coach **Mark Hogan** established a new Southeast Missouri State head coaching victories mark with his 374th victory at SEMO in a 17-3 victory over Murray State on Saturday, March 31. The victory put his past Joe Uhls, who had 373 victories in his career. Hogan, in his 13th season at Southeast Missouri, has amassed more than 750 career victories in 26 years, which included stops at Lurleen B. Wallace Community College and West Alabama before coming to Cape Girardeau.

Southeast Ties NCAA Grand Slam Record: With hitting three grand slams in a 27-16 victory over Freed-Hardeman on March 28, Southeast Missouri State tied the NCAA record for grand slams in a single game. The Redhawks are the eighth team to hit three grand slams in a game and first since Youngstown State did so against Oakland University on May 6, 2001. The grand slams came off the bats of **Asif Shah**, **Phillip Riley** and **Nick Harris**. The 27 runs in the game was a Southeast Missouri record (breaking a mark of 24 set in 1985 and equaled in 2001) as was the combined 43 runs by the two teams (breaking a record of 38 set in 1977).

Cold/Rain Forces Cancellation of League Games: An early April cold front cancelled the final games of both the Murray State/Eastern Illinois and UT Martin/Eastern Kentucky series on April 7. This past weekend poor weather forced several teams to re-arrange their double-header and Murray State and Eastern Kentucky lost one of the three games in their series.

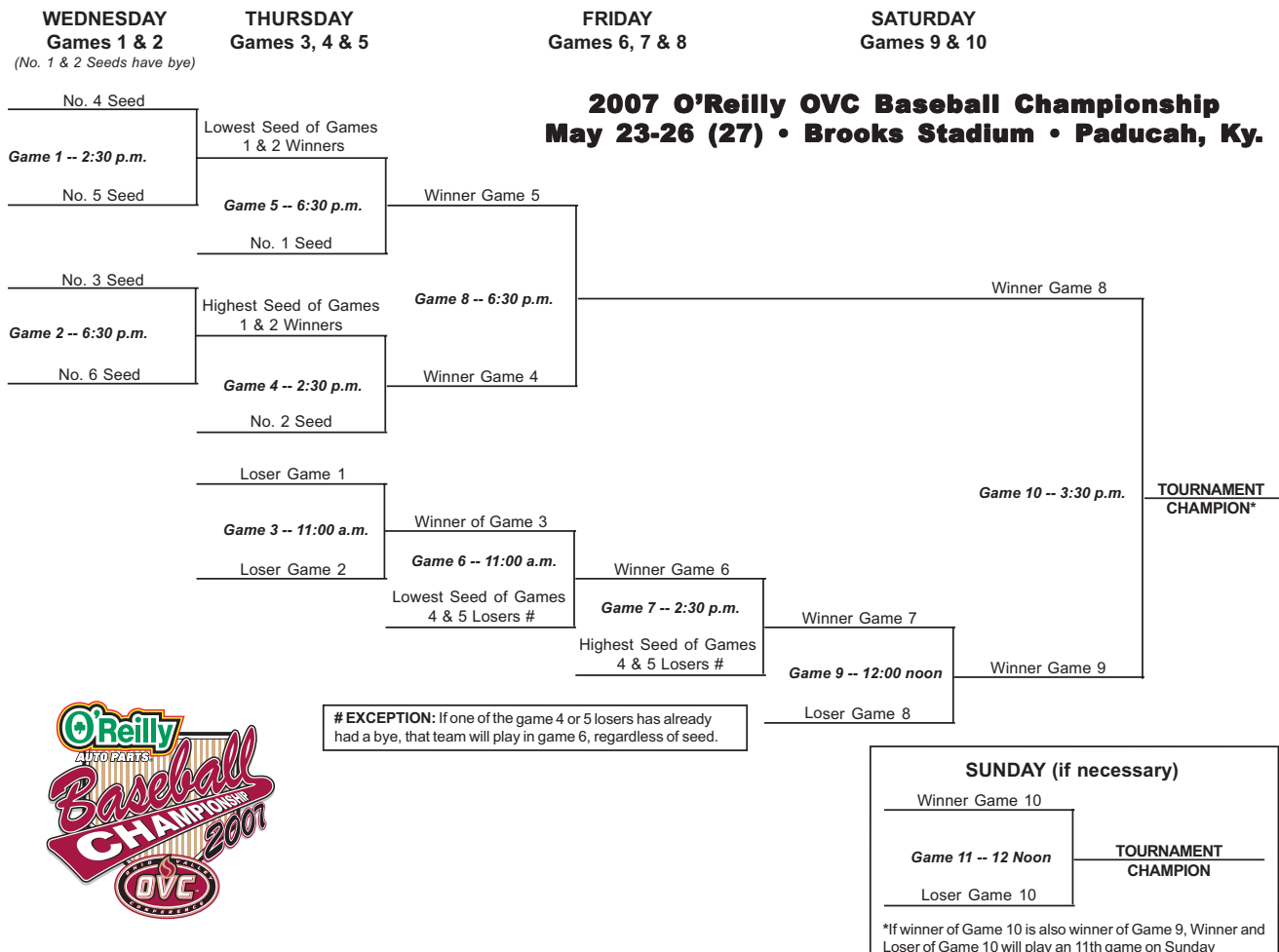
