Dominique Sims, G • Sr., 5'10 • Wichita Falls, Texas • Eastern Illinois

Sims posted an 18-point, 13-rebound double-double in the win over Austin Peay that allowed EIU to clinch the OVC title outright. She scored nine points during the game-opening 15-0 run. Sims also had 13 points, seven rebounds and four assists in the win versus Tennessee State. For the week she averaged 15.5 points and 10.0 rebounds.

Darnisha Lyles, F • Jr., 6'1 • Mobile, Ala. • UT Martin

Lyles averaged 20 points and 8.5 rebounds last week as the Skyhawks secured a spot in the OVC Tournament and a first round home game for the first time since 2006-07. She shot 64.0 percent from the field against Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State. In the EKU game, Lyles posted a career-high 23 points while also pulling down 10 boards for her third double-double of the year. She was also 7-of-11 at the free throw line with an assist. At Morehead State she added 17 points and seven boards with one steal.

Jones averaged a double-double in the two games last week. She finished with eight rebounds and three blocks against UT Martin. In the Murray State game, she posted her seventh double-double of the season with 20 points and 16 rebounds to go along with two assists and three steals against Murray State. She needs only 10 points and eight more rebounds to become the fifth Lady Colonel ever to register 350 points and 250 rebounds in the same season.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC on Wazzo Sports: The 2010 OVC Women's Basketball Tournament semifinals and finals will be produced and broadcast by Wazzo Sports. It marks the first time that the semifinals will be televised live. In addition the broadcasts will be picked up by WEIU, WCTE, WQWQ (championship game only) and KMOV which are located in the markets of Charleston, Ill., Cookeville, Tenn., Cape Girardeau, Mo., and St. Louis, respectively.

Morehead State's Bozeman sets 3-point Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman set a new school and OVC career three-point record of 248. She currently has 255 career treys.

Free-Throw Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman went 17-for-17 from the free throw line against Tennessee State on Jan. 28 to set the school and league's single-game record.

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week eight times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachian State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Team Notes

Austin Peay split a pair of road games to close out the regular season. The Lady Govs fell to Eastern Illinois (78-47) before defeating Southeast Missouri (77-60). Austin Peay earned the third seed in the upcoming OVC Tournament. The Lady Govs are making their second straight tourney appearance after winning the title last season becoming the first fifth seed in league history to accomplish that feat. Austin Peay grabbed 51 rebounds in its victory at Southeast Missouri, its fourth 50+ rebound effort this season, but are only 2-2 in those contests. Junior **Ashley Herring** led the team last week with 14.5 point and 9.0 rebounds per game. She scored 13 points versus Eastern Illinois and followed that up with her third career double-double at Southeast Missouri with 16 points and 15 rebounds. Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** posted a double-double against the Panthers with 14 points and 14 rebounds. Third-seeded Austin Peay will host No. 6 Tennessee Tech in the first round of the tournament on Tuesday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Austin Peay (78-47) and Tennessee State (79-67) to win its first OVC regular-season title outright. The Panthers also recorded its second straight 20-win season. Senior **Dominique Sims** averaged a double-double for the week. She scored 18 points and brought down 13 rebounds in the win over Austin Peay for her fourth career double-double. She followed that up with 13 points and seven boards versus Tennessee State. Freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** scored a team-high 19 points versus the Lady Tigers, including 15 in the second half. Nixon also added 12 points and nine rebounds against Austin Peay. The Panthers earned the top seed in the upcoming conference tournament and will face No. 8 Tennessee State in first-round action on Tuesday. It marks the third straight year the Panthers and Lady Tigers have met in the tournament. EIU has won the last nine meetings with Tennessee State.
