NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC on Wazzo Sports: The 2010 OVC Women's Basketball Tournament semifinals and finals will be produced and broadcast by Wazzo Sports. It marks the first time that the semifinals will be televised live. In addition the broadcasts will be picked up by WEIU, WCTE, WQWQ (championship game only) and KMOV which are located in the markets of Charleston, Ill., Cookeville, Tenn., Cape Girardeau, Mo., and St. Louis, respectively.

Morehead State's Bozeman sets 3-point Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman set a new school and OVC career three-point record of 248. She currently has 255 career treys.

Free-Throw Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman went 17-for-17 from the free throw line against Tennessee State on Jan. 28 to set the school and league's single-game record.

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week eight times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachian State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Team Notes

Austin Peay closed out the home portion of its regular-season slate with wins over Jacksonville State (75-71) and Tennessee Tech (78-70). With the victories, the Lady Govs also clinched a home game in the first round of the conference tournament. APSU finished 8-1 at home in OVC contests this season and 8-6 at the Dunn Center overall. Junior **Ashley Herring** posted back-to-back 28-point performance last week. She went 19-for-23 from the free throw line, including an 8-for-8 performance against Jacksonville State. Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** averaged 16 points and eight rebounds over the two games while senior **Nicole Jamen** recorded 10.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game. Jamen recorded her 12th career double-double against Jacksonville State (15 pts/11 reb.) and surpassed both the 800-point and 600-rebound plateaus for her career. Austin Peay will travel to Eastern Illinois on Thursday and Southeast Missouri on Saturday.

Eastern Illinois fell to UT Martin (71-64) and defeated Murray State (76-71) last week. The loss to the Skyhawks snapped the Panthers 13-game win streak. With the win over Murray State, EIU clinched at least a share of its first regular-season title. **Ta'Kenya Nixon** broke the EIU freshman records for assists and free throws made and tied the school's freshman marks for rebounds and free throws attempted. She has now broke or tied five freshman records. She scored a game-high 21 points at UTM, her team-leading fifth 20-point game of the season. Senior **Maggie Kloak** posted her fourth career double-double with 20 points and 15 rebounds at Murray State. She also tallied five blocks versus the Racers. Kloak was a perfect 6-for-6 from the field at UT Martin, her second career perfect shooting night. Freshman **Sydney Mitchell** scored 12 points at UT Martin and nine points at Murray State while senior **Ashley Thomas** netted 11 of her 13 points versus the Racers in the second half. Eastern Illinois will host Austin Peay on Thursday and Tennessee State on Saturday.

Eastern Kentucky defeated Morehead State, 79-67, last week. The Lady Colonels have double its number of conference wins from last season. Freshman **Alex Jones** posted career-highs of 34 points and 18 rebounds in the win while fellow freshman **Brittany Coles** also scored a career-best 18 points. The double-double was Jones' sixth of the season.
