Hayes scored 39 points against Austin Peay to set a single-game scoring record for a guard in Tennessee Tech history. She also added nine rebounds, three assists and two steals in the win. She just missed her second triple-double of the season against Tennessee State as she posted 17 points, nine rebounds and eight assists. Hayes leads the league with 17.8 points per game during Conference play this season.

Weatherly played all 40 minutes against Southeast Missouri Thursday night, despite suffering an injury with two minutes remaining that would force her to miss Saturday's game at Eastern Illinois. She scored 10 points and pulled down seven rebounds to help the Skyhawks pick up their first win at the Show Me Center since 2001. Weatherly also recorded two assists, one steal and one block.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week six times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachian State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS (7-13, 6-3)

Team Notes

Austin Peay saw its road losing streak reach seven games with a loss at Tennessee Tech (77-56) before picking up a win at Jacksonville State (78-70). It was the first road win for the Lady GoVs since defeating Lipscomb on Nov. 21. Senior **Nicole Jamen** reached the conference slate's midway point as the only player averaging a double-double with 12.8 points and 10.8 rebounds. Junior **Ashley Herring** reached double-figures in scoring against both Tennessee Tech (14 pts) and Jacksonville state (12 pts). She leads the team with 14.0 points per OVC game at the halfway point. Herring is 53 points shy of becoming the 13th APSU women's basketball player to score 1,000 points and the first since Ashley Haynes (2002-06). Junior **Brooke Faulkner** made a career-high five three-pointers in the win at JSU. Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** led the squad with 17 points at Tennessee Tech, marking the fifth time she has paced the team in scoring. Austin Peay will host Eastern Kentucky on Thursday and Morehead State on Saturday.

Eastern Illinois extended its winning streak to seven straight games with victories over Murray State (64-57) and UT Martin (74-47). With an 8-1 mark, the Panthers are off to their best start in OVC play as a member of the league. EIU had three players score in double-figures and collected 51 team rebounds in both wins last week. The Panthers snapped a four-game losing streak against Murray State Thursday. Senior **Dominique Sims** posted her third career double-double with 13 points and a career-best 12 rebounds. Senior **Maggie Kloak** and sophomore **Chantelle Pressley** both scored 11 points versus the Racers while freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** posted a career-high 10 assists, which is the most by an EIU player since December 2005. For the seventh time this season, every Panther that played scored in the win against UT Martin. Freshman **Mariah King** scored a career-high 14 points to help EIU enjoy a 40-2 edge in bench scoring. EIU puts its winning streak on the line this weekend as it travels to Tennessee Tech on Thursday and Jacksonville State on Saturday.

Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky split a pair of games last week, defeating SIU Edwardsville (58-53) and falling to Morehead State (59-58). Freshman **Shakeyia Colyer** scored a career-best 15 points to go along with seven rebounds and four assists against the Cougars while fellow freshman **Michaela Kleist** contributed 10 points and six rebounds off the bench. A lay-up by freshman **Alex Jones** with 51 seconds gave ECU a 58-57 lead and capped a 16-3 late-game run versus Morehead State. Jones led the team with 15 points while Colyer chipped in 14 boards versus the Eagles. Kleist recorded her first career double-double as she put up 12 points and brought down a game-high 12 rebounds in the Morehead State game. Eastern Kentucky has held 11 of its last 14 opponents to 60 points or less. The Lady Colonels have out-rebounded 13 of its 19 opponents this year while its bench has out-scored its opposing bench in 12 straight games. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Austin Peay on Thursday and Tennessee State on Saturday.
