NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC on Wazzo Sports: The 2010 OVC Women's Basketball Tournament semifinals and finals will be produced and broadcast by Wazoo Sports. It marks the first time that the semifinals will be televised live. In addition the broadcasts will be picked up by WEIU, WCTE, WQWQ (championship game only) and KMOV which are located in the markets of Charleston, Ill., Cookeville, Tenn., Cape Girardeau, Mo., and St. Louis, respectively.

Morehead State's Bozeman sets 3-point Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman set a new school and OVC career three-point record of 248. She currently has 255 career treys.

Free-Throw Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman went 17-for-17 from the free throw line against Tennessee State on Jan. 28 to set the school and league's single-game record.

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week eight times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachain State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCSports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

With the victories, the Lady Govs also clinched a home game in the first round of the conference tournament. APSU finished 8-1 at home in OVC contests this season and 8-6 at the Dunn Center overall. Junior Ashley Herring posted back-to-back 28-point performance last week. She went 19-for-23 from the free throw line, including an 8-for-8 performance against Jacksonville State. Sophomore Jasmine Rayner averaged 16 points and eight rebounds over the two games while senior Nicole Jamen recorded 10.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game. Jamen recorded her 12th career doubledouble against Jacksonville State (15 pts/11 reb.) and surpassed both the 800-point and 600-rebound plateaus for her career. Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky defeated Morehead State, 79-67, last week. The Lady Colonels have double its number of conference wins from last season. Freshman Alex Jones posted career-highs of 34 points and 18 rebounds in the win while fellow freshman Brittany Coles also scored a career-best 18 points. The double-double was Jones' sixth of the season. Jones became the seventh Lady Colonel since 1988-89 to amass 300 points and 200 rebounds in the same season and just the second freshman to accomplish the feat.
