PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Kate Vanderham, DP/P, Jr. 6-1, Brookeville, Fla. - UT Martin

Vanderham hit .429 over five games for UT Martin this week, with three home runs and four RBI at the plate while also picking up two wins in the circle. At the plate Vanderham opened the week against Evansville by hitting a two-run homer in the first game of the doubleheader, then followed in the nightcap by hitting a pair of home runs. On the day she was 4-for-7 with three homers and four RBI. In the second game against Evansville Vanderham also tossed a complete game for the win. Against SEMO this weekend Vanderham picked up two more hits and scored a run to help UT Martin clinch the OVC Regular Season title, while again picking up a win in the circle. On the week, Vanderham also earned four walks at the plate, extending her school record walks total to 33 this year.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Paij Lintz, P. Sr. 5-7, Lewisburg, Tenn. - UT Martin

Lintz became UT Martin's all-time winningest pitcher and all-time strikeouts leader this week when she picked up four wins in 24 innings pitched with 30 strikeouts, while tossing a pair of one-hitters and helping the Skyhawks clinch the OVC Regular Season championship. Lintz opened the week with a 7.0 inning complete game one-hit win over Evansville then came in the seventh inning of game two and tossed two innings to pick up the extra-inning win. In the two inning win Lintz recorded five of the six outs by strikeout and on the day picked up 12 strikeouts while also breaking the UT Martin record for career wins. This weekend at SEMO Lintz picked up a pair of wins beginning with an eight inning win with nine strikeouts in game one, then followed it up with a one-hit shutout in the series finale to clinch the OVC title. In the OVC clinching win Lintz again had nine strikeouts and in the process became UT Martin's all-time strikeout leader.

2010 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (15-33 overall, 7-12 OVC): Austin Peay dropped both ends of a doubleheader with SIU Edwardsville (2-3, 0-8) last week. The Lady Govs' three-game series with Jacksonville State was rained out, marking the first time that APSU has failed to play at least one game of a series against an OVC opponent. With the four strikeouts against SIUE, senior **Abby Marby** became the 11th Lady Gov pitcher to record at least 100 total strikeouts in a career. Austin Peay will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (21-23 overall, 11-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois was scheduled to play a three-game series at Tennessee State but it was cancelled due to heavy rains in the Nashville area. The Panthers will return to the field on Saturday as the close out the regular season hosting Murray State for a three game series.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-33 overall, 7-13 OVC): Eastern Kentucky's game with Kentucky last Tuesday was cancelled as well as its three-game series with Tennessee Tech due to inclement weather. EKU will take the field again on Saturday as the host Austin Peay to conclude the regular-season.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (24-17 overall, 10-6 OVC): Jacksonville State fell to Auburn, 8-5, and defeated Samford, 3-2, last week. The Gamecocks have had their last six OVC games rained out after their series at Austin Peay was called because of the storms in Tennessee this weekend. Their series at Southeast Missouri was rained out last week. That pushes their total of conference games lost to rain this season to eight. Freshman Kelci Johnson hit. 429 over the three games with one home run and two RBI. Senior Chrissy O'Neal also went 3-for-7 with a pair of runs batted in. JSU will close out the regular-season this weekend as it hosts Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (27-19 overall, 14-6 OVC): Morehead State swept IUPUI in a doubleheader (7-1, 8-4) Wednesday and had its three-game series at Murray State cancelled. In the IUPUI games, freshman Amber Riddle, junior Rebecca Butler and sophomore Kayla Brill all hit two-run homers, while senior pitcher Alex Gjevre tossed the first six in game one, allowing no runs and striking out nine. She made her school career record 112th start in the game. Sophomore pitcher Ashley Boyd recorded her first career save of the season in the second game. Morehead State concludes the regular season hosting OVC regular season champion UT Martin this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (20-26 overall, 9-10 OVC): Murray State was scheduled to host Morehead State for a trio of games last weekend but all three were cancelled due heavy rain and poor field conditions. The Racers will travel to Eastern Illinois this weekend for a three-game series.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (15-28 overall, 5-15 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped three games to UT Martin (3-4 (8), 1-5, 0-2) last week. Junior **Melissa Walker** led the team with a .500 batting average while senior **Alex Ramirez** hit .333 with two RBI in the series. The Redhawks will travel to Saint Louis for a pair on Wednesday and play a three-game series at Tennessee Tech this weekend to close out the regular-season.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (27-24 overall): SIU Edwardsville closed out its 2010 season going 2-3 last week. The Cougars swept a doubleheader with Austin Peay (3-2, 8-0 (5)), before dropping a pair with Saint Louis (0-1, 4-5) and falling to Southern Illinois, 11-2. SIUE will be eligible to compete in the OVC for the first time next season.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-31 overall, 6-13 OVC): Tennessee State's three-game series with Eastern Illinois was cancelled last weekend due to the heavy rainfall in the Nashville area. The Tigers will now travel to Jacksonville State this weekend to close out the regular-season.

TENNESSEE TECH (23-27 overall, 9-11 OVC): Tennessee Tech defeated Western Kentucky, 9-7, in its only game of the week. The Golden Eagles' series with Eastern Kentucky was cancelled due to heavy rains. Sophomore **Whitney Cummings** picked up the win in the circle while also going 2-for-4 with three RBI, two runs scored and a pair of home runs. Tech will host Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.

UT MARTIN (42-9 overall, 19-3 OVC): UT Martin took both ends of a doubleheader with Evansville (7-2, 8-7 (8)) and swept Southeast Missouri (4-3 (8), 5-1, 2-0) last week to clinch the OVC regular-season title. The Skyhawks set a new school record for wins in a season with 42 and shattered the single-season home run record that now stands at 65. Senior pitcher **Paij Lintz** went 4-0 last week with 30 strikes out in 24.0 innings of work. Lintz became the program's all-time winningest pitcher with 48 career wins and the school's career strikeout leader with 406. Junior **Katie Vanderham** hit .429 over the five games. She hit three home runs and drove in four runners. UT Martin will close out the regular-season with a three-game series at Morehead State starting on Saturday.
