# 2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (13-25 overall, 5-8 OVC):** Austin Peay split a doubleheader with Belmont (7-2, 6-7), took two from Evansville (9-8, 3-1) and went 2-1 against Murray State (2-3 (8), 9-3, 4-2) last week. With the series win over Murray State, the Lady Govs have won back-to-back OVC series for the first time since 2007. Freshman **Shine Huwe** tied a school single-game record with two home runs in the opener against Evansville. Huwe finished the week with one double, four homeruns, six runs scored and 13 RBI. Senior **Brittany Williams** broke two school record in the finale with Murray State. She became the first Lady Gov to record 100 assists in a season. Williams also broke the APSU all-time assist mark with 435 assists. Freshman **Shelby Norton** was hit by a pitch four times last week to bring her total to six for the season which sets a new single-season freshman mark. Senior pitcher **Abby Marby** picked up three wins, including a complete-game victory versus Belmont. Austin Peay will host Tennessee State on Wednesday and welcome Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (19-17 overall, 9-4 OVC):** Eastern Illinois swept a twinbill with Saint Louis (3-0, 6-4), dropped a doubleheader to Butler (2-5, 0-4) and took two of three from Eastern Kentucky (4-3, 0-7, 2-1 (9)) last week. Junior pitcher **Amber May** tied a her career-high with 10 strikeouts in the finale against Eastern Kentucky. She finished the week with a 3-1 record, striking out 28 batters in 34.2 innings of work. Eastern Illinois will host Southeast Missouri on Wednesday and travel to Illinois on Thursday before heading to UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (12-27 overall, 6-7 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky split a pair with Dayton (4-5, 7-2), dropped a twinbill to Miami (Ohio) (0-2, 4-6) and went 1-2 against Eastern Illinois (3-4, 7-0, 1-2 (9)). In the victory over Dayton, junior **Stacye Toups** allowed two runs on six hits over seven innings of work in the circle. Freshman **Kristen Perry** struck out 23 batters in 23.2 innings of work last week. She tossed a complete-game shutout in the win over Eastern Illinois. Freshman **Rachel Howes** led the Colonels at the plate with a .458 batting average and a .500 on-base percentage. Eastern Kentucky will host Morehead State on Wednesday and travel to Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (19-16 overall, 6-6 OVC):** Jacksonville State defeated Alabama (1-0), UAB (2-1) and took two of three from Morehead State (9-4, 3-4, 4-0). Sophomore **Kacyee Crow** recorded at least one hit in each of the Gamecocks' five games over the week, including a pair of multi-hit games. She went 2-for-2 with a solo home run in the win over UAB. Junior **Ashley Eliasson** won each of her three starts in the circle last week. She posted a 0.93 earned run average with 12 strike outs in 22.2 innings of work last week. Jacksonville State will host Tennessee Tech on Wednesday and Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series on Saturday.

**MOREHEAD STATE (19-16 overall, 9-4 OVC):** Morehead State split a doubleheader with Marshall (2-4, 9-3) and went 1-2 against Jacksonville State (3-9, 4-3, 0-4) last week. The victory over Marshall marked the first time since 2001 that the Eagles have defeated the Thundering Herd. Freshman **Amber Riddle** hit three home runs last week to increase her team-lead to seven. She also recorded nine RBI to lift her team total to 29. She hit a three-run and two-run homer in the 9-3 win over Marshall and added a three-run blast against Jacksonville state. Freshman **Elizabeth Wagner** led the team with a .417 batting average on the week. Senior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** picked up a save against Jacksonville State, giving her two for the year and five in her career which ties the school career record. Morehead State will travel to Eastern Kentucky on Wednesday and to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**MURRAY STATE (13-21 overall, 5-7 OVC):** Murray State split a doubleheader with Trevecca (3-7, 7-4, swept a twinbill with Bethel (6-2, 6-1) and went 1-2 against Austin Peay (3-2 (8), 3-9, 2-4). Freshman **Megan Belio** hit .478 with three triples to extend her hitting streak to eight games. Junior **Jenna Bradley** hit .350 with two home runs and 11 RBI. She also scored six runs and hit two doubles. Junior pitcher **Kristen Broadway** went 2-1 on the week with a 1.97 ERA. She held opponents to a .190 batting average and struck out 25 batters. Freshman **Shelby Kosemecki** picked up her first two career saves. On the week, Kosemecki struck out 19 in 15.1 innings of work. Murray State will travel to Western Kentucky on Tuesday before returning home to host UT Martin on Wednesday and Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (13-22 overall, 4-9 OVC):** Southeast Missouri took two of three from Tennessee State (9-0, 4-6, 7-5) last week. Sophomore **Shelby Stein** hit .600 with a .900 slugging percentage over the three games. She recorded a double, a triple, three runs scored and three RBI while also swiping two bases in three attempts. Sophomore pitcher **Stefanie Barnes** went 2-0 in the circle, striking out nine batters while holding the opponent to a .200 batting average. As a team the Redhawks hit .373 in the series. Freshman **HaLeigh Willis** hit .375 and recorded her first collegiate home run in the series opener.

**SIU EDWARDSVILLE (22-16 overall):** SIU Edwardsville swept a doubleheader with IUPUI (9-3, 8-0 (5)). Sophomore **Megan Murphey** went 2-3 with two RBI while senior **Laurie Seibert** also knocked in a pair of runs in the opener against IUPUI. Freshman **Samantha Stanicek** hit her first home run of the season in the nightcap. The Cougars will host Missouri for a pair on Tuesday and travel to Bradley on Wednesday.

**TENNESSEE STATE (10-24 overall, 5-8 OVC):** Tennessee State dropped doubleheaders to Chattanooga (0-2, 4-10) and Lipscomb (2-11, 0-3) and went 1-2 against Southeast Missouri (0-9, 6-4, 5-7) last week. Junior **Caitlin Eaton** led the Tigers with three home runs and seven RBI. In the win over Southeast Missouri, Eaton hit a pair of hoe runs. Tennessee State will travel to Austin Peay on Wednesday and host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

**TENNESSEE TECH (16-23 overall, 5-8 OVC):** Tennessee Tech defeated Kennesaw State (6-5) and went 1-2 against UT Martin (1-9, 2-3, 6-0). Junior **Kaleigh Gates** hit .500 with a .692 on-base percentage. She led the team with four walks to go with four hits, including a double. Gates also scored four runs for the Eagles. Tennessee Tech will travel to Jacksonville State on Wednesday and to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**UT MARTIN (29-7 overall, 10-3 OVC):** UT Martin took two of three from Tennessee Tech (9-1 (5), 3-2, 0-6) last week. Senior **Megan Van Arsdale** hit .500 over the three games with two home runs and one double. She recorded five RBI and three runs scored. Her two home runs moved her two second on UT Martin's all-time list. Senior pitcher **Paij Lintz** appeared in all three games, earning a win and a save. She tossed a four-hit win and allowed one unearned run in the opening game versus Tech. Lintz struck out 10 batters in 11.0 innings of work. The Skyhawks will host Belmont for a pair on Tuesday, travel to Murray State on Wednesday and host Eastern Illinois for a three-game series this weekend.
