Hillary Downs, OF, Sr., 5'6, Childersburg, Ala. - Jacksonville State Downs reached base in all but four of her 14 plate appearances for a .714 on-base percentage. She recorded two hits in each of JSU's four games and scored at least two runs in three of them. Downs scored a total of eight runs and drove in five more last week. Paij Lintz, P, Sr., 5'7, Lewisburg, Tenn. - UT Martin

Lintz earned four wins and a shutout last week as she tossed 22 innings and struck out 22 batters. She held opponents to a .171 batting average. She carried a no-hitter into the fifth inning at Murray State before eventually ending with a two-hit shutout. Lintz earned two wins over Eastern Illinois striking out 11. She moved into No. 2 all-time at UT Martin in both career wins and career strikeouts.

2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (14-28 overall, 6-11 OVC): Austin Peay defeated Tennessee State (2-1) before dropping three to Morehead State (8-1, 3-2, 6-1). With her win over versus Tennessee State, freshman **Morgan Brewer** became the first Austin Peay pitcher to reach double-figures in wins in a single season since Natasha Anderson did in 2007. It was also the first time an Austin Peay freshman reached 10 wins since Anderson in 2004. Senior **Abby Mabry**, in her only second career at-bat at Austin Peay, broke up Morehead State's Sarah Funtson's no-hit bid in the bottom of the sixth inning with a lead-off single. Sophomore catcher **Amy Mills** threw out five of the seven runners attempting to steal a base this week. Austin Peay will travel to Kentucky for a doubleheader on Wednesday and to Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (20-21 overall, 10-7 OVC): Eastern Illinois defeated Southeast Missouri (2-0) before falling to No. 18 Illinois (8-0) and dropping a three-game series to UT Martin (3-1, 4-1, 7-4). Senior **Denee' Menzione** added to her homerun total with two homers against UT Martin. Menzione's seven homeruns this season increases her current school mark to 26 all-time. The Panthers will travel to Indiana State on Thursday before hosting Austin Peay for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (12-31 overall, 6-11 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to Morehead State (4-2) and dropped a three-game series to Jacksonville State (8-0 (5), 10-2 (5), 15-6 (6)). Freshman **Melissa Costa** led the team with a .417 batting average and four RBI while fellow freshman **Raquel Howes** hit .333 with a pair of runs scored. Eastern Kentucky will host Murray State for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (23-16 overall, 10-6 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Tennessee Tech, 8-5, before sweeping a three-game series with Eastern Kentucky (8-0 (5), 10-2 (5), 15-6 (6)). The Gamecocks scored 33 runs in the series with the Colonels, which set a new school record for runs in a series. Junior pitcher Ashley Eliasson ran her career record to 50-20 moving past Ann Shelton into second place on the school's career wins list. All nine position starters this week for the Gamecocks hit at least one home run in a week that saw JSU hit 11 total and outscore its opponents 41-13. Senior Hillary Downs reached base in all but four of her 14 plate appearances for a .714 on-base percentage. For the week, she hit .667 with a double and a home run. Downs scored eight runs and drove in five. Jacksonville State will travel Southeast Missouri this weekend for a three-game series.

MOREHEAD STATE (23-16 overall, 13-4 OVC): Morehead State went 4-0 last week, defeating Eastern Kentucky (4-2) and sweeping Austin Peay in a three-game series (8-1, 3-2, 6-1). Senior pitcher Alex Gjevre tied her season-high for strikeouts as she fanned 12 batters against Eastern Kentucky. She also set the school career and season record with two saves last week. Freshman Amber Riddler led the team with a .444 batting average. Freshman Kayla Ashbrook hit .429 and led the squad with five RBI. She hit. 500 with all five RBI in the APSU series. Senior Sarah Funston picked up a pair of victories in the circle. Senior Bethany Ellis hit her first home run of the year in the series finale with Austin Peay. Morehead State travels to Western Kentucky for twinbill on Wednesday and host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (15-24 overall, 7-9 OVC): Murray State fell to Western Kentucky, 4-3, in 10 innings and UT Martin, 8-0, before taking two of three from Southeast Missouri (9-1 (5), 6-9, 9-4) last week. The Racers scored 20 of their 24 runs in the Southeast Missouri series with two outs. The Racers hit a season-high four home runs in the series finale with the Redhawks. Sophomore **Megan Glosser** hit .533 with two RBI and four runs scored. She also record two sacrifice bunts and stole four bases. The Racers will travel to SIU Edwardsville for a doubleheader on Tuesday, host Mid Continent for a pair on Thursday before playing a three-game series at Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (14-24 overall, 5-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri fell to Eastern Illinois, 2-0 and went 1-2 against Murray State (1-9, 9-6, 4-9). With the win over the Racers, head coach **Lana Richmond** notched her 799th career victory. Junior **Nicole Troncoso** hit .429 during the week and drove in five of the Redhawks' 11 runs scored. She recorded four doubles against Murray State. Senior **Jennifer Vasquez** extended her season-high hitting streak to six games. Senior **Alex Ramirez** hit her first home run of the season in the second game with Murray State. The Redhawks will travel to SIU Edwardsville on Thursday for a twinbill before hosting Jacksonville State for a three-game series this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (22-19 overall): SIU Edwardsville dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Missouri (11-1 (5), 6-0) and fell at Bradley, 4-2, last week. Junior **Taylor Tooley** went 1-2 and drove in the lone run against Missouri. Junior **Kasey Schlafke** recorded a pair of hits including a home run against Bradley. The Cougars will host Murray State for a doubleheader on Tuesday, Southeast Missouri for two on Thursday and Rhode Island for a single-game on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-27 overall, 6-11 OVC): Tennessee State fell to Austin Peay, 2-1, and went 1-2 against Tennessee Tech (0-8, 0-2, 4-3). Senior **Tamara Perkins** went 3-for-4 at the plate in the win over Tech. She recorded a pair of doubles and scored the tying run. Defensively, Perkins had four putouts and 10 assists. Tennessee State will travel to Middle Tennessee for two on Wednesday and to UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (18-25 overall, 7-10 OVC): Tennessee Tech fell to Jacksonville State, 8-5, and took two of three from Tennessee State (8-0, 2-0, 3-4) last week. Freshman **Chanelle Spalding** hit her first career home run in the second win over Tennessee State. She led the team with five runs scored as she hit .417 on the week. Junior pitcher **Maddie Schmissrauter** posted a 1.75 ERA a she struckout 10 batters in 12.0 innings of work. Tech will host Tennessee on Tuesday and Cumberland for a doubleheader on Thursday before traveling to Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (35-7 overall, 14-3 OVC): UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Belmont (8-0 (5), 2-1), beat Murray State (8-0) and took three from Eastern Illinois (3-1, 4-1, 7-4) last week. Senior **Megan Williams** hit a pair of walk-off home runs last week. In the opening game with Belmont, Williams hit a home run to lead off the game and then came back in the fifth to hit another solo shot. She finished the week with a .421 batting average, three home runs, three stolen bases, five runs scored and seven RBI. Senior **Paij Lintz** moved into the No. 2 spot on the school's all-time list in both career wins and career strikeouts last week. She went 4-0 with a 1.27 ERA while striking out 22 in 22 innings of work. The Skyhawks will travel to Middle Tennessee for a pair on Thursday before hosting Tennessee State for a three-game series this weekend.
