**Lindow** went 5-for-10 at the plate with a pair of doubles and a grand slam to knock in eight runs for the Skyhawks. She also scored three runs during the week, including the game-winner against St. Peters, and was responsible for the game-winning hit against Akron. Lindow added her third home run of the season with a grand slam against Fairleigh Dickinson, the first of her career. Her three home runs this year is the most she has in a season during her four year career.

She pitched a three-hit shut-out against Fairleigh Dickinson to complete a six-game sweep at the Rebel Spring Games for UT Martin then followed it with a four-hit shutout against Eastern Kentucky in the 1-0 win. In 14.0 innings she gave up no runs and issued only two walks. In the ECU shutout, the lone run for the Skyhawks came off a Vanderham game-winning RBI double. She also connected on her second home run of the year against St. Peters and scored three runs.

# 2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (5-17 overall, 0-2 OVC):** Austin Peay fell to No. 17 Tennessee, 10-0, before dropping a pair to Tennessee Tech (12-8, 5-2) to open up Conference play last week. With her stolen base in the first game versus Tech, senior **Brittany Williams** moved into fifth place on the school's all-time list with 21. Freshman **Shine Huwe** hit a home run versus Tennessee Tech to record her first collegiate hit while also driving in a team season-high three runs. Senior pitcher **Megan Williams** moved into a tie for 10th place in all-time appearances at APSU with 63 with her relief appearance against the Golden Eagles. Austin Peay will host Western Kentucky on Wednesday and will travel to UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (8-11 overall, 2-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois dropped twinbills to Western Kentucky (7-4, 6-1) and Chattanooga (3-2, 12-4) before opening up league play with a sweep of Jacksonville State (3-1, 6-4) last week. It marked the first time EIU has swept JSU in regular-season action and also snapped a six-game losing streak to the Gamecocks. Senior **Denee' Menzione** hit her fourth home run of the season to help the Panthers defeat Jacksonville State. For the week, she hit .471 with two home runs and five RBI. Junior **Amber May** pitched a complete game in the 3-1 win over Jacksonville State, striking out seven batters. The Panthers will open up a six-game home stand this week as they host IUPUI for two on Wednesday, SIU Edwardsville on Thursday and Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-19 overall, 0-2 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky lost doubleheaders to Western Kentucky (8-0, 5-0) and UT Martin (5-2, 1-0) last week. Freshman **Kristin Perry** allowed just one run on four hits to go along with three strikeouts in the second game versus UT Martin. Sophomore **Diane Gallagher** recorded three hits and scored a run over the four games while also walking twice. The Colonels will host Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-11 overall, 0-2 OVC):** Jacksonville State dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Eastern Illinois (3-1, 6-4) last week. Senior **Hilary Downs** went 3-for-7 in the twinbill including a 2-for-3 performance in game one. She also connected on her second home run of the season. Jacksonville State will host Kennesaw State on Tuesday and Middle Tennessee for a doubleheader on Wednesday before traveling to Murray State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**MOREHEAD STATE (9-11 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State went 3-2 last week and has now won six of its last eight games. The Eagles split a twinbill with Butler (1-2 (9), 5-1) and fell to Kentucky, 5-1, before sweeping Southeast Missouri (9-2, 7-5). The Eagles ended Southeast Missouri's 13-game regular-season win streak. Sophomore **Kayla Brill** hit .353 last week, including going 5-for-8 in the doubleheader against the Redhawks. Her two-out, two-run home run in the sixth inning of game two tied the contest at 5-5. Freshman **Kayla Ashbrook** led the team with a .357 batting average last week. Freshman **Anna Sommer** hit her second career home run in the first game against Southeast Missouri. Senior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** struck out 24 batters in 22 innings last week. She won both ends of the doubleheader at Southeast Missouri. Morehead State travels to Tennessee State for a three-game series this weekend.

**MURRAY STATE (5-11 overall, 1-1 OVC):** Murray State defeated SIU Edwardsville, 9-1, in five innings before splitting a twinbill with Tennessee State (8-1, 5-7) last week. Junior **Stephanie Mattocks** hit .556 over the three games with five runs scored and two RBI. She was perfect in the field over the three games as she recorded 10 assists. Junior **Kristen Broadway** went 2-0 last week, pitching two complete games. She struck out three in 13.0 innings of action. Junior **Taylor Wilson** hit two home runs in the game against SIUE, for her first and second career home runs. Freshmen **Stephanie Edwards** and **Ellyn Troup** both have five-game hitting streaks, dating back to March 15. Troup has recorded nine of her 11 hits on the season during the five-game hitting streak. Murray State will travel to ULM for games on Monday and Tuesday. The Racers will also play two at Samford on Wednesday before returning home to host Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (9-14 overall, 0-2 OVC):** Southeast Missouri swept a twinbill with IUPUI (15-7, 5-4), split a pair at Indiana State (5-3, 2-4) and dropped a doubleheader to Morehead State (9-2, 7-5) last week. Junior **Nicole Troncoso** hit .478 last week to extend her hitting streak to 11. She scored four runs and drove in five over the six games. Junior **Carmen Fowler** batted .316 with two home runs and six RBI with a .632 slugging percentage. Sophomore **Renee Kertz** had a triple, a grand slam home run and six RBI. Senior **Alex Ramirez** collected two walks during the week to tie the school record for career walks with 80. The Redhawks will travel to Eastern Kentucky for three-game series starting on Saturday.

**SIU EDWARDSVILLE (15-14 overall):** SIU Edwardsville fell at Murray State, 9-1, before splitting a pair of games at the IU Classic. The Cougars defeated Indiana, 11-0, and fell to Central Michigan, 9-3. Junior **Erika Taylor** tossed her second no-hitter of the season to become just the eighth pitcher in school history to have multiple no-hitters in a season. She finished with eight strikeouts on the week. SIUE will host Northwestern on Tuesday and travel to Eastern Illinois on Thursday. SIU Edwardsville will also host the Cougar Classic this weekend where it will play South Dakota State and Northern Illinois each twice.

**TENNESSEE STATE (6-11 overall, 1-1 OVC):** Tennessee State swept a doubleheader with Belmont (8-4, 8-7) and split a twinbill with Murray State (1-8, 7-5) last week. Junior **Brittany Webb** led the team with five hits and four RBI last week. She reached base at least once in every game. Webb also recorded three doubles and scored three times. Freshman **Hannah Schnebly** went 2-0 in the circle to improve to 4-3 on the season. She didn't give up an earned run against Belmont and limited the Bruins to only two hits in the game. Tennessee State will travel to Western Kentucky for a doubleheader on Tuesday before returning home to host Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (10-15 overall, 2-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech fell to Chattanooga, 6-1, before taking two from Austin Peay (12-8, 5-2) last week. Freshman **Melody Christian** scored four runs in the two games against Austin Peay and hit better than .500 for the week. She went 4-for-5 with three runs scored in the first game of the doubleheader and finished 2-for-4 with a runs scored in game two. Tennessee Tech will host a doubleheader with Belmont on Tuesday and travel to Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**UT MARTIN (20-3 overall, 2-0 OVC):** UT Martin defeated Army (10-1), St. Peter's (14-5), Akron (4-2) and Fairleigh Dickinson (9-0) to finish a perfect 6-0 at the Rebel Spring Games. The Skyhawks opened up conference play with a pair of victories over Eastern Kentucky (4-2, 1-0). UTM has reached 20 wins the fastest it ever has in program history. The Skyhawks were the 11th team among those receiving votes in the USA Today/NFCA Top 25 to reach the 20-win plateau. Senior **Laurie Lindow** went 5-for-10 at the plate with a pair of doubles and a grand slam to knock in eight runs. She also scored three runs over the six games. Junior **Kate Vanderham** tossed a pair of complete game shutouts in the circle, while also hitting .455 with four RBI and a home run. During the week, senior **Laura Roberts** became the program's all-time leader in runs scored (112), runs batted in (114) and total bases (114) while already leading in career home runs with 25. UT Martin will travel to Southern Illinois on Wednesday before hosting a three-game series with Austin Peay starting on Saturday.
