Ward averaged 21.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in UT Martin's two wins last week, helping the Skyhawks win consecutive games for the first time since 2006-07. Against Tennessee State, Ward broke her career scoring mark with 25 points. She also pulled down a game-high 12 rebounds to record her first collegiate double-double. Ward went 6-for-11 from the field on the day with a career-best three three-pointers while also going 10-for-13 at the charity stripe. In the game against Austin Peay, Ward netted 18 points on 6-of-11 shooting from the field while also going a perfect 2-for-2 from three point range and 4-for-4 at the line. She also dished out a game-high six assists against the Lady Govs while pulling down five rebounds.

Weatherly averaged 23.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in UT Martin's two games last week. In the win over Austin Peay, Weatherly scored a career-high 25 points on 7-of-11 shooting. She also went 3-for-5 from the three-point range and was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line. Weatherly also pulled down a team-high eight rebounds and recorded a block. She followed that up with a 21-point effort versus Tennessee State. She shot 6-for-12 from the field and was again perfect at the free throw line (7-for-7).

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Free-Throw Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman went 17-for-17 from the free throw line against Tennessee State on Jan. 28 to set the school and league's single-game record.

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week six times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachian State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCSports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Team Notes

Austin Peay fell at UT Martin (79-70) before defeating Murray State (76-72) last week. Sophomore **Whitney Hanley** scored 13 points at UT Martin and followed that up with a 20-point outing at Murray State. Junior **Ashley Herring's** 20-point performance at Murray State pushed her past the 1,000-career point mark. She becomes the 13th Lady Govs player to surpass 1,000 career points. Senior **Nicole Jamen** recorded her season's eighth double-double (17 pts./10 reb.) at UT Martin. It was her fifth double-double in 11 games. Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** posted her sixth double-double versus the Racers with 14 points and a career-high tying 17 rebounds. Freshman **Meghan Bussabarger** came off the bench to hit a three-pointer to put APSU ahead for good at Murray State. After scoring just 19 points in the first half at UT Martin, the Lady Govs responded with a 51-point second half. Austin Peay will travel to Tennessee State on Saturday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated SIU Edwardsville (74-63) and Southeast Missouri (71-41) to run its winning streak to 11 games which marks a new program record. The Panthers won at Southeast Missouri for the first time since 2001 and ending a nine-game losing streak at the Show Me Center. Having swept its four-game road stretch, EIU has posted six of its 11 consecutive victories on the road. Four Panthers scored in double-figures in both wins. Senior **Maggie Kloak** scored a season-high 21 points at SIUE and was one of three EIU players to score 12 points at Southeast Missouri. Freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** posted her team-leading third double-double of the season at SIUE with 19 points and 11 rebounds. Freshman **Sydney Mitchell** scored in double-figures in both games off the bench with 11 points at SIU and a career-high 12 points at Southeast Missouri. With one more victory, EIU can clinch a home game in the opening round of the OVC Tournament for the third straight season. The Panthers will host Morehead State on Thursday and Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

Team Notes

Jacksonville State went 1-1 for the week, falling at Morehead State (80-53) and earning its first win ever at McBrayer Arena with a 49-46 overtime win over Eastern Kentucky. Sophomore **Brittany Wiley** tied a career-high with 23 points and collected 10 rebounds for her third career double-double in the win over EKU. She scored the final four points of regulation that included a game-tying basket with one second left against the Lady Colonels and then scored four of JSU's five points in overtime.
