Oby Okafor, F • Sr., 5'9 • Rolla, Mo. • Tennessee State

Okafor led the Tennessee State offense as the Lady Tigers went 2-0 last week. She nearly averaged a double-double with 21.5 points and 9.5 rebounds. Okafor recorded her second double-double of the season and 26th of her career with 17 points and 10 rebounds against Cumberland. She followed that up with 26 points and nine rebounds on 8-for-8 shooting against Lipscomb.

Davis recorded 18 points, seven rebounds, four steals and three assists while making 50 percent of her shots from the field against Bethune-Cookman. She hit a three-pointer with nine seconds left and came up with a steal at the other end before Bethune-Cookman could get another shot off. Against Towson, she had a game-high six assists to go along with four points, six rebounds and three steals.

Jones scored a career-high 26 points in the victory over Bethune-Cookman. She kept the Lady Colonels in the game by scoring 21 points in the second half, including EKU's first 10 points. In addition to making 11 of her 14 attempts from the field, Jones also contributed eight rebounds, three assists, two steals and a blocked shot. Against Towson, Jones recorded 12 points, five rebounds, five steals, two assists and one block.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2009-10 campaign kicks off with Morehead State hosting Kentucky State in an exhibition game on Oct. 31. The regular-season begins on Nov. 13 with Conference play starting on Dec. 3. Eight different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 15.

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

OVC Women's Basketball on "The U": The Jan. 2 game between Austin Peay and Morehead State will be featured on ESPNU. The contest is a re-match of last season's OVC Tournament first round game where No. 5 Austin Peay defeated No. 4 Morehead State, 78-74. In the preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors the Eagles and the Lady Gavs are picked No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, with just one point separating them. Gametime is set for 5:30 p.m. CT in Morehead, Ky.

EIU In the Preseason WNIT: Eastern Illinois will participate in the 2009-10 Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Panthers will travel to Ohio State on Nov. 13 and will play either Bowling Green or Chicago State on Nov. 15. Eastern Illinois becomes the first OVC team to participate in the Preseason WNIT since former league member Samford did so in the 2007-08 season.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Austin Peay fell to James Madison (83-56) before going 0-2 at the Vanderbilt Thanksgiving Tournament with losses to No. 16 Vanderbilt (95-51) and Northwestern State (86-84, OT). After opening the season making 77.5 percent (59-of-76) of their free throws in the first three games, the Lady Govs made just 53.8 (35-of-65) of their free throws during last week's three contests. Junior **Ashley Herring** was named to the all-tournament team after scoring 21 points against both Vanderbilt and Northwestern State. She made her first four three-point field goals to help give the Lady Govs the 19-12 first-half lead against Vandy. Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** posted a career-high in both points (18) and rebounds (17) against Northwestern State while senior **Nicole Jamen** added an 18-point, 11-rebound performance. Team Notes

Eastern Illinois fell to SMU (79-52) before picking up wins over IPFW (68-64) and Brescia (110-28). The Panthers scored 100 points for the first time since November 2006. Senior **Maggie Kloak** led the way with 15 points in the win at IPFW. She was 11-of-12 at the free throw line for the week. Sophomore **Pilar Walker** scored a career-best 13 points at IPFW and sealed the victory with two free throws in the final seconds. Kloak and Walker teamed up to score EIU's final 15 points in the win. Senior **Dominique Sims** scored a season-high 18 points in the loss to SMU. The Panthers were 5-of-6 from three-point land in the win at IPFW, setting a new single-game three-point percentage record (.833). Eastern Illinois had 31 assists versus only two turnovers against Brescia. Six players scored in double-figures, including three freshmen (**Ta'Kenya Nixon**, **Mariah King** and **Sydney Mitchell**) in their Lantz Arena debuts.
