Austin Peay's Terrence Holt finished his career as the NCAA all-time leader (all divisions) in kickoff returns (191) and kickoff yards (4,683). He is also the only player with four 1,000+ yard kick return seasons.

Tennessee State running back Charles Anthony is the only player in OVC history to record back-to-back 1,700-yard rushing seasons. He ranks as the league's second all-time rushing leader (5,057 yards) and holds the Conference record for rushing touchdowns with 55.



During his career at Southeast Missouri (2008-11) quarterback Matt Scheible became the first player in OVC history to pass for 4,000 or more yards (4,841) and rush for 2,000 or more yards (2,595) in a career. His 7,436 yards of total offense was fifth in OVC history.

NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

College football coaches often say the greatest improvement a team makes is between its first and second game. Team Frisco certainly agrees. After staging a successful championship game in 2011, its first of at least three at FC Dallas Stadium in Frisco, Texas, year two was even better.

Last year, the perfect blend of two passionate fan bases combined with a "local" team making it to the championship game led to a standing-room only crowd of 20,586 to watch North Dakota State beat Sam Houston State 17-6.

Fans of each school were scrambling to find tickets as soon as they locked up their appearances with semifinal wins and as a result, the game was sold out less than four days later. A limited number of standing-room-only tickets became available the week of the game and sold out within minutes.

"I joked that the last person in the state of North Dakota needs to turn out the lights because I don't know if there's anybody left," Bison coach Craig Bohl said after the game. "What a great showing of support. I want to say thanks to all our fans. This is a great game-day venue and Sam Houston State had a great following, too. I think it just sets a tone that this championship can really be special."

North Dakota State's campus in Fargo is roughly 1,000 miles north of Frisco and about a 16-hour drive. Conversely, Frisco is only about 200 miles north of Huntsville, Texas, where Sam Houston State calls home.

Combine those elements and it produced an electric atmosphere from start to finish.

North Dakota State quarterback Brock Jensen threw a touchdown pass right after a fake punt and then added a 1-yard run for another score following a long interception return to help the No. 2 seed Bison upset the top-seeded Bearkats, snapping Sam Houston's 16-game win streak and preventing it from winning its first national championship.

North Dakota State won its first national championship at the Division I level to go with five Division II titles, the last in 1990. Each of the last four Division I championship games, including both games in Frisco, have produced a first-time champion: Richmond following the 2008 season, Villanova in 2009 and Eastern Washington in 2010.

Eastern Washington erased 16-point deficit to beat Delaware 20-19 in the first game in Frisco in January 2011. The entertaining game certainly did not disappoint the 13,000-plus fans who attended the first college football game in Frisco.

While the games have no doubt been the highlight, it is a week's worth of events that have separated the event in Frisco from past championships – not to mention the great Texas hospitality.

The teams arrive in Texas four days before the game starts. They're greeted by signs and banners around town as well as great crowds at their respective team headquarters. The next day, the teams visit local elementary schools where they are welcomed by students eager to show off their school spirit for their newly adopted college teams. Later that night, the two participating teams gather for the Great Texas Barbecue Bowl that showcase the legendary Texas culture and hospitality. On Friday, teams attend the Champions Luncheon and make last-minute tweaks in game preparation.

The day of the game, fans begin gathering at restaurants and parking lots surrounding FC Dallas Stadium and take part in Tailgate Town that features quality entertainment and even more Texas sounds, flavors and hospitality.

"The NCAA national championship game in Frisco was an experience our players, fans and coaching staff will never forget," Sam Houston State head coach Willie Fritz said. "What a great week. The NCAA, Southland Conference and city of Frisco put on a first class event from start to finish."

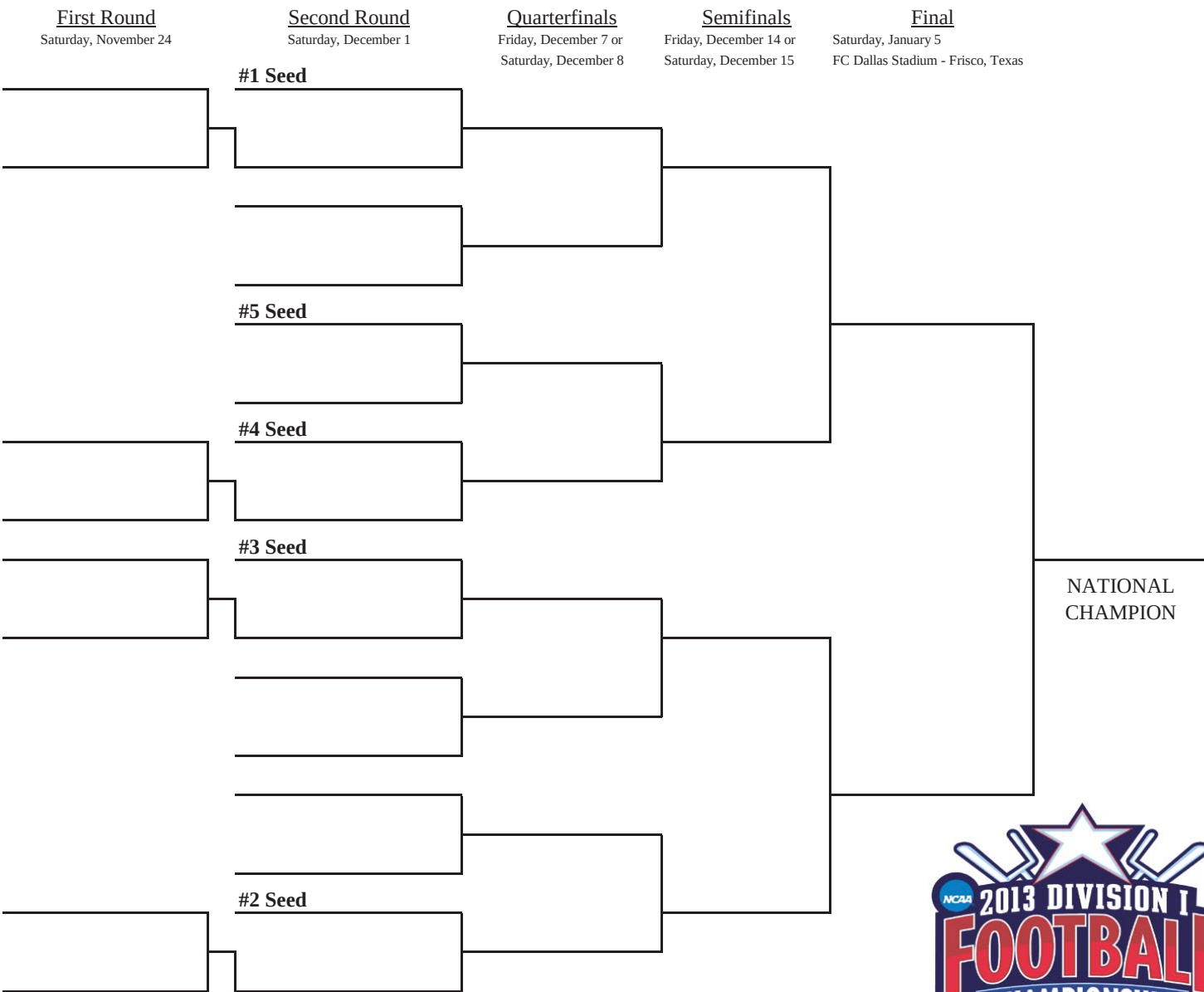

The Ivy League and Southwestern Athletic Conference choose not to participate in the football championship. FCS/I-AA PLAYOFFS HISTORY

The I-AA (re-named the Football Championship Subdivision at the end of the 2006 season) Playoffs began in 1978. FCS schools are the only Division I institutions who compete in a playoff format for a national championship (Football Bowl Subdivision - formerly I-A - compete for the Bowl Championship Series Championship).

Eastern Kentucky, which won the I-AA national championship in 1979 and 1982, has been to the playoffs 20 times in the 34-year history of the event. That is the second-most appearances all-time (trailing only Montana). EKU, along with fellow OVC members Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin have also been in the field during the past six years.
