THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Chynna Bozeman, G • Jr., 5'11 • Reynoldsburg, Ohio • Morehead State

Bozeman averaged 33.5 points over Morehead State's two wins last week. She scored 30 points at Tennessee State, hitting a school and OVC record 17-of-17 free throws. Bozeman followed that up with a career-best 37 points, including a 9-for-13 effort from three-point range, at Austin Peay. Her point total at APSU ranked as the second highest single-game performance in school history. She shot 52 percent from three-point range and also recorded 2.5 steals and assists per game.

NEWCOMER

Darnisha Lyles, F • Jr., 6'0 • Mobile, Ala. • UT Martin

Lyles recorded 11.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game as UT Martin went 1-1 last week. Lyles, who entered the week, shooting just 30 percent from the free throw line, went 10-of-13 over the last two games at the charity stripe. She went a perfect 7-for-7 from the line down the stretch against Murray State to seal the Skyhawks' win. Also against the Racers, she tallied 12 points and pulled down five boards to go with a career-best three blocks. Lyles tallied her third double-double of the season with 10 points and 12 rebounds against SIU Edwardsville.

Ward matched a career-high with 23 points in the win over Murray State. In the victory, she was 8-for-9 from the field, including a perfect 3-for-3 from three-point range while also going 4-for-5 at the free throw line. She also added six rebounds, two steals, two blocks and two assists. For the week, Ward averaged 16.5 points and 6.5 rebounds over the two games. Against SIU Edwardsville, she added 10 points and seven rebounds.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Free-Throw Record: Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman went 17-for-17 from the free throw line against Tennessee State on Jan. 28 to set the school and league's single-game record.

UTM's Weatherly Sets Newcomer Record: UT Martin's Alecia Weatherly has been named Newcomer of the Week six times which set a school record. She is closing in on the OVC record of nine which was set by Southeast Missouri's Tatiana Conceicao in 2004-05.

Seniorless: Tennessee Tech and UT Martin are two of 15 squads in the nation without a senior on the roster. Joining the Golden Eagles and the Skyhawks are Appalachian State, Arizona, Army, Central Arkansas, Colorado State, George Washington, Harvard, South Carolina, Southern Utah, Tennessee, West Virginia, Winston-Salem and Wyoming.

EIU's Nixon Joins Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Ta'Kenya Nixon earned her second Player of the Week honor to become just the third player in OVC history to earn the accolade twice as a freshman. She joins Middle Tennessee's Jennifer McFall (1981-82) and Austin Peay's Amanda Behrenbrinker (1994-95).

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Team Notes

Austin Peay defeated Eastern Kentucky (68-57) before falling to Morehead State (88-68) last week. The loss to the Eagles was the Lady Govs' first home OVC defeat of the season. Junior **Ashley Herring** is currently 32 points shy of becoming the 13th APSU women's basketball player to score 1,000 points and the first since Ashley Haynes (2002-06). Sophomore **Jasmine Rayner** led the Lady Govs with a double-double in last week's two contests, averaging 13.5 points and 10.5 rebounds. She posted a career high 22 points and 15 rebounds against EKU for her first double-double of the season. Austin Peay will play five of its final seven OVC games on the road in February. The Lady Govs will travel to UT Martin on Thursday and Murray State on Saturday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Tennessee Tech (80-59) and Jacksonville State (60-43) to extend its winning streak to nine games. The streak ties a school record and is the longest in the OVC this season. EIU has now won nine straight games versus Tennessee Tech, its the longest win streak ever against an OVC opponent. Senior **Dominique Sims** scored a career-high 21 points in the win at Tech while moving into 10th on the school's all-time list for three-pointers made. Senior **Maggie Kloak** posted her third career double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds against Tech. She also put up 18 points versus JSU. Freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** posted her second 10-assist effort against the Golden Eagles. The Panthers grabbed a season-high 54 rebounds in the Tech win. EIU was 6-of-6 from the free throw line against JSU, marking the first times since November 2008 that the Panthers have attempted fewer than 10 free throws. Eastern Illinois will travel to SIU Edwardsville on Thursday and Southeast Missouri on Saturday.
