Bozeman recorded her first career double-double and reached the 1,000 career point plateau with a 24-point, 10-rebound effort at UT Martin. She also scored a team-high 16 points in helping the Eagles win at Murray State for the first time in three seasons. For the week, she also averaged 3.0 assists, 2.5 steals and shot 80 percent from the free throw line.

Weatherly scored a team-high 19 points and pulled down eight rebounds to lead UT Martin against Morehead State. She then added five points and five rebounds against Eastern Kentucky. For the week, Weatherly averaged 12.0 points and 6.5 rebounds. She also shot 75 percent from the free throw line to go along with three assists and one steal.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Predicted Order of Finish: In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State earned 147 points, including nine first-place votes while, Austin Peay claimed six first-place votes and 146 points for second place. Tennessee State picked up 134 points and four first-place votes for a predicted third place finish as Eastern Illinois earned the final first-place nod and 111 points to finish fourth. Rounding out the poll are Jacksonville State (84 points), Murray State (79 points), Southeast Missouri (67 points), Tennessee Tech (58 points), Eastern Kentucky (54 points) and UT Martin (18 points).

Let the Season Begin: The 2009-10 campaign kicks off with Morehead State hosting Kentucky State in an exhibition game on Oct. 31. The regular-season begins on Nov. 13 with Conference play starting on Dec. 3. Eight different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 15.

At the Sommet Again: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 16th time in 17 years, will be back at the Sommet Center for the second straight year and 11th time overall. The two-day event will be held March 5 and 6.

New Faces: For the second straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will each have first-year head coaches. Sytia Messer takes over the helm of the Golden Eagles after spending the last five seasons on the Georgia Tech women's basketball staff. Messer completed her first year as the Yellow Jackets associate head coach. She also spent time on the staffs of Arkansas State and Memphis. Kevin McMillan becomes just the eighth head coach in Skyhawk history. McMillan takes over the helm of the UT Martin women's basketball team after spending the last two seasons as the skipper at Gibson County High School. McMillan also had a stint as an assistant coach at Middle Tennessee State.

Young Teams: The Ohio Valley Conference will return less than half of its starters from a year ago as just 26 starters are coming back from last season. However, Jacksonville State will have its entire starting lineup in tact from the 2008-09 season. Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State each have four starters returning from last season while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville and UT Martin each have two. Eastern Illinois, Murray State and Tennessee State will have the most holes to fill as they have just one starter coming back.

OVC Women's Basketball on "The U": The Jan. 2 game between Austin Peay and Morehead State will be featured on ESPNU. The contest is a re-match of last season's OVC Tournament first round game where No. 5 Austin Peay defeated No. 4 Morehead State, 78-74. In the preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors the Eagles and the Lady Gavs are picked No. 1 and No. 2, respectively, with just one point separating them. Gametime is set for 5:30 p.m. CT in Morehead, Ky.

EIU In the Preseason WNIT: Eastern Illinois will participate in the 2009-10 Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Panthers will travel to Ohio State on Nov. 13 and will play either Bowling Green or Chicago State on Nov. 15. Eastern Illinois becomes the first OVC team to participate in the Preseason WNIT since former league member Samford did so in the 2007-08 season.

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS (3-5, 2-0)

Team Notes

Austin Peay defeated Southeast Missouri (76-63) and Eastern Illinois (65-55) to open up Conference play 2-0 for the first time since 2003-04. The Lady Govs have not trailed for nearly 77 consecutive minutes in OVC play after taking the lead at the 16:51 mark of the first half against Southeast Missouri. Junior **Brooke Faulkner** averaged 17.0 points last week, including a career-high 20-point performance against EIU. Senior **Nicole Jamen** grabbed a career-high 17 rebounds versus the Panthers, becoming the second Lady Govs player to grab 17 boards. Junior **Ashley Herring** saw her double-digit scoring streak end at six games with a nine-point performance against EIU. She grabbed 16 rebounds and dished out seven assists in the two outings. Austin Peay will travel to UALR on Tuesday and Troy.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Tennessee State (70-37) before falling to Austin Peay (65-55) last week. EIU now has an eight-game win streak against TSU, marking the Panthers' longest active streak against an OVC opponent. Every Panther that played scored in both games of the road trip. Freshman **Ta'Kenya Nixon** scored 14 of her game-high 17 points in the second half of the TSU win. Senior **Dominique Sims** posted her second career double-double (10 points, 10 rebounds) at TSU and senior **Mariah King** also finished with 10 points on a perfect shooting night (5-of-5). King tied EIU's single-game field goal percentage mark, the eight Panther to do so during head coach **Brady Sallee's** six-year tenure. EIU held TSU to 28 percent shooting from the field and collected 50 rebounds. EIU puts its 10-game non-conference home win streak on the line this week against Western Michigan (Wednesday) and Indiana State (Saturday). Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky stretched its winning streak to four games with victories over Murray State (58-54) and UT Martin (56-53). The four-game winning streak is the longest for the Lady Colonels since winning 15 straight on its way to the NCAA tournament in 2005. The win over Murray State snapped the Racers' 21-game home winning streak, which was the fourth longest active run in the nation. Freshman **Alex Jones** led the team with back-to-back double-doubles. In the win at Murray State, Jones scored 12 points and grabbed 14 rebounds. She followed that up with 12 points and 13 boards against UT Martin. Junior **Talisha Davis** finished with 12 points to go along with seven rebounds and three steals against Murray State. Freshman **Brittany Coles** tied her career-best with 13 points against UT Martin. EKV will travel to West Virginia on Tuesday before hosting Davis & Elkins on Friday.
