# 2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (11-35 overall, 6-18 OVC):** Austin Peay won the opening game of the series with Eastern Illinois, 3-2, in eight innings before dropping the next two contests (2-7, 2-11 (5)). Junior **Catie Cozart's** consecutive games started streak now stands at 150 after the games with EIU. Sophomore **Morgan Brewer** appeared in her 38th game in the circle on Saturday against the Panthers, tying her total from 2010 and it makes her the only pitcher in APSU history to have at least 38 appearances in two or more seasons. The Lady Govs will host No. 4/6 Tennessee on Tuesday before traveling to Tennessee Tech this weekend.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (34-9 overall, 21-3 OVC):** Eastern Illinois fell to Southeast Missouri, 8-4, before going 2-1 against Austin Peay (2-3 (8), 2-7, 2-11 (5)) last week. It marked the eighth consecutive OVC series the Panthers have won. Five different Panthers hit a home run last week to up the school-record total to 43 this season. Freshman **Carly Willert** led the team as she hit .563 over the four games. She recorded two doubles and one home run as she knocked in four runs. Willert also stole a pair of bases last week. Eastern Illinois will host Indiana State on Wednesday and travel to IUPUI for a pair on Thursday before entertaining Jacksonville State this weekend.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (22-24 overall, 9-17 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky fell to Kentucky, 7-0, before going 1-2 against Murray State (4-12 (5), 7-9, 9-8) to snap an 11-game losing streak. With the Colonels trailing 7-6 in the top of the fifth of the series finale, **Nikki Bruce** hit a three-run home run to put EKV on top. Bruce finished 2-for-4 with a run and five RBI. Ashley Dollins went 4-for-4 with a run scored while Raquel Howes hit her 11th home run of the season, finishing 2-for-4 with two runs and two RBI. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Dayton for a pair of games on Sunday.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (34-13 overall, 19-5 OVC):** Jacksonville State swept a doubleheader with Tennessee Tech (3-2, 8-3) before dropping two of three at UT Martin (1-3, 9-1, 0-8 (5)) last week. **Amanda Crow** led the team with a .333 batting average. She posted five hits, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI over the five games. Jacksonville State will travel to Alabama State on Wednesday and Eastern Illinois for a three-game series this weekend.

**MOREHEAD STATE (19-29 overall, 10-14 OVC):** Morehead State defeated Marshall, 9-1, before going 1-2 against Tennessee Tech (2-7, 5-3, 0-1) last week. **Rebecca Butler** extended her league-leading hitting streak to 22 games, which also ranks fourth in the nation. Sophomore **Kayla Ashbrook** recorded a hit in each game, including a 2-for-4 performances at Marshall with a home run and two RBI. For the Week, she recorded two doubles, one home run, two runs scored and five RBI. Freshman pitcher **Kelsey McMurray** recorded a 1.62 ERA and struck out 11 over 13.0 innings of work. Morehead State will travel to Ohio State for a doubleheader on Friday before returning home to host Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.

**MURRAY STATE (18-24 overall, 9-14 OVC):** Murray State went 4-1 last week with wins over Alabama State (9-0, 10-4) and Eastern Kentucky (12-4, 9-7). The Racers only loss came to the Colonels in the series finale as they fell, 9-8. The Racers hit 11 home runs on the week and were 15-15 in steals. Senior **Jenna Bradley** went yard four times on the week, driving in 12 runs and scoring 10 times herself while hitting for a .692 average. She posted a .789 on-base percentage and a 1.769 slugging percentage. Murray State had four other players start all five games and hit over .400 for the week. Murray State will close out its home portion of its schedule this week as it hosts Mid Continent on Tuesday and Western Kentucky on Wednesday before welcoming Tennessee State this weekend.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (22-24 overall, 14-10 OVC):** Southeast Missouri defeated Eastern Illinois, 8-4, before sweeping a doubleheader with Williams Baptist (4-1, 5-2) last week. With the victories, the Redhawks improved to 13-7 at home. Southeast Missouri hit .301 as a team and held its opponents to a .241 batting average. The team has hit a home run in six straight games. Freshman **Shelby Kuryllo** hit .571 for the week with three home runs, three runs scored and six RBI. **Carmen Fowler** hit .625 over the three games to push her season average to .413. **Taylor Cowan** posted a .444 batting average while hitting her team-best eighth home run of the season in the opening win over Williams Baptist. She also picked up the victory in the circle against the Lady Eagles. **Shelby Stein** hit .667 with a pinch-hit home run against Eastern Illinois. Freshman pitcher **Alora Marble** recorded two of the Redhawks' three victories in the circle. She recorded a 1.50 ERA, striking out nine batters in 14.0 innings of work. Southeast Missouri will travel to Middle Tennessee for a doubleheader on Thursday and Morehead State this weekend for a three-game series.

**SIU EDWARDSVILLE (24-23 overall, 16-8 OVC):** SIU Edwardsville fell to Southern Illinois, 10-1, in five innings before going 2-1 against Tennessee State (11-0 (5), 5-6 (10), 6-0). Senior **Erika Taylor** tossed her third career no-hitter in the 6-0 win over Tennessee State. She became the first player in school history to throw three no-hitters against Division I competition (Murray State, Indiana, Tennessee State). For the week, Taylor posted a 1.94 ERA with 24 strikeouts in 18.0 innings in the circle. Junior **Megan Murphy** hit .750 over the four games. She recorded six hits, one double, two runs scored and two RBI. The Cougars will host Saint Louis on Tuesday before traveling to Missouri on Wednesday and will return home to host UT Martin this weekend.

**TENNESSEE STATE (11-41 overall, 5-22 OVC):** Tennessee State went 1-2 against SIU Edwardsville (0-11, 6-5, 0-6) last week. Junior **Kelly Troglin** went 1-0 with a 1.40 ERA in the circle for the Lady Tigers last week. She struck out three in 10.0 innings of work. Tennessee State will host Middle Tennessee on Wednesday before traveling to Murray State for a three-game series this weekend.

**TENNESSEE TECH (18-24 overall, 9-14 OVC):** Tennessee Tech dropped a doubleheader to Jacksonville State (2-3, 3-8) and went 2-1 against Morehead State (7-2, 3-5, 1-0) last week. Junior pitcher **Holly Thomas** won two of her three starts, which included a pair of complete-game victories against the Eagles. Thomas struck out 12 batters in 19.2 innings of work. The Golden Eagles will travel to Lipscomb on Wednesday and Belmont on Thursday before returning home to host Austin Peay this weekend.

**UT MARTIN (28-20 overall, 15-8 OVC):** UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Belmont (11-0, 8-2) and went 2-1 against Jacksonville State (3-1, 1-9, 8-0) last week. Freshman pitcher **Amanda Brandenburg** went 3-0 in the circle with a pair of shutouts. She sported a 0.41 ERA while striking out 15 batters in 17.0 innings of work. She also hit .500 for the week and drove in three runs. She had a double and scored five runs while also going 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts. As a team, the Skyhawks were 7-for-8 on the base paths. UT Martin has now recorded 78 stolen bases this season. Sophomore **Leah Taylor** hit her seventh triple of the season and is one away from tying Ashley Benbow for the most triples in a season. Senior **Chelsea Cary** hit her first home run of the season against JSU. She now has four career home runs, one in each season. UT Martin will host Memphis for a single game on Wednesday before traveling to SIU Edwardsville for a three-game series this weekend.
