NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Tourney MVP: UT Martin's Jasmie Newsome was named the MVP of the 2011 OVC Basketball Championship after averaging 22.0 points and 3.5 assists in the tourney. She scored 24 points and dished out four assists to lead to the Skyhawks past top-seeded Tennessee Tech en route to its first conference tournament title. Newsome was also named the 2010-11 OVC Co-Defensive Player of the Year. She ranks second in the OVC with 69 steals (2.2 spg). She recorded 43 swipes in conference play and posted five steals three times in 2010-11.

UT Martin Wins First OVC Tourney Title: UT Martin entered the OVC Tournament as the second seed earning a bye in the first two rounds of the event. The Skyhawks knocked off third-seeded Morehead State, 79-69, in the semifinals and beat No. 1 Tennessee Tech, 82-76, to earn its first tourney crown.

Tennessee Tech Wins 16th OVC Regular-Season Title: Tennessee Tech, which was predicted to finish 4th in the league race, earned its 16th OVC regular-season title but its first since the 2005-06 season. The Golden Eagles 16 regular-season crowns is tops in the conference. Tennessee Tech has also won nine OVC Tournament titles most recently in 2000.

Tourney Tidbits: Austin Peay enters the tournament as the fifth seed for the second time in three years....Eastern Illinois is making its fourth straight trip to the tourney... Jacksonville State will be making its sixth appearance in the postseason since joining the OVC in 2003....Morehead State has finished in the top four in the OVC Standings the last three years....Murray State will be appearing in its 18th conference tournament ...Tennessee State earned its fourth straight trip to the OVC Tourney...Tennessee Tech has posted a 41-19 record in OVC Tournament games and has won a league-leading nine tourney titles...UT Martin will play in its third OVC Tourney in the last five years.

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

Team Notes

UT Martin won its first OVC Tournament title in program history as the second-seeded Skyhawks defeated No. 3 Morehead State, 79-69, in the quarterfinals and top-seeded Tennessee Tech, 82-76, in the championship game. Freshman Jasmine Newsome was named the tourney MVP after putting up 22.0 points and dishing out 3.5 assists per game. Newsome had 24 points and four assists to lead the team in the title game. Fellow freshman Heather Butler also earned all-tournament honors. Butler recorded 21.0 point per tourney game. UT Martin's last postseason appearance came in 1999 when the Skyhawks earned a spot in the WNIT. UTM defeated Mississippi, 77-66, in the first round before falling 87-73 to Memphis in the second round.

Tennessee Tech won its 16th OVC regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament. The Golden Eagles defeated No. 5 Austin Peay, 65-56, in the quarterfinals before falling to No. 2 UT Martin, 82-76, in the championship game. Junior Tacarra Hayes was named to the all-tournament team after she recorded 26.5 points and 9.0 rebound per game. Hayes recorded 33 points and seven boards in the championship game. Tennessee Tech made its last postseason appearance in 2006 in the WNIT. Tech defeated Belmont, 56-55, in the first round before falling to Western Kentucky, 83-66, in the second round.
