THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**PLAYER****MICHAEL MARSECO • SS, SO., 5'8 • FT. LAUDERDALE, FLA. • SAMFORD**

Marseco his .500 (7-for-14) in three games last week as he helped Samford sweep Tennessee Tech and jump from ninth to sixth in the OVC standings and keep the team's postseason hopes alive. Marseco was 7-for-11 (.636) in Saturday's doubleheader sweep, netting two home runs (one of which was a grand slam) and eight RBI as the Bulldogs won 16-2 and 16-6 in must-win games. For the week he had a 1.000 slugging percentage and a .533 on-base percentage. Marseco also scored five runs in the three-game series and did not commit and error in the field. Marseco's .351 batting average leads the team and ranks 11th in the OVC; his 73 hits are tied for fourth in the Conference.

PITCHER**BEN TOOTLE • RHP, FR., 6'0 • OXFORD, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE**

Tootle recorded a career-high nine strikeouts in leading Jacksonville State to a 3-1 victory over Tennessee-Martin in Sunday's series finale. Over 7.2 innings, he limited the Skyhawks to five hits (all singles), a .179 batting average and one earned run in getting a no-decision. Tootle retired 11 batters in a row from the end of the fourth inning until the eighth and did not allow a hit after back-to-back singles in the fourth frame. Tootle is 5-2 on the season in 15 starts; his 61 strikeouts lead the Gamecocks squad. It marks the fourth time this season at JSU pitcher has earned the OVC Pitcher of the Week honor.

TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

AUSTIN PEAY (34-18, 17-7 OVC): Austin Peay took another step towards claiming its sixth OVC regular season championship and earning the No. 1 seed in next week's O'Reilly OVC Tournament, by winning two of three at Murray State. That was off the heels of topping No. 13 Mississippi State 3-2 (11 innings) and 7-5 in back-to-back days at home last week. Three wins against Eastern Kentucky this weekend guarantees them the outright title (two gains a share) while two wins and a Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri loss does also. If APSU ends up in a tie with JSU in the final standings, they will lose the tiebreaker as Jax State won the season series 3-0. The Governors ran their winning streak to 11 games with a 7-3 victory over Murray State in game one of the weekend series; at the time that was the second longest winning streak in the country (behind Rice's 13). Overall the team has won 13 of its last 15 OVC games and 14 of its last 16 games overall. **Jake Lane**, last week's Co-Player of the Week, had a pair of home runs and six RBI last week. He accounted for all three runs in a 3-2, 11-inning win over No. 13 Mississippi State. That included a walk-off solo home run in the 11th inning. **Shawn Kelley** is making a good case for Pitcher of the Year honors; the senior is 7-0 with a 2.48 E.R.A. in OVC play entering his final regular season start of the year. He tied Rowdy Hardy's mark for single-season Conference wins by an Austin Peay pitcher. He is third in the OVC in overall E.R.A. (2.44), while his Conference-only E.R.A. is second. The Gobs will play at Belmont on Tuesday before hosting ECU for three games this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (20-26, 9-14 OVC): Following a 14-1 non-conference victory at Chicago State (where the team matched a season-high run total) the Panthers returned home and dropped two of three games to Eastern Kentucky to fall to 9-14 in the OVC race, which puts them in eighth place entering the final weekend of play. EIU will need to win at least two games - if not three - to have a chance to make the six-team OVC Tournament field. Senior **Erik Huber** hit .444 (8-for-18) with five runs, two doubles, a home run and seven RBI in four games last week. He concluded his home career in style, with a walk-off single to lift the Panthers to a 4-3 win on Sunday afternoon. **Kory Peppenhorst** had a two-out, three-run home run in game one of the series to break a 6-6 tie and put EIU ahead in the seventh inning. The team, however, would go on to lose 10-9 in 10 innings. **Chris Vaculik** struck out seven in tossing a seven-inning complete game on Saturday. He surpassed the 200-strikeout plateau for his career and is just the third player in program history with more than 20 wins and 200 strikeouts. EIU will play at Southern Illinois on Tuesday and in a neutral site game (in Geneva, Ill. in suburban Chicago, the home of the Kane County Cougars, a Marlins Class A affiliate) against Northern Illinois on Wednesday. The Conference season closes this weekend at Morehead State.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (22-24-1, 11-10 OVC): Eastern Kentucky won two of three games at Eastern Illinois over the weekend to pull above .500 in Conference play and get closer to securing an OVC Tournament berth. The Colonels now find themselves in fourth place overall and can clinch a spot in the six-team event if they win one game over the weekend. Junior **Joe Oliver** hit .455 (5-for-11) with three runs, a double and three RBI in three games last week. He was 3-for-4 with three RBI in ECU's 10-9, 10-inning win on Saturday and scored a run in a 6-3 victory in game two of that doubleheader. Sophomore **Christian Friedrich** tossed a seven-inning complete game against EIU on Saturday, allowing four hits and three runs (only one of which was earned) while striking out six. He is now 4-3 on the season and is second in the Conference with a 2.23 E.R.A. His 86 strikeouts (11.27 per game) are first in the OVC and he continues to rank among the nation's leaders. **Matt Davis** powered the Colonel attack with a grand slam in the 6-3 victory on Saturday. **Lucas Waters** is now hitting .380 on the season, the fourth best mark in the Conference. **Tyler Barnett's** .412 average in Conference-only games is third-best in the OVC. Eastern will host Dayton in non-conference action before traveling to Austin Peay to close out Conference play this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (29-23, 16-8 OVC): Jacksonville State clinched a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Tournament by winning two of three against UT Martin at home over the weekend. The Gamecocks also won a non-conference game at Georgia State. JSU, the 2006 OVC Tournament Champions, are one game behind Austin Peay in the regular season championship and could win the title by winning one more game than the Governors do this weekend (Jax State has the head-to-head tiebreaker over APSU). Freshman **Ben Tootle** was named OVC Pitcher of the Week after striking out a career-high nine batters in 7.2 innings. Tootle allowed five hits (all singles) and one run in getting a no-decision. He retired 11 consecutive batters at one point before leaving in the eighth inning. Sophomore **Bert Smith** hit .471 (8-for-17) with eight runs, three doubles and three RBI in four games last week. He was also a perfect 5-for-5 in stolen bases and set the school's single-season record for steals (29). JSU hit .347 on the week and leads the Conference with a .313 team batting average. The Gamecocks had a stretch of six straight games with double-digit runs before scoring three in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader (a 4-3 loss). Junior **Clay Whittemore** had two multiple-hit games last week to increase his total to 28 on the season, a mark that leads the OVC. He has 83 hits this season and is just 11 away from the JSU single-season record of 94 set by Bobby Hicks in 2004. Senior **Jake Ball** increased his career hits total to 239, just two shy of the program's career record of 241 set by All-American Stewart Lee. Jacksonville State will host Kennesaw State in a non-conference game on Tuesday before traveling to Murray State for its final OVC series of the season this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (16-33, 9-15 OVC): Morehead State took one of three games at Southeast Missouri over the weekend and kept its hopes of an OVC Tournament berth alive. Sitting in ninth place in the Conference at 9-15, the Eagles will likely need to sweep Eastern Illinois this weekend or win two of three and get a lot of help from other teams in order to move up to the top six. Morehead played the Southeast series without shortstop **Nick Nail** who was injured in batting practice prior to Saturday's doubleheader. Freshman **Drew Lee** hit .417 on the week with two doubles in the SEMO series. Senior second baseman **Chris McCaslin** had a two-run home run and a two-run single in Sunday's 9-8 victory, where Morehead

State overcame a five-run deficit after six innings. Sophomore lefty **Tyler Lee** pitched three innings of no-hit relief in Sunday's win, netting a save in the process. He would have picked up the win in relief on Saturday, but was tagged with the loss as SEMO scored an unearned run in the eighth inning to win 3-2. Morehead State will close out the regular season this weekend by hosting Eastern Illinois. The Panthers and Eagles are equal in the Conference wins column (9) entering the weekend.

MURRAY STATE (17-31, 11-11 OVC): Murray State lost two of three at home to league-leading Austin Peay over the weekend to slip to 11-11 in the Conference and to fifth place in the standings with one weekend to play. The Thoroughbreds are in a pack of three teams with 11 victories while three other teams are just one or two wins behind and still in contention for an OVC Tournament berth. Two wins would guarantee Murray a spot in the six-team field. Senior **Tyler Pittman** hit .500 (6-for-12) last week with three runs scored and a pair of RBI. He set a new Murray State career hits record (223) and had an on-base percentage of .538 on the week. In the last two weeks Pittman has also set or tied Murray career records for at-bats and doubles. Sophomore pitcher **Anthony Stacy** got a victory in relief on Saturday, holding Austin Peay hitless over four innings, allowing the 'Breds to come-from-behind and win 7-6 in 10-innings. The win snapped Austin Peay's 11-game winning streak, which at the time was the second longest winning streak in the country. MSU will host Kentucky in a neutral-site game at Brooks Stadium in Paducah on Tuesday; that is the site of this year's OVC Tournament. The game starts at 6 p.m. and can be seen live on OVCSports.TV. The team will close out the season by hosting second-place Jacksonville State for three-games this weekend.

SAMFORD (26-26, 11-13 OVC): With its back against the wall, Samford made the most of its opportunities over the weekend, sweeping Tennessee Tech at home in a must-win series. The series victory was the first home Conference series win of the season for Samford. The Bulldogs entered last week in ninth place but with the sweep jumped to sixth in the standings; the top six teams will make next week's OVC Tournament which will be held in Paducah, Ky. The team still has some work to do, but can guarantee itself a spot with two victories at UT Martin next weekend. Sophomore **Michael Marseco** was named the OVC Player of the Week after hitting .500 (7-for-14) with five runs, a double, two home runs and eight RBI over the weekend. Marseco did all of his damage in Saturday's doubleheader sweep, going 7-for-11 with his two home runs, including a grand slam. He had a 1.000 slugging percentage for the week. Sophomore hurler **David Knapp** picked up a victory in game one of Saturday's doubleheader, allowing five hits and two runs while striking out eight in eight innings of work. The sweep was made possible in-part by **Parker Gargis** who had a three-run double in the bottom of the eighth inning on Sunday to lift the team to an 8-5 come-from-behind victory. Samford will close out the regular season with three games at UT Martin this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (30-20, 15-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri won a pair of games in its final at-bat on Saturday and then squandered a five-run lead in Sunday's finale against Morehead State to slip to third place in the standings entering the final week of play. The Redhawks have clinched a spot (and top three seed) in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Tournament but saw its chances to win its second regular season title probably come to an end. SEMO would need to sweep at Tennessee Tech this weekend and hope Austin Peay loses two of three at home to Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State loses two of three at Murray State. By securing a spot in the OVC

Tournament, the program did so for the 13th season in a row (every year under head coach **Mark Hogan**), which ties an OVC record (also held by Eastern Kentucky, 1981-93). Southeast won its 30th game of the season over the weekend, becoming the eighth squad in school history to reach that plateau; it is the seventh time the program has done that under Hogan and first since 2003. On Saturday Southeast entered its final at-bat of game one tied at 3-3 before a throwing error by Morehead State allowed the winning run to come home and score. In the second game it was senior **Daryl Graham** who singled in extra innings to give Southeast the 3-2, eight-inning victory. That was the team's sixth extra-inning game of the season; SEMO is 3-3 in those contests. Each of the team's last five games have been decided by one run; the team is 7-7 this year in one-run games. Sophomore **Matt Wagner** hit .727 (8-for-11) last week with two runs, a double and RBI in the MSU series. **Omar Padilla** was hit-by-pitch for the 27th time in his two-year career at Southeast Missouri over the weekend; that is now tied for the school record. **Dustin Renfrow** struck out eight on Saturday against the Eagles and continues to lead the OVC in E.R.A. (2.05). Southeast will play at Saint Louis on Tuesday and then close out the regular season this weekend at Tennessee Tech.

TENNESSEE TECH (24-26, 10-14 OVC): Tennessee Tech suffered a sweep at Samford over the weekend, hurting its chances of making the six-team OVC Tournament. The Golden Eagles slipped into seventh place, one game behind the Bulldogs, with three games to play. The team will need to win at home this weekend against Southeast Missouri to jump into the top six. Catcher **Steve Soper** hit a pair of home runs and drove in five during the weekend series. His two-run home run in the top of the eighth gave Tech a 5-4 lead, but the Golden Eagles surrendered that advantage in the bottom of the inning as they lost 8-5. Soper leads the team with a .376 average, a mark that is fifth in the Conference. **Sean Reilly** extended his hitting streak to 18 games, the third longest streak in the OVC this season. TTU leads the OVC in slugging percentage (.447) and is second in batting average (.306). Tech will play at Tennessee on Tuesday and then host third-place Southeast Missouri on Friday and Saturday to close out the regular season.

UT MARTIN (19-32, 7-16 OVC): With two losses to Jacksonville State over the weekend, Tennessee-Martin has been officially eliminated from contention from making the field of six for the 2007 OVC Tournament. The Skyhawks did pick up a 4-3 win over JSU in game two of Saturday's doubleheader, winning for only the third time on the road this season. **Blake Turner**, last week's OVC Co-Player of the Week, hit .364 (4-for-11) with two runs, a triple, home run and five RBI in the Jax State series. The triple was his fourth of the season, which is tied for third on the UTM single-season list; he needs one more three-bagger to move into the school's career top-10 list. **Jason Hockaday** continued to swing a hot bat, extending his hitting streak to 16 games, the fourth longest streak in the OVC this season (and second longest active streak). Junior **William Blackmon** had eight strikeouts in the team's 4-3 victory on Saturday. He has 59 strikeouts on the year, a mark that is ninth in the OVC; he is two strikeouts away from breaking into the Skyhawks' career top-10 for single-season strikeouts. With an appearance this weekend, **Travis Webb** has now made 26 this season, the third most in Tennessee-Martin single-season history. UTM will host Memphis in a neutral site game (Union City, Tenn.) on Tuesday and then close out the season with three games at home against suddenly hot Samford.

OTHER NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Close Races: Since the league switched a 27-game Conference schedule, this year's race is turning out to be one of the closest. Entering the final weekend of play the difference between first and last place is just 9.5 games; the closest top-to-margin finish in OVC history is 12.5 games in 2005. At the top of the standings three teams are vying for the title entering the final week of play. Austin Peay is 1.0 game ahead of Jacksonville State and 1.5 games ahead of Southeast Missouri. The closest race at the top of the standings occurred in 2003, when APSU topped Southeast by 0.5 games and were 1.5 games ahead of Tennessee Tech (who they topped on the final day of the season).

Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite: Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists: The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. In a revised Wallace List released in late April, those three players were no longer on the list but had been replaced by Jacksonville State's **Clay Whittemore** (6'1, Sr., OF), Southeast Missouri's **Asif Shah** (6'1, Sr., RHP/DH) and Eastern Illinois **Erik Huber** (6'6, Sr., 1B/OF). Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again: For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

OVC Players in Major League Baseball: The Ohio Valley Conference currently has four former players playing Major League Baseball this season. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC) and Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington). Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson began the year with Boston but was released in May.

EIU's Schmitz Picks Up 500th Career Victory: Eastern Illinois head coach **Jim Schmitz** picked up his 500th career victory on Saturday, March 24 as EIU topped Tennessee Tech 9-7 in the opening game of a doubleheader. Schmitz, who is in his 13th year at EIU after stints at Wilmington and Cincinnati, has recorded 336 of his victories at Eastern Illinois. Schmitz has been tabbed OVC Coach of the Year three times in his career (1998, 1999, 2001).

Hogan Sets Southeast Missouri All-Time Victories Mark: Southeast Missouri State head coach **Mark Hogan** established a new Southeast Missouri State head coaching victories mark with his 374th victory at SEMO in a 17-3 victory over Murray State on Saturday, March 31. The victory put his past Joe Uhls, who had 373 victories in his career. Hogan, in his 13th season at Southeast Missouri, has amassed more than 750 career victories in 26 years, which included stops at Lurleen B. Wallace Community College and West Alabama before coming to Cape Girardeau.

Southeast Ties NCAA Grand Slam Record: With hitting three grand slams in a 27-16 victory over Freed-Hardeman on March 28, Southeast Missouri State tied the NCAA record for grand slams in a single game. The Redhawks are the eighth team to hit three grand slams in a game and first since Youngstown State did so against Oakland University on May 6, 2001. The grand slams came off the bats of **Asif Shah**, **Phillip Riley** and **Nick Harris**. The 27 runs in the game was a Southeast Missouri record (breaking a mark of 24 set in 1985 and equaled in 2001) as was the combined 43 runs by the two teams (breaking a record of 38 set in 1977).

Austin Peay's Win Streak Reaches 11 Before Ending: Austin Peay saw its winning streak of 11 games come to an end in the second game of a doubleheader at Murray State on May 12. When it ended the streak was the second longest nationally, trailing only a 13-game streak by Rice. The 11 wins in a row tied a school record for the Governors.


