2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (15-31 overall, 7-12 OVC): Austin Peay dropped both ends of a doubleheader at Kentucky (1-10 (5), 2-10 (5)) and split a pair at Eastern Illinois (0-7, 5-3 (8)). With the win over the Panthers, the Lady Govs have now won seven OVC games which equals the total number of league victories in the last two seasons combined. **Morgan Brewer** set the school freshman record for appearances in a single-season with her start in the second game against EIU. Brewer also picked up the win against the Panthers to up her season total to 11 and tie her for 10th most in a single-season at Austin Peay. Freshman **Shelby Norton** hit a two-run homer in the top of the eighth at EIU which proved to be the game-winner. Austin Peay will travel to SIU Edwardsville on Monday for a doubleheader before returning home to host a three-game series with Jacksonville State this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (21-23 overall, 11-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois fell to Indiana State, 5-4 and split two with Austin Peay (7-0, 3-5 (8)). Junior **Kiley Holtz** led the team with a .545 batting average which included the first grand slam by a Panther in the 7-0 win over Austin Peay. She accounted for six of the seven runs in the victory as she also hit a two RBI double. For the week, she drove in eight runs. Junior **Amber May** went 1-1 in the circle last week. She pitched a one-hit shutout in the win over the Lady Govs. May finished the week with a 2.00 ERA while striking out six in 14.0 innings. Eastern Illinois will travel to Tennessee State for a three-game series that starts on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-33 overall, 7-13 OVC): Eastern Kentucky picked one win in the three-game series with Murray State (0-5, 2-0, 14-4 (5)). Freshman **Kristen Perry** tossed a one-hit shutout in the victory over the Racers. She allowed the lone hit in the third inning and struck out seven. Senior **Jena Handley** went 3-for-3 with a run and an RBI in the series finale. Sophomore **Diane Gallagher** went 3-for-4 with a run scored. Her stolen base in the first inning broke the school record for steals in a season. Gallagher's total of 32 surpassed Chanze Patterson's mark of 31 set in 2006. The Colonels will host Kentucky on Tuesday and travel to Tennessee Tech this weekend for a three-game series.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (23-16 overall, 10-6 OVC): Jacksonville State's three-game series at Southeast Missouri was rained out. The Gamecocks will return to the field this week as they travel to Auburn on Tuesday, host Samford on Thursday and play a three-game series at Austin Peay this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (25-19 overall, 14-6 OVC): Morehead State split a doubleheader at Western Kentucky (5-0, 3-9) before dropping two of three against Tennessee Tech (6-4, 1-3, 3-7). Freshman **Kayla Brook**, who is team's leading hitter, led the squad last week with a .385 average. Senior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** tied the school career record for starts on Sunday with her 111th. She earned the shutout against WKU and struck out 10 in the first game against Tennessee Tech. In the Tech series finale, Gjevre allowed just one earned run, but the Eagles committed four errors leading to six unearned runs. Junior **Rebecca Butler** hit her sixth homer of the year at WKU and her 20th of her career. Morehead State will host IUPUI for a pair on Wednesday and travel to Murray State for three this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (20-26 overall, 9-10 OVC): Murray State went 5-2 last week. The Racers split a twinbill with SIU Edwardsville (1-2 (9), 3-2 (8), swept two with Mid-Continent (8-0 (6), 8-4) and took two of three from Eastern Kentucky (5-0, 0-2, 14-4 (5)). The Racers recorded their first two shutouts in program history last week. Freshman **Shelby Kosmecki** posted two straight shutouts in the circle. She allowed just one hit against Mid-Continent and struck out six batters. For the Week, she allowed just two earned runs and fanned 13. Junior **Lauren Buch** hit two home runs on the week, including the game-winner against Mid Con in game two. Freshman **Megan Belio** hit .391 with two RBI and seven runs scored. The 14 runs Murray State scored in the series finale against EIU were the most in a single game and the eight in the fifth inning were the most in single inning. The Racers will host Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (15-25 overall, 5-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri split a doubleheader with SIU Edwardsville (3-2 (9), 2-3) before having its three-game series with Jacksonville State cancelled due to rain. Head coach **Lana Richmond** recorded her 800th career win becoming just the 42nd NCAA softball coach to reach the mark and ranks 18th among active NCAA Division I coaches. With the win, the Redhawks moved to 4-1 in extra inning games. Junior **Megan Walker** hit .667 during the week, scoring two runs including the game-winner versus SIUE. Sophomore **Shelby Stein** batted .571 and drove in Walker with the game-winning double. Junior **Nicole Troncoso** extended her hitting streak to five games. Sophomore pitcher **Stefanie Barnes** earned the victory, tossing all nine innings and tying a career-high with nine strikeouts. Southeast Missouri will host UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (25-21 overall): SIU Edwardsville split doubleheaders with Murray State (2-1 (9), 2-3 (8)) and Southeast Missouri (2-3 (9), 3-2) before defeating Rhode Island (5-1) last week. Junior **Erika Taylor** struck out 28 batters last week, including tying a career-high with 13 in the win over Rhode Island. The Cougars will host Austin Peay for a pair on Monday, travel to Saint Louis for a twinbill on Wednesday and welcome Southern Illinois on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-31 overall, 6-13 OVC): Tennessee State dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Middle Tennessee (2-3, 1-6) and fell twice to UT Martin (0-7, 0-9) last week. Freshman **Hannah Schnebly** led the team in hitting with a .375 batting average, including recording a double. TSU will host Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (22-27 overall, 9-11 OVC): Tennessee Tech fell to Tennessee (0-10), swept a doubleheader with Cumberland (8-0, 6-1) and took two of three from Morehead State (4-6, 3-1, 7-3). Freshman **Melody Christian** hit .591 with a .609 on-base percentage. She scored five runs and drove in one. Christian was also stole five bases last week. Sophomore **Holly Thomas** went 3-1 with a 1.75 ERA, picking up a pair of wins against Morehead State. She struck out 17 batters in 16.0 innings. Tennessee Tech will travel to Western Kentucky on Wednesday and host Eastern Kentucky for three this weekend.

UT MARTIN (37-9 overall, 16-3 OVC): UT Martin dropped a twinbill to Middle Tennessee (0-2, 3-7) and took two from Tennessee State (7-0, 9-0). The Skyhawks hit five home runs against Tennessee State to give them 56 on the year to break the school record of 55 set last year. On the year, UT Martin is now 14-0 at home and has out-scored its opponents 83-16 with six shutouts. Senior **Laurie Lindow** hit .571 last week, with two RBI and one home run. Senior **Paij Lintz** had 10 strikeouts in nine innings of work this week, allowing just three hits. She now has 44 career victories and is only two away from setting a new school record. Lintz also needs just 23 more strikeouts to break the school mark. Senior **Megan Williams'** walk-off home run against Tennessee State was her third walk-off homer in the last 10 games, after having never hit one in her career. UT Martin will host Evansville for two on Tuesday and travel to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.
