PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Amanda Crow, IF, Jr., 5'9, Sharpsburg, Ga. - Jacksonville State

Crow entered the week with just one homer on the year but hit three in Jacksonville State's five games on the week. She also drove in eight runs having just two prior to the start of the week. She hit safely in all five of the Gamecocks' games and drove in at least one run in four of the five. She started the week with a three-run homer to help JSU to a 5-1 win over Tennessee Tech. She helped the Gamecocks take 2-of-3 from the previously unbeaten UT Martin by going 4-of-8 in the series with two home runs, a double, four runs scored and five RBI. In the series opener, Crow hit a two-run homer that erased a one-run deficit and proved to be the game-winner. She had a 1.333 slugging percentage and a .562 on-base percentage over the week.

Morgan Brewer, P, Fr., 5'9, Collierville, Tenn. - Austin Peay

Brewer picked up all three wins last week for the Lady Govs, finishing 3-0, while giving up just two unearned runs in 16.1 innings of work and holding opponents to a .167 batting average. It was the first time since 2007 that an Austin Peay pitcher had one three straight decisions in conference play. She struck out 13 batters while walking just three.

2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (8-23 overall, 3-7 OVC): Austin Peay split a doubleheader with Tennessee State (2-5, 5-4 (10)) before taking 2-of-3 from Southeast Missouri (4-3 (8), 5-12, 11-2 (5)) last week. The three OVC wins are just one away from last season's total. Freshman **Morgan Brewer** picked up three straight conference wins in the circle. She did not allow an earned run while striking out 13 in 16.1 innings of work. Sophomore **Amy Mills** reached base nine out of her 20 plate appearances. She finished the five games with a .353 batting average, seven runs scored, two RBI and one home run. The 11 runs scored against Southeast Missouri were the most by a Lady Govs team in conference play since 2007. Austin Peay will travel to Belmont for a pair on Tuesday, host Evansville for two on Wednesday and will play three at Murray State this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (15-14 overall, 7-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois swept a doubleheader with Southeast Missouri (3-0, 10-2 (6)) before dropping three to Morehead State (2-0, 6-1, 7-3). Six different players hit a home run in the second game against Southeast Missouri, setting a new single-game high during EIU coach Kim Schuette's tenure. The Panthers combined for seven home runs in the doubleheader sweep of the Redhawks. Eastern Illinois will travel to Saint Louis for a twinbill on Tuesday and Butler for a pair on Thursday before returning home to host Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-22 overall, 5-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a twinbill with Morehead State (0-2, 5-0) and won two of three with Tennessee State (4-3, 6-4, 2-1) last week. Junior pitcher **Stacye Touns** led the Colonels to the three victories. She allowed just one earned run in 23.2 innings, walking only three and striking out 13. Sophomore **Diane Gallagher** led the team with a .529 batting average and a .600 on-base percentage over the five games. She was also perfect with five stolen bases in five attempts. Eastern Kentucky will host Dayton for a doubleheader on Monday, Miami (Ohio) for two on Tuesday and travel to Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Friday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (15-15 overall, 4-5 OVC): Jacksonville State split a doubleheader with Tennessee Tech (5-1, 1-4) and took two out of three with UT Martin 97-5, 10-2 (5), 6-9). Senior **Chrissy O'Neal** hit her 37th career home run against UT Martin to move her past Rachel Countryman in second place on JSU's all-time list. Junior **Amanda Crow** entered the week with just one homer but hit three in the Gamecock's five games on the week. She hit safely in all five games and drove in eight runs and scored six times. Junior **Ashley Eliasson** recorded a pair of wins in the circle. She struck out nine in 18.2 innings of work. Jacksonville State will host Alabama State on Tuesday and UAB on Thursday before traveling to Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-13 overall, 8-2 OVC): Morehead State won six of its seven games last week, including a three-game sweep of Eastern Illinois (2-0, 6-1, 7-3). The Eagles also split with Eastern Kentucky (2-0, 0-5) and took two from Bellarmine (4-1, 7-5). Junior **Rebecca Butler** set the Morehead State career home runs record with her 18th in the 2-0 win over EIU. Senior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** went 3-0, winning her fifth, sixth and seventh straight starts. She allowed just three hits in the shutout of the Colonels and then gave up just one hit to go along with eight strikeouts in the opener against Eastern Illinois. Freshman **Kayla Ashbrook** led the team with a .389 batting average and is now hitting .423 in the 10 OVC games. Senior pitcher **Sarah Funston** struck out and allowed only two hits in the second game with EIU. For the week, she was 2-1 with a 0.71 ERA. Morehead State will host Marshall for a twinbill on Wednesday and Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (9-18 overall, 4-5 OVC): Murray State dropped a pair to UT Martin (6-0, 11-3 (5)) before taking two-of-three from Tennessee Tech (12-6, 6-1, 0-4) last week. Freshman **Ellyn Troup** led the team with a .412 batting average. She recorded one double and four RBI over the five games. Troup also had a 1.000 fielding percentage for the week with 31 put outs. Troup now leads the team with seven multi-hit games. Freshman **Starr Gilley** earned her first career win in the circle in the first game against Tennessee Tech. Murray State will host Trevecca Nazarene for two on Monday, Bethel for a twinbill on Thursday and Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (11-20 overall, 2-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Eastern Illinois (3-0, 10-2) and took one of three from Austin Peay (3-4 (8), 12-5, 2-11) last week. Senior **Nicole Troncoso** hit .421 for the week while junior **Elise Sperrakos** batted .400 and drove in three runs. Sophomore **Shelby Stein** hit .385 and is now riding a season-high four-game hitting streak. Senior **Jennifer Vasquez** hit a home run and drove in six runs last week. Southeast Missouri will host Southern Illinois on Wednesday and Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (20-16 overall): SIU Edwardsville swept a doubleheader with Central Arkansas (3-0, 3-1), defeated Western Illinois (9-1 (5)) and beat George Washington (8-0 (5)) last week. The Cougars have now won their last five games. Freshman **Taylor Tooley** hit .455 with three RBI and two home runs last week. Junior **Laurie Siebert** hit a home run and drove in four runs last week. SIUE will host IUPUI for a doubleheader on Tuesday.

TENNESSEE STATE (9-18 overall, 4-6 OVC): Tennessee State split a doubleheader with Austin Peay (5-2, 4-5) and went 1-2 against Eastern Kentucky (3-4, 6-4, 1-2) last week. Junior **Caitlin Eaton** led the team with seven hits and drove in three runs. She was a perfect 3-for-3 from the plate against Austin Peay. Freshman **Hannah Schnebly** didn't allow an earned run in 10.2 innings of work last week. She posted a 1-1 record and struck out nine. Tennessee State will host Chattanooga for a pair on Tuesday, travel to Lipscomb for a twinbill on Wednesday and head to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Friday.

TENNESSEE TECH (14-21 overall, 4-6 OVC): Tennessee Tech split a twinbill with Jacksonville State (1-5, 4-1) and took one of three from Murray State (6-12, 1-6, 4-0) last week. Junior **Kaleigh Gates** led the team in the win over JSU with a pair of home runs while driving in all four runs. She recorded a hit in each game last week. Gates posted a .538 batting average over the five games. Tennessee Tech will face Kennesaw State on Wednesday and host UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (27-6 overall, 8-2 OVC): UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Murray State (6-0, 11-3) and went 1-2 from Jacksonville State (5-7, 2-10, 9-6) last week. Senior **Laura Roberts** led the team with a .529 batting average with two doubles and one home run. She drove in six and scored five runs. She recorded a hit in each of the five games while also stealing two bases. Senior pitcher **Paij Lintz** went 2-1 in the circle last week. She struck out 12 batters in 14.2 innings of work. UT Martin will host Memphis for a twinbill on Wednesday before traveling to Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
