2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (5-14 overall, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay split a twinbill with Stetson last week falling in the first game, 2-0, and taking the second contest, 5-1. With her stolen base versus Stetson, senior **Brittany Williams** became just the seventh player in APSU history to record at least 20 stolen bases in a career. Freshman **Morgan Brewer** pitched a four-hit complete-game victory in the night cap to snap the Lady Gobs' five-game losing streak. She allowed just one runner to get past second base. She also pitched two shutout innings in the first game versus the Hatters. Austin Peay will travel to Tennessee on Wednesday before opening up Conference play at home versus Tennessee Tech this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (6-7 overall, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois was scheduled to play a doubleheader at Evansville this past Saturday but it was cancelled due to rain. The Panthers will return to the field after a week off with a pair of road twinbills at Western Kentucky on Tuesday and Chattanooga on Thursday. EIU will also kick off OVC play this weekend with a three-game series at Jacksonville State starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-14 overall, 0-0 OVC): After starting the season 1-12, Eastern Kentucky went 4-3 last week. The Colonels swept a doubleheader with North Carolina A&T (2-1, 5-3), split with Elon (1-7, 3-2) and beat Winston-Salem State (8-0). EKV also fell to Hartford (5-2) and Towson (9-2). Freshman **Kristin Perry** pitched a complete-game and struck out 13 batters to earn her first collegiate victory in the 2-1 win against North Carolina A&T. In the second game versus North Carolina A&T, Perry came on in relief and struck out five in three innings of work to pick up her second win of the season. In the 3-2 win over Elon, freshman **Raquel Howes** led off the sixth inning with her second home run of the season, which proved to be the game winning run. Perry capped the week by tossing a two-hit shutout against Winston-Salem State, striking out 10 batters. Senior **Jena Handley** batted .435 in the seven games last week. In the second game against North Carolina A&T, she went 2-for-3 with a run and an RBI. Eastern Kentucky will host Western Kentucky for a doubleheader on Wednesday before hitting the road to face UT Martin to open up Conference play this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-9 overall, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State went 3-2 last week, picking up wins over Indiana (6-3), Cleveland State (2-0) and Pittsburgh (1-0). The Gamecocks also fell to UAB (13-5) and Quinnipiac (2-0). Junior **Ashley Eliasson** pitched an eight-inning no hitter in the win over Pitt. It was JSU's first no hitter since Eliasson's five-inning one versus Austin Peay on April 27, 2008. It marked the Gamecocks' first non-shorten no hitter since the 2006 season. Eliasson went 2-0 on the week. Jacksonville State will kick off Conference play at home this weekend as it hosts Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (6-9 overall, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State went 3-1 last week, splitting with SIU Edwardsville (3-4, 5-2) and taking both ends of a doubleheader at Ohio (10-8, 12-7). Freshman **Amber Riddle** hit her first career homerun against SIUE. For the week, Riddle hit .615 with one double and one homerun to go along with four runs scored and five RBI. Riddle currently leads the team in batting with a .364 batting average this season. Junior **Rebecca Butler** belted two three-run homers against Ohio and is now tied for the school's career lead in round trippers. Freshman **Anna Sommer** connected on her first career homerun in the first game at Ohio. Morehead State will travel to Butler for a pair on Tuesday, Kentucky on Thursday and will begin OVC play at Southeast Missouri this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (3-10 overall, 0-0 OVC): Murray State split a doubleheader with Belmont last week, falling in the first game (9-6) and winning the night cap (10-2). Junior **Jenna Bradley** hit a three-run game-winning homer in the second game of the doubleheader. The homerun was the fourth of the season for Bradley and increased her team-high RBI total to 11. Junior **Kristen Broadway** earned the win in the circle for the Racers. She finished the week with eight strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work. Every member of the Racers that has recorded a plate appearance has drove in at least one run this season. Junior **Stephanie Mattocks** is the only players to have hit a single, double, triple and home run this year. Murray State will open up its first ever OVC campaign this week as it travels to Tennessee State for a three-game series.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-11 overall, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 2-4 last week, picking up wins over IPFW (4-3) and SIU Edwardsville. The Redhawks also fell to Illinois State (12-1), Arkansas (4-2), Louisiana Tech (5-3) and SIUE (6-5). The win over IPFW marked the 10th straight victory at home for the Redhawks. The streak was snapped, however, with the loss to Illinois State. Junior **Elise Sperakos** batted .429 while hitting safely in all four games of the Arkansas Tournament and drove in three runs. Junior **Melissa Walker** hit .375 with a double and three runs scored. She is currently riding a five-game hit streak, including her first multi-hit game as a Redhawk versus SIUE. Junior **Nicole Troncoso** led the team with a .568 slugging percentage to go with a .368 batting average last week. She hit a home run to leadoff the first inning versus IPFW. Troncoso drove in two runs and scored five last week. Senior **Alex Ramirez** collected five walks last week to give her 78 for her career which is two shy of the school record. Southeast Missouri will host IUPUI on Tuesday and travel to Indiana State on Wednesday before opening up league play at home versus Morehead State this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (13-12 overall): SIU Edwardsville defeated Missouri State (3-1) and split a doubleheader with Morehead State (4-3, 2-5) before going 2-2 at the Arkansas Tournament. The Cougars defeated Louisiana Tech (7-5) and Southeast Missouri (6-5) and fell to the Redhawks (7-6) and Arkansas (9-3). SIU Edwardsville will host Bradley on Tuesday, travel to Murray State on Wednesday and play in the IU Classic on Saturday where it will face Indiana and Central Michigan.

TENNESSEE STATE (3-10 overall, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State had last week off. The Tigers will return to the field on Wednesday as they host Belmont for a twinbill. TSU kicks off Conference play at home with Murray State in a three-game series that starts on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (8-14 overall, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a pair to Lipscomb (5-0, 2-1) and lost to Liberty (6-2) before going 0-4 at the UT Tournament last week. The Golden Eagles fell to Liberty twice (4-1, 6-2), Tennessee (11-2) and Campbell (4-0). Tech has now lost its last eight games. Tennessee Tech will look to get back on the winning track as it travels to Chattanooga on Tuesday before opening up OVC play at Austin Peay this weekend.

UT MARTIN (14-3 overall, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin defeated Marist (13-0) and Manhattan (4-0) in its first two games at the Rebel Spring Games. Senior **Megan Williams** hit .833 over the two games with one home run, two RBI and three runs scored. She reached base six of the seven times she stepped to the plate. Senior **Paij Lintz** improved to 6-1 on the year with a shutout win over Marist, striking out eight and walking only one. The Skyhawks continue play at the Rebel Spring games with contests against Army and St. Peters on Monday; and Akron and Farleigh Dickinson on Tuesday. UT Martin will open up Conference play this weekend as it hosts Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
