Crow reached base in all six games for the Gamecocks in a week that saw them go 6-0. She had three multi-hit games over the week. Her best game of the week was 2-for-3, two-homer, three-RBI game against Eastern Kentucky on Saturday. She led JSU to a sweep of EKU by batting .400 with three homers and seven RBI in the series. Crow recorded a .524 on-base percentage and a 1.111 slugging percentage over the week while also being hit by three pitches.

Tiffany Harbin, P, Fr., 6'0, Hazel Green, Ala. - Jacksonville State

Harbin made five appearances and earned five of the Gamecocks' six wins last week, including all three victories in a series sweep at Eastern Kentucky to start the OVC season. She started the week by throwing the first three innings of a combined no-hitter against Samford, striking out four. Harbin tossed 1.1 hitless innings out of the pen and earned the win in relief versus Kennesaw State. She started the first game of the EKU series and went the distance, shutting out the Colonels on two hits. Harbin earned another win in relief in game two of the series with three innings of work. She wrapped up the week with a complete-game win over EKU as she struck out six. She walked just one batter and fanned 20 in 19.1 innings of action over the week, holding opposing hitters to a .138 average.

2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (3-16 overall, 0-3 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a trio of games to Morehead State (2-5, 11-16, 2-3) to open up conference play. The 16 runs given up in the second game were the most runs given up in a contest in coach Casey Dickson's three seasons at Austin Peay. Junior **Amy Mills** recorded four hits in the second game, becoming the first Lady Gov to collect four hits in a game since 2009. Freshman **Lauren de Castro** led the team with a .625 batting average and a 1.125 slugging percentage. She recorded five hits, including a double and a home run. Austin Peay will host Belmont on Wednesday and Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (7-5 overall, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois defeated Columbia (5-0) and Fairleigh Dickinson (2-1) to open up play in the Rebel Spring Games last week. Senior pitcher **Amber May** improved to 2-3 on the season with a win over Fairleigh Dickinson. She struck out a career-high 14 batters. It marks the most strikeouts by a Panthers in over 20 years. In the win over Columbia, seniors **Melinda Jackson** and **Kiley Holtz** hit back-to-back home runs. Eastern Illinois continues play in the Rebel Spring Games this week facing Siena, Hartford, Houston Baptist, Manhattan, Akron and Rider. The Panthers will also travel to Murray State for three-games this weekend to open up OVC play.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-9 overall, 0-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky picked up wins over Wagner (8-0), Bryant (12-1) and Yale (7-0) while also losing to Sacred Heart (1-4) at the Rebel Games. The Colonels were swept by Jacksonville State in a three-game series (0-9, 2-6, 2-4) to open up Conference play. Sophomore **Raquel Howes** led the team with a .450 batting average, 1.000 slugging percentage and a .522 on-base percentage. She hit three home runs including a pair in the JSU series and drove in 11 runs. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Austin Peay for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (14-6 overall, 3-0 OVC): Jacksonville State went 6-0 last week with wins over Samford (9-0, 6-0), Kennesaw State (5-4) and Eastern Kentucky (9-0, 6-2, 4-2). The victory in the finale with Eastern Kentucky marked head coach Jana McGinnis' 600th career win. Senior **Amanda Crow** reached base in all six games last week and had three multi-hit games. She hit .400 with three home runs and seven RBI in the series sweep of Eastern Kentucky. Freshman pitcher **Tiffany Harbin** made five appearances and earned five of the Gamecocks' six wins last week. She started the week throwing the first three innings of a combined no-hitter against Samford. For the week, she recorded two complete games and one shutout. Harbin struck out 20 batters and walked just one in 19.1 innings of work. Jacksonville State will travel to Samford for a pair on Thursday and host Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (9-11 overall, 3-0 OVC): Morehead State fell to Louisville (1-12) before sweeping a three-game series at home against Austin Peay (5-2, 16-11, 3-2). Morehead State has now won 12 consecutive games against APSU. The Eagles' 3-0 OVC starts is its best since beginning 4-0 in 1996. Sophomore **Elizabeth Wagner** hit .615 for the week, including batting .700 (7-for-10) in the APSU series. She scored five runs and drove in four while also hitting her second home run of the year. Junior pitcher **Ashley Imperial** picked up the win in the first and third games of the series with the Lady Govs while also earning her second career save in the second game. Freshman walk-on **Corrie Roberts**, who entered the weekend with one career plate appearance, hit a pinch-hit solo home run in the bottom of the sixth in game three to life the Eagles to a 3-2 comeback victory. Junior **Jami Whitcomb** earned the win in game two marking her first career Division I victory. Morehead State will travel to Ohio on Wednesday before playing a three-game series at Jacksonville State this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (3-11 overall, 0-3 OVC): Murray State dropped a three-game series to UT Martin (5-6, 0-3, 6-14) to open up OVC play last week. **Jenna Bradley** hit a pair of home runs in the series with the Skyhawks while **Lauren Buch** raised her averaged back to .500 on the season with four hits over the three games. Buch also walked four times and was hit once. The Racers will step out of conference play for a doubleheader at UAB on Tuesday before hosting Eastern Illinois for a three-game series this weekend to open its home portion of the its 2011 schedule.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (5-12 overall, 2-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri fell to Southern Illinois, 10-0, before going 2-1 against SIU Edwardsville to open up conference play. Senior **Carmen Fowler** hit .500 with a .571 slugging percentage. She scored a pair of runs and drove in five over the four games. In the series finale with the Cougars, Fowler was 3-for-3 with one RBI. Senior **Nicole Troncoso** hit .462 with a double, home runs and five RBI. In the second game with SIUE, Troncoso hit a two-run shot in the top of the eight that was the eventual game-winner. Freshman **Shelby Kuryllo** hit her first career home run, a grand slam, in the top of the ninth inning of the Redhawks' 11-4 win over SIUE. Southeast Missouri will travel to Belmont on Thursday and return home to host Tennessee Tech this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (8-16 overall, 1-2 OVC): SIU Edwardsville dropped a doubleheader at Western Kentucky (0-4, 2-7), split a twinbill with Belmont (5-2, 1-2 (9)) and went 1-2 in its first ever OVC series with Southeast Missouri (4-11 (9), 6-8 (8), 11-1 (5)). Sophomore **Taylor Tooley** hit .400 for the week with three doubles, one home run and five RBI. She also stole a base. Tooley took over the team lead in RBI with 11 and is tied for the team lead in hits with **Rachel Coonrod** with 20. Freshman **Chelsea Yankolovich** hit her first career home run in series with the Redhawks. Freshman **Kayla Riggs** went 2-for-3 pinch hitting last week with a walk. The Cougars will travel to Southern Illinois on Tuesday and Indiana State on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (7-17 overall, 1-2 OVC): Tennessee State went 1-2 against Tennessee Tech (3-5, 1-2, 4-1) to open up OVC play last week. Sophomore **Tedra Alford** recorded at least one hit in each game last week, She went 2-for-3 at the plate in game two against Tennessee Tech before recording two RBI and her second home run of the season to help the Tigers pick up the 4-1 win over Tech. Senior pitcher **Caitlin Eaton** went 1-1 in the circle for TSU. She allowed just two walks and struck out eight in 13.0 innings of work. Tennessee State hosts Tennessee on Tuesday, Western Kentucky on Wednesday and UT Martin this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (9-8 overall, 2-1 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 2-1 against Tennessee State (5-3, 2-1, 1-4) last week to open up OVC play. Senior **Lacie Coquerille** recorded a hit in each game of the series and drove in a pair of runs. Junior pitcher **Whitney Cummings** earned her third victory of the season in the 2-1 win over TSU. She entered the game in the third inning and allowed just one base runner while striking out six in 4.1 innings of work. Tech will host Tennessee Wesleyan on Tuesday before traveling to Southeast Missouri this weekend.

UT MARTIN (13-8 overall, 3-0 OVC): UT Martin swept a three-game series with Murray State (6-5 (10), 3-0, 14-6 (5)) to open up OVC play. Sophomore **Leah Taylor** hit a pair of home runs and drove in six over the three games. She recorded a 1.000 slugging percentage and a .571 on-base percentage. She leads the team with five home runs this season. Junior pitcher **Chelsea Jones** pitched her fifth complete game and her fourth shutout of season in the 3-0 win over Murray State. Jones struck out 12 batters to up her season total to 74 in 11 appearances. The Skyhawks will travel to Evansville on Wednesday and Tennessee State this weekend.
