AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS (10-8 OVC, 17-15 Overall)

Austin Peay defeated Eastern Illinois, 69-65, in double overtime to capture its sixth OVC Tournament Title. The Lady Govs entered the tourney as the five seed, becoming the first fifth seed to ever reach the finals of the league tournament.

APSU is making its sixth trip to the NCAA Tournament and will face No. 1 Duke in the first round of the Berkeley Region in East Lansing, Mich. This will mark the first meeting between Austin Peay and Duke. The last time the Lady Govs went dancing they earned the 13th seed and lost to No. 4 LSU, 83-66. Senior April Thomas was named the OVC Tournament MVP after recording 17.7 points and 7.3 rebounds per game during the tourney. In the semifinals against Murray State, she put up 25 points and brought down seven rebounds.



MURRAY STATE RACERS (16-2 OVC, 22-8 Overall)

Murray State went 16-2 in the Ohio Valley Conference to earn its first league regular-season crown. The Racers defeated Jacksonville State, 79-69, in the first round of the OVC Tournament but fell to Austin Peay, 90-84, in the semifinals. Murray State earned its

first Conference tourney title last year to make its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Racers lost to Duke, 78-57, in the first round. Murray State will be making its third trip to the WNIT. The Racers have earned WNIT appearances in 1989 and 2007. The last time out, Murray State fell to Arkansas State, 59-52. Senior Ashley Hayes was named the OVC Player of the Year for the second straight season, making her just the sixth player in league history to earn back-to-back honors. She leads the league and ranks sixth national with 23.0 points per game. Murray State will travel to Arkansas-Little Rock for the first round of the WNIT. The Racers own a 4-2 advantage in the series against the Trojans.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

APSU Wins Sixth Tournament Title: Austin Peay won its sixth overall tournament title with a 69-65 double-overtime win over Eastern Illinois. The Lady Govs were the fifth seed, making them the first fifth seed to ever reach the finals of the OVC Tournament.

Double Overtime Twice: The men's and women's OVC Tournament finals both went to double overtime in 2009. Making the OVC the first Conference to ever have the championship games of both the men's and women's tourneys to go into double overtime.

Murray State Earns First OVC Regular-Season Crown: The Murray State women's basketball team earned its first ever Ohio Valley Conference regular-season title. The Racers won the league tournament last year and made their first trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Player of the Year: Murray State's Ashley Hayes was named OVC Player of the Year for the second straight season becoming just the sixth player in league history to earn back-to-back honors. On Feb. 4, Hayes scored 46 points to break not only the women's school scoring record but eclipsing the men's mark as well.

Coach of the Year: Murray State's Rob Cross, who is in his first season at the helm of the Racers was tabbed OVC Coach of the Year. Cross is the fifth first-year coach in OVC history to be named Coach of the Year joining names such as Tennessee Tech's Bill Worrell, Tennessee State's Teresa Phillips, Austin Peay's Andy Blackston and Southeast Missouri's John Ishee.

Defensive Player of the Year: Tennessee State's Kendra Appling earned the inaugural OVC Defensive Player of the Year. She is second in the Conference with 66 steals for a 2.3 per game average during the regular-season. The Jackson, Ga., native is league's active career leader with 253 swipes in her four years at Tennessee State.

Freshman of the Year: Eastern Kentucky's Kayla Drake is the third Lady Colonel to earn OVC Freshman of the Year honors. She reached double digits in scoring in all but four games this season, including hitting the 20-point mark eight times

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

EIU's Galligan Finalist for Lowe's CLASS Awards: Eastern Illinois' Rachel Galligan is one of ten finalists nationally for the Lowe's CLASS Award. Go to www.seniorclassaward.com to vote. The winners will be announced during the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four.

Academic All-America: Murray State's Amber and Paige Guffey were named to the first team of the ESPN The Magazine Academic-All American team as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America. In addition, Amber was named the Academic All-American of the Year an honor that Tennessee's Candace Parker won last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.
