## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### CO-PLAYER

#### JAKE LANE • 1B, SR., 6'3 • CLARKSVILLE, TENN. • AUSTIN PEAY

Lane hit .500 (6-for-12) with four runs, a double, two home runs and six RBI last week as Austin Peay swept Eastern Illinois and moved into sole possession of first place in the OVC standings. Lane belted a home run in both games of Saturday's doubleheader including a grand slam in game one that brought home the game-winning run in the Govs 6-2 victory. In game two, his leadoff home run in the fourth tied the game and sparked a six-run inning which gave the Govs the upper hand in a 6-1 victory. In Sunday's finale, he was intentionally walked in his first plate appearance – loading the bases – and the Govs scored the game's second run in their next at-bat.

### CO-PLAYER

#### BLAKE TURNER • OF/DH, JR., 6'0 • BRENTWOOD, TENN. • UT MARTIN

Turner hit .429 (6-for-14) with three runs, two doubles and eight RBI while the Skyhawks won two of three from Murray State over the weekend. Turner also had a .714 slugging percentage and a .400 on-base percentage during the week. He had a walk-off double, his only hit of the game, and drove in the tying and winning runs in Saturday's 10-9 come-from-behind win over the 'Breds. He was 2-for-5 with a run scored and two RBI in the 10-6 loss on Saturday. He went 3-for-5 with two runs and three RBI in the Skyhawks 8-5 win in the series finale on Sunday. Turner finished the series with two multiple-hit games and three-multiple RBI games.

### CO-PITCHER

#### DONOVAN HAND • RHP, JR., 6'4 • HATTON, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Hand gave up two singles to the first two batters of the game, and then did not allow a hit as he pitched a seven-inning complete-game to lead the Gamecocks to a 14-1 win over Tennessee Tech on Saturday. He faced just four batters over the minimum after allowing just two base runners after the first inning. It was a career-best pitching performance as he finished with five strikeouts (to only one walk) and held Tech batters to hit only .091 against the right-hander. Hand has now won the OVC Pitcher of the Week award three times this season and five times in his career.

### CO-PITCHER

#### ASIF SHAH • LHP, SR., 6'1 • CINCINNATI, OHIO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Shah threw his conference-leading third shutout of the season on Sunday at Eastern Kentucky in a 1-0 victory. He became just the fifth player in SEMO history to throw three or more shutouts in the same season. Shah gave up just two hits (his career best in a complete game) and allowed only three base runners. The southpaw retired 18 of the first 19 batters he faced, including 13 in a row beginning with the final out of the second inning. Shah's double in the second was the only hit of the game for Southeast, and he eventually came around to score the only run of the game. The Pitcher of the Week award is his second of the season.

## TEAM NOTES FROM AROUND THE DIAMOND

**AUSTIN PEAY (30-17, 15-6 OVC):** Austin Peay continued its torrid pace with a three-game sweep of Eastern Illinois over the weekend to take over sole possession of first place in the OVC standings (a game ahead of Jacksonville State and 1.5 games over Southeast Missouri). The Governors, who have now won eight games in a row overall and six straight OVC contests, have clinched a spot in the six-team 2007 O'Reilly OVC Baseball Tournament field. After losing 2-of-3 to Samford on April 6-7, Austin Peay has won 11 of its last 12 Conference games, dropping only a 16-14, 12-inning marathon against Southeast Missouri on April 22. APSU also reached the 30-win plateau for the season, marking the fourth straight season (and seventh time in the last eight years) that team has won 30 or more games. **Jake Lane** hit .500 (6-for-12) with four runs, two home runs and six RBI last week to earn OVC Co-Player of the Week honors. He belted a grand slam in game one of the series to spark a 6-2 Govs win while his leadoff home run in the fourth inning of game two sparked a six-run inning on its way to a 6-1 victory. Senior **Matt Reynolds** allowed just one run on six hits to improve to 8-3 on the season on Saturday. The complete game was his fourth of the season. Fellow senior hurler **Shawn Kelley** improved to a perfect 6-0 in OVC play this season (he is 9-2 overall) over the weekend. He posted his sixth straight victory and became APSU's career innings pitched leader (354.1) and tied the program's record for career games started (53). His 2.36 E.R.A. is third in the OVC overall and his 2.35 E.R.A. in OVC-only games is second. Junior **Tyler Farrar** had his second five-hit performance of the season, going 5-for-5 in Sunday's win over EIU. He is second on Austin Peay's team in hitting (.335), home runs (4) and RBI (29) and has committed only eight errors at third base this season. The Govs will host No. 13 Mississippi State for two games this week before playing three games at Murray State this weekend. APSU concludes its OVC slate with three games at home against Eastern Kentucky on May 18-19.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (18-24, 8-12 OVC):** Eastern Illinois suffered a sweep at the hands of first-place Austin Peay over the weekend to fall to 8-12 in the Conference with six games remaining. The Panthers, who have lost eight of nine overall and seven of nine OVC games, are now in seventh place in the standings, 1.5 games behind Tennessee Tech for the final spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Tournament. **Mark Chagnon** led the way for a 5-for-9 performance during the APSU series while **Brett Nommensen** saw his 11-game hitting streak in OVC games come to an end. **Ryan Campbell** hit his 17th career home run on Sunday, making him the active leader on the EIU team. Campbell went all of last season and the first 34 games of this year without a home run but has now homered in back-to-back weekend series. **Erik Huber** is now third in the OVC in hitting (.398) and second in on-base percentage (.472) but still leads the Conference in slugging (.669). EIU will host Division I Independent Chicago State on Wednesday and then host their final OVC series on the season when Eastern Kentucky comes to town for three games. The Panthers wrap-up the OVC season at Morehead State the following weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (20-23-1, 9-9 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky dropped a non-conference game to Louisville midweek and then split a pair of games with Southeast Missouri over the weekend. The normal three-game OVC series was shortened to just two after Saturday's play was cancelled due to rain. So far ECU has lost three Conference games to weather this year which could play into possible tiebreakers if they end the regular season tied with another team. Currently the Colonels are 9-9 in OVC play and sit in fifth place, percentage points ahead of Tennessee Tech (who has played all 21 OVC games so far this season). Sophomore **Christian Friedrich** was a hard luck loser this past weekend. The lefty allowed only one hit while striking out eight and walking nobody over seven innings against Southeast Missouri. Despite the complete game effort, after allowing a double in the second inning, two groundball outs allowed the run to score and ECU eventually lost the game 1-0 after the Colonel's offense was limited to just two hits. Friedrich has a 2.34 E.R.A. this season, which is second in the League. He has 80 strikeouts on the season (11.68/game) which is tops in the OVC and among the national leaders. ECU will travel to Eastern Illinois for this week's OVC series. The team closes out OVC play a week later with Conference frontrunner Austin Peay in Clarksville.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (26-22, 14-7 OVC):** Jacksonville State fell out of first place in the OVC for the first time this season despite winning two of three games at Tennessee Tech over the weekend. Thanks for a three-game sweep by Austin Peay, the Gamecocks find themselves one game behind the Governors in the standings with six Conference games to play. Should the teams finish the season tied, JSU would claim the higher seed in the tournament as they swept the Govs earlier this year. At 14-7 overall, one OVC victory (or OVC loss by EIU, Morehead State or Samford) guarantees Jacksonville State a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Tournament, an event they won last season. Junior **Donovan Hand** was named OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week after allowing only two hits in a 14-1 win over Tech this past weekend. Hand allowed a single to each of the game's first two hitters and then tossed a no-hitter the rest of the way, striking out five and walking only one. The Pitcher of the Week award was the third this season for Hand and the fifth time in his career he had been honored. In OVC-only games, Hand is 5-2 this season with a 3.12 E.R.A. Senior **Nick Cleckler** hit .500 (6-for-12) with seven runs scored, a home run, two RBI and two stolen bases during the week. Hand and Cleckler both hail from Hatton, Ala. As a team JSU leads the OVC in hitting (.310), as well as runs, hits, RBI and doubles. **Clay Whittemore** has taken over the OVC lead in batting (.407) and is now the only player in the League over the .400 mark on the season. He also leads the League in hits (77) and RBI (58). JSU will travel to Georgia State for a non-conference game before hosting UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend. UTM enters the weekend in 10th place in the Conference. Jax State will finish up the season by playing three games at Murray State the following weekend.

**MOREHEAD STATE (15-31, 8-13 OVC):** Morehead State dropped a pair of games at Cincinnati during the week before taking two of three games against Samford at home over the weekend. The Eagles jumped out of the cellar in the OVC race and into a log-jam for seventh/eighth place in the League with two weekends to play. Entering this week MSU is in eighth place, although their eight wins are tied with Eastern Illinois (7th) and Samford (9th) and they are only two games behind Tennessee Tech for sixth place (the

out three. The shutout was his third of the year (tops in the OVC) and he is now tied for the OVC lead in complete games (6). He became just the fifth player in SMO history to toss three or more shutouts in the same season. His 2.82 E.R.A. is fourth overall in the Conference. In the performance he retired 18 of the first 19 batters he faced including 13 in a row at one point. More impressively, Shah had Southeast's only hit of the game (a double in the second inning) and came around to score the only run of the contest after two ground ball outs. The games at ECU clocked in at 1:29 and 1:50 in length, the two quickest games of the year for the Redhaws. Southeast is still second as a team in E.R.A. (4.47) as **Dustin Renfrow** continues to lead the OVC in individual E.R.A. (1.91, 2.30 in OVC-only games). Southeast will host Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend. Two wins would guarantee them a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Tournament. The team completes OVC play the following week when it travels to Tennessee Tech.

**TENNESSEE TECH (23-23, 10-11 OVC):** Tennessee Tech won its series opener with Jacksonville State (11-10) but then dropped the final two games to the Gamecocks. Tech is now 10-11 in the OVC and in sixth place overall in the standings. Senior catcher **Steve Soper** hit .385 (5-for-13) for the week, netting five runs, three home runs and three RBI. He homered twice in Sunday's 13-7 loss and leads the team with a .381 average for the season. Soper's average is fourth best in the OVC while his 17 doubles ranks first, as does his 110 total bases. As a team the Golden Eagles slipped to second in team hitting (.309), just .001 behind Jacksonville State. Sean Reilly's 14-game hitting streak is currently the longest active streak in the OVC. On the mound, **Jared Dobbs** is eighth in E.R.A. (3.81). Dobbs has appeared in 16 games this season, five of which were starts, and struck out 35 in 52 innings of work. Tech will host East Tennessee State for a game on Tuesday before traveling to Samford for a three-game series this weekend. The Golden Eagles host Southeast Missouri the final weekend of OVC play.

**UT MARTIN (18-30, 6-14 OVC):** Tennessee-Martin topped in-state rival Belmont 3-1 in non-conference play and then won two of three against Murray State at home over the weekend. The win on the road against Belmont was only the Skyhawks' second of the year away from home. Junior **Blake Turner** was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after hitting .429 (6-for-14) with three runs, two doubles, a triple and eight RBI last week. Turner drove in the tying and winning runs with a walk-off double in a 10-9 come-from-behind win on Saturday and was 3-for-5 in UTM's 8-5 win in Sunday's series finale. Freshman **Shayne Martin** also had a good week at the plate, hitting .571 (8-for-14) in four games; he had a .714 slugging percentage and .625 on-base percentage as well. Senior **Jason Hockaday** extended his hitting streak to 13 games, the second longest active streak in the OVC (and one of only two streaks at 10-plus games right now). Junior **Kyle Dudley** recorded his 17th and 18th multiple hit games of the season (tied for ninth in the League) over the weekend. He was 3-for-5 in the first game of the Murray series and 2-for-4 in the second contest. Senior **Chad Green** swiped his 18th stolen base of the season over the weekend and is now tied for eighth in UTM single-season history. He is 9-for-9 this season in steals against OVC teams. **Douglas Nicodemus** played in his 40th game of the season on Sunday, a game that was his 192nd career game at UT Martin, giving him the program's all-time record in that category. UTM will travel to Jacksonville State for three games this weekend. OVC play ends the following weekend for the Skyhawks with three at home against Samford.

top six teams make the OVC Tournament). Morehead has won four of its last six OVC games, taking series from Jacksonville State and Samford. Sophomore **Matt Clark** tossed a nine-inning complete game shutout on Sunday to beat the Bulldogs. He allowed five hits and did not allow a runner past second base as MSU won 8-0. He appeared in three total games last week, picking up a save in the first game of the Samford series and losing a decision at Cincinnati earlier in the week. Senior **Ryan Kinder** hit .500 (9-for-18) with three runs and six RBI on the week. He was 8-for-13 (.615) in the Samford series. Kinder is seventh in the OVC in batting average (.358). Freshman **Drew Lee** has assumed the OVC lead in on-base percentage (.475). Morehead State continues to lead the Conference in stolen bases and went across the century mark for the first time in school history. MSU had 11 steals last week as eight different players had at least one swipe. The Eagles will play at Southeast Missouri next weekend and then close out OVC play by hosting Eastern Illinois the following week.

**MURRAY STATE (16-29, 10-9 OVC):** Murray State dropped a non-conference tilt to Belmont and after winning the opening game at UT Martin, dropped the final two against the Skyhawks. The Thoroughbreds are now 10-9 in the Conference and in fourth place overall, just ahead of Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee Tech in the standings. **James Akin** hit .353 (6-for-17) with three runs, a double, two home runs and eight RBI in four games last week. He hit long balls in each of Saturday's doubleheader contests. **Seth Hudson** is now second in the OVC in batting average (.399) and multiple-hit games (24). In OVC-only games **Tyler Owen's** .456 average is tops in the Conference. Hudson is also the OVC leader in triples (6) while **Austin Swain's** 33 walks is tops in the League. Murray State will host first-place Austin Peay this coming weekend. After hosting Kentucky at Brooks Stadium (the site of the OVC Tournament) on May 15, the 'Breds close out OVC play by hosting second-place Jacksonville State.

**SAMFORD (23-26, 8-13 OVC):** Samford lost non-conference contests against Troy and Jackson State last week before dropping two of three games at Morehead State over the weekend. The losses left the Bulldogs at 23-26 overall and 8-13 in Conference play. Samford, the preseason OVC favorites, will have some work to do if they want to make the six-team OVC Tournament field. Samford will host Tennessee Tech for three games this weekend (Tech is currently two games ahead of the Bulldogs in the standings) and battle at UT Martin (who is currently 1.5 games behind Samford) the final weekend of the year. Senior **Josh Ehmke** allowed only one hit over five innings and struck out seven to pick up a victory against Morehead over the weekend. Samford has pitched well this season, ranking third in the OVC in team E.R.A. (4.82); however, a team batting average of just .248 has hurt the Bulldogs. **Parker Gargis** leads the League in home runs (11) while **Joseph Edens** is first in saves (10). Samford was scheduled to play their final non-conference game of the year on Tuesday at Lipscomb, but that game has been cancelled.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (28-19, 13-7 OVC):** Weather hurt Southeast Missouri this past weekend, as one of their scheduled three games at Eastern Kentucky was cancelled, which could potentially hurt the team in the final standings at the end of the year. Southeast now finds itself in third place overall in the League, a half game behind Jacksonville State and 1.5 games behind Austin Peay in the League standings. Senior **Asif Shah** picked up his second OVC Pitcher of the Week honor of the season this week after an outstanding performance against the Colonels. Shah tossed a seven-inning, complete game shutout where he allowed just two hits and struck

**Samford Picked as League Preseason Favorite:** Defending Ohio Valley Conference regular season champion Samford has been picked to win the 2007 OVC baseball crown this season by a narrow margin over rival and 2006 OVC Tournament Champion Jacksonville State, according to a preseason poll of the league's 10 head coaches. The Bulldogs, who won an OVC-record 21 Conference games a season ago, received six first-place votes (78 points in total), two more than second-place Jacksonville State. Jacksonville State (74 points), who won the OVC regular season title in 2005 and represented the OVC in the NCAA Tournament a year ago, fell just four points behind Samford in the poll, as the two teams racked in all 10 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky (58 points) was picked third for the second straight year, edging out Austin Peay (53 points) and Eastern Illinois (53 points), who tied for fourth, and Southeast Missouri (44 points), who were fifth. Tennessee Tech (28 points) was tabbed seventh, Murray State (24 points) eighth, UT Martin (20 points) ninth and Morehead State 10th (15 points).

**Several OVC Players Named to Preseason All-American Teams/Watch Lists:** The OVC had several players named to preseason All-American teams and Award Watch lists. Eastern Kentucky's **Christian Friedrich** (6'3, So., LHP) was named a third-team preseason All-American by both the NCBWA and the Collegiate Baseball News (Louisville Slugger). He was also one of 62 pitchers named to the Roger Clemens Award Watch List (given to the nation's top pitcher) and the Brooks Wallace Watch List (given to the nation's top player by the College Baseball Foundation). Samford's **Josh Ehmke** (5'9, Sr., LHP) and Jacksonville State's **Nick Clecker** (5'10, Sr., OF) were also selected to the Brooks Wallace Watch List. In a revised Wallace List released in late April, those three players were no longer on the list but had been replaced by Jacksonville State's **Clay Whittemore** (6'1, Sr., OF), Southeast Missouri's **Asif Shah** (6'1, Sr., RHP/DH) and Eastern Illinois **Erik Huber** (6'6, Sr., 1B/OF). Ehmke was also named to the Louisville Slugger Preseason All-American team while teammate **Joseph Edens** (5'10, Sr., RHP) was one of 35 pitchers named to the NCWBA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List (given to the nation's top closer). Morehead State senior catcher **Donald Cheney** was named to the Watch List for the 2007 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award, delivered by AT&T; the award is given to the top catcher in the nation and it marks the third straight year Cheney has been on the list.

**O'Reilly OVC Baseball Championship Set For Paducah Once Again:** For the seventh consecutive year the O'Reilly Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship will return to historic Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky. The top six teams from the Conference will meet in Paducah for games from May 23-27. The event has seen five different teams win the tournament title in its six years in Paducah with Jacksonville State capturing the title last year (they also won in 2004).

**OVC Players in Major League Baseball:** The Ohio Valley Conference currently has four former players playing Major League Baseball this season. Those players include Austin Peay's Jaime Walker (Baltimore) and George Sherrill (Seattle), Jacksonville State's Todd Jones (Detroit - although Jones played at JSU before they were members of the OVC) and Morehead State's Jon Rauch (Washington). Southeast Missouri's Kerry Robinson began the year with Boston but was released in May.

**EIU's Schmitz Picks Up 500th Career Victory:** Eastern Illinois head coach **Jim Schmitz** picked up his 500th career victory on Saturday, March 24 as EIU topped Tennessee Tech 9-7 in the opening game of a doubleheader. Schmitz, who is in his 13th year at EIU after stints at Wilmington and Cincinnati, has recorded 336 of his victories at Eastern Illinois. Schmitz has been tabbed OVC Coach of the Year three times in his career (1998, 1999, 2001).

**Hogan Sets Southeast Missouri All-Time Victories Mark:** Southeast Missouri State head coach **Mark Hogan** established a new Southeast Missouri State head coaching victories mark with his 374th victory at SEMO in a 17-3 victory over Murray State on Saturday, March 31. The victory put his past Joe Uhls, who had 373 victories in his career. Hogan, in his 13th season at Southeast Missouri, has amassed more than 750 career victories in 26 years, which included stops at Lurleen B. Wallace Community College and West Alabama before coming to Cape Girardeau.

**Southeast Ties NCAA Grand Slam Record:** With hitting three grand slams in a 27-16 victory over Freed-Hardeman on March 28, Southeast Missouri State tied the NCAA record for grand slams in a single game. The Redhawks are the eighth team to hit three grand slams in a game and first since Youngstown State did so against Oakland University on May 6, 2001. The grand slams came off the bats of **Asif Shah**, **Phillip Riley** and **Nick Harris**. The 27 runs in the game was a Southeast Missouri record (breaking a mark of 24 set in 1985 and equaled in 2001) as was the combined 43 runs by the two teams (breaking a record of 38 set in 1977).


