#### **PLAYER OF THE WEEK:**

Rebecca Butler, 3B, Sr., 5'8, Pendleton, Ind. - Morehead State

Butler extended her hitting streak to 18 games and set a pair of Morehead State career records last week. She batted .500 for the week with a team-best eight RBI and nine runs scored while hitting two doubles and two home runs. Butler set the school's career hit record with her 198th, a two-run homer, at Dayton. She also established a new program career walk record when she was intentionally given first base at Dayton. In the Tennessee State series, she hit .545 with six runs scored, six hits and six RBI.

### **PITCHER OF THE WEEK:**

Tiffany Harbin, P, Fr., 6'0, Hazel Green, Ala. - Jacksonville State Harbin highlighted a record-breaking week with the program's first ever nine-inning no-hitter on Sunday, a 1-0 win that saw her strike out 10 and allow just three base runners, none past first base. She retired the last 16 batters she faced in the victory. Harbin pitched a pair of complete games against the Lady Govs on the weekend and struck out 10 in each game to run her season strikeout total to 191, fourth most in JSU history and the most since 2006. She started the week with a 12-strikeout performance in just five innings of a win over Tennessee State in which she allowed just two hits. In a complete game win over APSU in the series opener, Harbin allowed just three hits in seven innings. Opponents hit .077 against her on the week.

### 2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (10-33 overall, 5-16 OVC):** Austin Peay defeated UT Martin, 5-2, before being swept by Jacksonville State in a three-game series (2-5, 0-5, 0-1 (9)) last week. Sophomore **Shelby Norton** was hit by a pitch four times last week to bring her total to 11 for the season, which is a new school single-season record. With three home runs this week, Austin Peay now has 23 on the season, the most since 2006. Sophomore **Morgan Brewer** is just the third Lady Gov pitcher to appear in at least 35 games in the circle in back-to-back season and the second to do it in her first two seasons. Austin Peay will host Eastern Illinois for a three-game series this weekend.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (32-7 overall, 19-1 OVC):** Eastern Illinois went 5-0 on the week with a pair of wins over Southeast Missouri (2-0, 4-0) and trio of victories against UT Martin (4-1, 2-1, 5-4). The Panthers have won their last nine contests. EIU continues to add to its school home run record as it hit six more this weekend to give the Panthers 38 on the season. Junior **Haliee Hanna** led the team with a .433 batting average while posting a 1.091 slugging percentage. She had a pair of home runs and a double to go with three runs scored and four RBI. Senior **Amber May** went 3-0 in the circle last week to remain undefeated in OVC play. She allowed just one earned run in 22.0 innings of work. She struck out 21 batters and walked just three. Eastern Illinois will travel to Southeast Missouri on Tuesday and Austin Peay this weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (21-21 overall, 8-15 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky saw its losing skid reach eight games as it fell to Tennessee Tech (9-10) and SIU Edwardsville (4-8, 5-7, 1-6) last week. Senior **Shyenne Hussey** led the team with a .556 batting average. She hit a home run against Tennessee Tech to break the school record for career dingers. For the week, Hussey walked five times to go with two home runs, three runs scored and four RBI. The Colonels will travel to Kentucky on Tuesday and Murray State this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (31-11 overall, 16-3 OVC): Jacksonville State went 4-1 last week with wins over Tennessee State (9-1) and Austin Peay (5-2, 5-0, 1-0 (9)). The Gamecocks only loss was a 7-0 setback to UAB. Senior **Amanda Crow** led the offense with two home runs and six RBI while posting a .929 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage. Freshman pitcher **Tiffany Harbin** highlighted a record-setting week with the program's first ever nine-inning no hitter in the 1-0 win over APSU. She tossed a pair of complete games against the Lady Govs. Harbin struck out 32 batters in 21.0 innings of work to give her 191 on the season which is fourth most in school history and the most since 2006. She fanned 12 batters in just five innings in a win over Tennessee State. The Gamecocks will host Tennessee Tech for a pair on Wednesday before traveling to UT Martin this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-27 overall, 9-12 OVC): Morehead State went 5-0 last week, taking both ends of a doubleheader with Dayton (6-1 (10), 14-2 (5)) and sweeping Tennessee State (9-1 (6), 12-4 (5), 11-3 (5)). The Eagle offense hit .429 over the five games with nine home runs. Senior Rebecca Butler set a pair of school records. Butler set a new career hit mark with her 198th which was a two-run home run in the 10th inning against Dayton. She also drew an intentional walk against the Flyers to set the school's career walk record with 70. Butler also extended her hitting streak to 18 games and is batting .524 with six doubles and five homers during the streak. Junior Kayla Brill nearly hit for the cycle and drove in seven runs in the second game with Dayton, setting the school's single-game RBI record. She also set the program's single-season hit-by-pitch record by getting plunked three times against TSU and upping that mark to 16 for the year. Junior Sam Woodall hit .636 (7-of-11) in the TSU series. Freshman pitcher Kelcey McMurray was credited with the win in all five games last week, including three in relief. Against TSU, she tossed two complete games and struck out 17 in 18.1 innings of work. Morehead State will travel to Marshall for a twinbill on Tuesday and to Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (14-23 overall, 7-13 OVC): Murray State fell to SIU Edwardsville (0-11) and went 1-2 against Southeast Missouri (9-10, 4-11, 9-7) last week. Leslie Bridges drove in a season-high five runs in the series opener against the Redhawks. Kristen Broadway struck out a careerbest nine batters on Sunday in 6.1 innings of relief to earn her first victory of the season. The Racers will host Alabama State for a doubleheader on Wednesday and Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series this weekend.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (19-24 overall, 13-10 OVC):** Southeast Missouri dropped both ends of a doubleheader with Eastern Illinois (0-2, 0-4) before taking two of three from Murray State (10-9 (8), 11-4, 7-9). The Redhawks hit eight home runs in the series with Murray State. Senior Carmen Fowler hit .389 with a .722 slugging percentage for the week. She hit two home runs and drove in five while also scoring five times. Freshman **Shelby Kuryllo** batted .375 with a home run and four RBI. **Renee Kertz** drove in six runs, including the game-winning, walk-off hit in game one of the series with the Racers. **Kaitlin Wallace** recorded a pair of home runs in the second game with Murray State. Freshman pitcher **Alora Marble** went 2-0 in the circle last week. She struck out seven in 12.2 innings of work. Southeast Missouri will host Eastern Illinois on Tuesday for a single game and Williams Baptist for a pair on Friday.

**SIU EDWARDSVILLE (22-21 overall, 14-7 OVC):** SIU Edwardsville went 5-0 with wins over Murray State (11-0 (5)) and Eastern Kentucky (8-4, 7-5, 6-1). The Cougars are currently riding a seven game win streak and have won nine of their last 10 games. SIUE hit eight home runs over its last four games after hitting 16 in their first 38. Junior **Paige Sheeder** hit four homers and is now the team leader with six. Freshman **Rachel Coonrod** went 6-for-9 at the plate with a pair of home runs and a 1.333 slugging percentage. Coonrod also walked four times and finished the week with a .769 on-base percentage. Senior **Erika Taylor** struck out 25 last week and needs just three more to pass Sandy Montgomery for second on the school's all-time strikeouts list. Taylor needs just eight strikeouts to become the fifth different player in school history to record 200 or more strikeouts in a season. The Cougars will travel to Southern Illinois for a single game on Tuesday and to Tennessee State for a three-game series this weekend.

**TENNESSEE STATE (10-39 overall, 4-20 OVC):** Tennessee State fell to Jacksonville State (1-9), Memphis (2-7, 0-8) and Morehead State (1-9, 4-12, 3-11) last week. **Tedra Alford** recorded five hits, two home runs and drove in a pair over the five games. Tennessee State will look to snap its nine game losing streak as it hosts SIU Edwardsville for a three-game series this weekend.

**TENNESSEE TECH (16-21 overall, 7-11 OVC):** Tennessee Tech defeated Eastern Kentucky, 10-9, before falling to Western Kentucky (2-6) and Kentucky (0-9 (5), 3-4 (10)) last week. **Callie Schmidt** led the Golden Eagles with a .455 batting average and eight RBI. She hit a pair of home runs and scored twice. Against Eastern Kentucky, she drove in seven of the teams 10 runs with a pair of home runs. Tennessee Tech will travel to Jacksonville State for a doubleheader on Wednesday and host Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

**UT MARTIN (24-19 overall, 13-8 OVC):** UT Martin dropped games to Austin Peay (2-5), Southern Illinois (0-6) and Eastern Illinois (1-4, 1-2, 4-5). The Skyhawks current five-game slide is the longest streak of the season and is the longest since they lost nine in a row in 2009. Sophomore **Leah Taylor** has six triples this year and is tied for second on the school's single-season list. She has also stolen 24 bases this season and needs just five more to set a new program single-season record. Freshman **Amanda Brandenburg** is closing in on the school's single-season double's mark as she has 11 doubles and needs just five more to break the record. UT Martin will look to get back on the winning track as it travels to Belmont for two on Tuesday and host Jacksonville State for three this weekend.
