2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (5-21 overall, 0-5 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a 4-0 contest to Western Kentucky before being swept by UT Martin (6-1, 5-0, 10-3) last week. Senior **Brittany Williams** became the 26th Lady Gov to record at least 100 hits in her career with her hit in the first game with UTM. Williams also recorded her 400th career assists on defense this past weekend versus the Skyhawks, becoming just the third player in APSU history to reach that mark. Freshman **Shine Huwe** moved into the designated player slot this past week and responded by going 4-for-10 with a double and two walks. Austin Peay will travel to Tennessee State on Tuesday for a twinbill before hosting Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Friday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (13-11 overall, 5-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois took two from IUPUI (4-3 (8), 5-1) and swept Tennessee Tech in a three-game series (1-0, 4-2, 6-3). The 5-0 OVC mark is the best start in league play during head coach **Kim Schutte**'s tenure. Junior pitcher **Amber May** struck out 10 batters in the 1-0 win over Tech to tie a career-high. She picked up four wins in the circle and fanned 28 last week. Junior **Kiley Holtz** hit .615 with a 1.154 slugging percentage over the five games. She scored three runs and drove in six. Eastern Illinois will travel to Southeast Missouri for a pair on Wednesday and to Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (7-20 overall, 2-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky took two of three from Southeast Missouri (5-4, 0-6, 7-2) last week. In the first game with the Redhawks, junior **DeAnn Horswill** drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the seventh. In the series finale, sophomore **Diane Gallagher** went 2-for-4 while freshman **Raquel Howes** went 2-for-4 with two runs scored. Junior pitcher **Stacye Toups** earned both wins in the circle. She gave up just two earned runs while striking out six in 13.1 innings of action last week. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Morehead State for a doubleheader on Tuesday and host Tennessee State for a three-game series starting Friday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (12-13 overall, 1-3 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Kennesaw State (7-6) and split doubleheaders with Middle Tennessee (0-1 (10), 5-1) and Murray State (7-10, 5-3) last week. Junior **Sallie Beth Burch** hit safely in four of the five games, including a going 2-for-3 with a home run against Kennesaw State. For the week she recorded four runs scored and three RBI. Junior **Ashley Eliasson** went 3-0 in the circle last week. She pitched a pair of complete games and struck out 22 in 25 innings of work. In the finale against Murray State, Eliasson fan 10 batters to get the win. Jacksonville State will travel to Tennessee Tech for a twinbill on Tuesday and host UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Friday.

MOREHEAD STATE (11-12 overall, 4-1 OVC): Morehead State took two of three from Tennessee State (5-3 (9), 4-10, 5-3 (8)) last week. Games one and three went to extra innings where the Eagles got a two-run homer from freshman **Amber Riddle** to win 5-3 in nine innings in the opener and a two-out two-run single from sophomore **Sam Woodall** to win 5-3 in the finale in eight innings. Riddle batted .333 and also hit her fourth home run of the year in the second game. Senior **Courtney Seiler** led the team with a .375 batting average in the series. Senior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** won the opener and the finale in complete game efforts. She struck out a season-high 12 in the first game. For the weekend, she had a 1.24 ERA. Morehead State hosts Eastern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Tuesday, Bellarmine for two on Wednesday and Eastern Illinois in a three-game series starting on Friday. Saturday's finale with EIU will be shown live on Wazoo Sports Network.

MURRAY STATE (7-15 overall, 2-2 OVC): Murray State dropped a pair to ULM (5-2, 13-5) and split twinbills with Samford (0-5, 11-3) and Jacksonville State (19-7, 3-5). Junior **Taylor Wilson** hit the first grand slam in program history in the first game against ULM. Junior **Jenna Bradley** became the MSU player to hit more than one multi-run homers in game as she hit a pair of three-run shots against Samford. Freshman **Ellyn Troup** hit .333 with one double, four RBI and four runs scored. She also hit a two home runs on the week, including the game-winner against Jacksonville State. Sophomore pitcher **Chelsey Sullivan** posted a 3.00 ERA while striking out 11 in 12.0 innings of work. Murray State will hit the road this week for a doubleheader at UT Martin on Tuesday and a three-game series at Tennessee Tech starting on Friday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-16 overall, 1-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 1-2 against Eastern Kentucky (4-5, 6-0, 2-7). The loss at ECU snapped the Redhawks' six-game OVC road winning streak. Junior **Melissa Walker** led the team with .375 batting average over the three game while junior **Elise Sperakos** batted .300 with two runs scored and a RBI. Sophomore **Renee Kertz** collected five walks over the weekend for a .583 on-base percentage while senior **Jennifer Vasquez** drove in four runs. Sophomore pitcher **Stefanie Barnes** held the ECU offense to a .222 team batting average. She went 1-1 while striking out nine in 15.2 innings in the circle. Southeast Missouri hosts Eastern Illinois for a pair on Wednesday before traveling to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Friday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (16-16 overall): SIU Edwardsville went 1-2 last week, defeating South Dakota State, 2-1, and falling to Northwestern, 10-5, and Northern Illinois, 11-0. Sophomore **Whitney Davis** went 4-for-7 with three RBI over the three games. In the game against Northwestern, Davis recorded two hits and two RBI. The Cougars will travel to Central Arkansas for two on Tuesday and to Western Illinois for a pair on Friday before hosting George Washington on Sunday.

TENNESSEE STATE (7-15 overall, 2-3 OVC): Tennessee State dropped a pair at Western Kentucky (6-5, 2-1) before going 1-2 against Morehead State (3-5, 10-4, 3-5). Junior **Brittany Webb** recorded her first two home runs of the season last week. She registered a hit in all five games and led the team with six RBI. She went 2-for-3 at the plate and scored two runs in TSU's 10-4 over Morehead State. The Tigers will host Austin Peay on Tuesday for a twinbill before traveling to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Friday.

TENNESSEE TECH (12-18 overall, 2-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech won both ends of the doubleheader with Belmont (10-0, 5-0) before being swept by Eastern Illinois (10-1, 4-2, 6-3) last week. Junior **Lacie Coquerille** led the Tech offense last week as she hit .412 with a double and four RBI. Junior pitcher **Maddie Schmisrauter** tossed a complete-game shutout as the Golden Eagles defeated Belmont. She worked seven innings and struck out nine batters. Tennessee Tech will host Jacksonville State for a doubleheader on Tuesday and Murray State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

UT MARTIN (24-4 overall, 5-0 OVC): UT Martin split a doubleheader with Southern Illinois (4-2, 3-9) before sweeping Austin Peay (6-1, 5-0, 10-3) last week. At the halfway point of the season, UT Martin has 37 home runs, putting it on track to hit 74 and shatter the previous school record of 55. During the mid-week games at SIU, senior **Megan Williams** became the Skyhawks' all-time hits leader and only the second player in school history to record over 300 hits in her career. Williams finished the five games with a .444 batting average and five RBI. Junior **Paij Lintz** picked up a pair of wins last week as she recorded a 2.25 ERA with 15 strikeouts in 16.0 innings of work. UT Martin will host Murray State for a doubleheader on Tuesday before heading to Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Friday.
