Luckett recorded the second triple-double in school history with 14 points, 11 assists and 10 rebounds against Jacksonville State. She followed that up with a double-double versus Tennessee Tech with 10 points and 10 rebounds. She was just three assists shy of a second triple-double against the Golden Eagles. Her 11 assists versus JSU tied for the No. 7 spot on the Racer's assists list.

For the week, Weatherly averaged 15.0 points and 6.0 rebounds for the Skyhawks. After a career-night against Tennessee Tech, Weatherly also added a nine points and game-high nine rebound showing against Jacksonville State.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVC Women's Basketball on "The U": The Jan. 2 game between Austin Peay and Morehead State will be featured on ESPN2. The contest is a re-match of last season's OVC Tournament first round game where No. 5 Austin Peay defeated No. 4 Morehead State, 78-74. In the preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors the Eagles and the Lady Gavs are picked No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, with just one point separating them. Gametime is set for 5:30 p.m. CT in Morehead, Ky.

EIU In the Preseason WNIT: Eastern Illinois will participate in the 2009-10 Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Panthers will travel to Ohio State on Nov. 13 and will play either Bowling Green or Chicago State on Nov. 15. Eastern Illinois becomes the first OVC team to participate in the Preseason WNIT since former league member Samford did so in the 2007-08 season.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Team Notes

Austin Peay defeated Tennessee State, 77-66, in its only game of the week. For the second time this season, senior **Nicole Jamen** (17 points, 12 rebounds) and sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** (21 points, 12 rebounds) recorded double-doubles in the same game. They also accomplished the feat against Northwestern State in the Vanderbilt Thanksgiving Tournament. The Lady Govs held Tennessee State to 31.1 percent (23-for-74) shooting from the field, the lowest an opponent has shot against Austin Peay this season. The Lady Govs overcame a halftime deficit for the first time this season; they are now 1-10 when trailing at halftime in 2009-10. Junior **Ashley Herring** had 17 points versus TSU, marking her fourth straight double-digit game. Sophomore **Whitney Hanely** broke out of her slump with 13 points, her first double-figure scoring game since Jan. 2. Team Notes

Eastern Illinois swept the Eastern Kentucky-Morehead State road trip for the third year in a row to move into first place in the OVC standings. The Panthers defeated ECU, 60-50, and Morehead State, 62-60. EIU has won a season-high five straight games and five consecutive games against both ECU and Morehead State. Senior **Dominique Sims** and freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** led the way in the ECU win. Sims scored 17 points while Nixon posted a 16-point, 17-rebound double-double. The 17 boards matched the most by a Panthers during head coach **Brady Saltee's** six-year tenure. Sophomore **Chantelle Pressley** scored 10 points at Morehead State and nine points at Eastern Kentucky. She connected on a pair of free throws with 2.3 seconds remaining to break a 60-60 tie and lift the Panthers to the win against the Eagles. Senior **Maggie Kloak** led the team with 20 points in the win at Morehead State, scoring 17 in the second half. Senior **Ashley Thomas** connected on three of EIU's three-pointers and scored 10 points at Morehead State. The Panthers will host Murray State on Thursday and UT Martin on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCSports.TV and the UT Martin contest will be broadcast locally on WEIU-TV.
