Abbey Stepp, 1B/DP, Jr., 5'9, Versailles, Ky. - Jacksonville State

Stepp recorded multiple hits and drove in at least one run in all five games for the Gamecocks last week. She started the week by going 4-for-6 with seven RBI in the doubleheader sweep at Samford, including a school-record tying two home runs in the first game. Stepp went 2-for-3 in both games of the twinbill, driving in five runs in the first game. She went 7-for-8 over the weekend with a double, home run, five RBI and three walks in the sweep of Morehead State. She went 3-for-4 with a double, home run and three RBI in the opener before going 2-for-2 in each of the last two games of the series sweep. Stepp posted a .778 on-base percentage and a 1.500 slugging percentage over the week.

2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (4-19 overall, 0-6 OVC): Austin Peay defeated Belmont (6-1) before being swept by Eastern Kentucky (3-5, 2-11 (5), 4-9) last week. Junior **Catie Cozart** hit a triple on Saturday versus ECU which was the fifth of the year for the Lady Govs, matching last year's team season total. Senior **Randal Davenport** was hit by a pitch for the fifth time this season in the series with the Colonels, bringing her career total to 13, which is just one shy of tying the school's all-time mark. The Lady Govs will host the second of their two home classics this weekend as they welcome Eastern Michigan and Southern.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (16-5 overall, 3-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois finished the Rebel Games with a perfect 8-0 record after getting wins over Siena (7-3), Hartford (2-1), Houston Baptist (7-3), Manhattan (8-1), Akron (3-0) and Rider (9-0(5)) last week. The Panthers also opened up OVC action with a sweep of Murray State (5-2, 4-0, 5-0). EIU has now won its last 11 contests which sets a new Division I program mark. Sophomore **Melisse Brown** hit .577 over the nine games with two doubles, two home runs and a triple. She scored 10 runs and drove in eight. Brown also stole three bases. She had her career-high 14-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday. Senior **Amber May** went 4-0 in four starts and notched her first save of the season last week. She struck out 34 batters in 28.2 innings of work, including falling one shy of her career-high with 13 strikeouts in the first game against Murray State. Eastern Illinois will host Illinois on Thursday and welcome Tennessee State this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (16-9 overall, 3-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky swept a conference series from Austin Peay (5-3, 11-2 (5), 9-4) last week. In the series finale on Sunday, ECU softball and head coach **Jane Worthington** earned the 500th victory in program history. Eastern Kentucky's softball program started in 1993. Worthington, in her 19th season, is the only head coach in program history. ECU now has an all-time record of 500-479. Four Colonels hit .400 or better and seven had a .300 or better average in the three games against APSU. **Diane Gallagher** led the way with a .500 average, three runs, three RBI and three stolen bases. She tied the school career record for steals on Saturday. **Ashley Dollins** hit .455 with two runs, three doubles, a home run and four RBI in the series. Senior **Noelani Esperas** picked up two wins against the Lady Govs. She held opponents to a .186 batting average. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Tennessee Tech for two on Tuesday before returning home to host UT Martin this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (19-6 overall, 6-0 OVC): Jacksonville State took both ends of a doubleheader with Samford (10-1 (6), 7-3) before sweeping a three-game series with Morehead State (10-3, 12-9, 7-3). The Gamecocks' 6-0 OVC start is their second-best start since joining the league. The 22 runs scored in Saturday's doubleheader with the Eagles were the most by the Gamecocks in a twinbill since scoring 22 against Morehead State in 2007. Junior **Abbey Stepp** hit .786 over the five games with one double and three home runs. She recorded 12 RBI and scored five runs. She posted a .788 on-base percentage and a 1.500 slugging percentage. Freshman pitcher **Tiffany Harbin** picked up three wins and a save last week. She struck out 24 batters in 18.0 innings of work. Jacksonville State will travel to Tennessee State for a twinbill on Tuesday and Middle Tennessee for a pair on Wednesday before returning home to host Southeast Missouri this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (9-16 overall, 3-3 OVC): Morehead State lost all five games last week, dropping a pair to Ohio (0-10 (5), 12-13) before being swept at Jacksonville State (3-10, 9-12, 3-7). The Eagles hit nine home runs during the week, including two by sophomore **Amber Riddle** and junior **Kayla Brill** and three by **Rebecca Butler**. Butler upped her school career-leading home run total to 23 while Brill moved into third place on the list with 14. Riddle led the Eagles at the plate with a .400 batting average and six RBI. The Eagles have allowed their opponents 95 runs in the first three innings this year while Morehead State has scored 62 runs in the third through fifth innings. Morehead State travels to Miami University for a doubleheader on Thursday and host new OVC foe SIU Edwardsville in a three-game set this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (3-21 overall, 0-6 OVC): Murray State split a twinbill with UAB (0-4, 2-0) before being swept by Eastern Illinois (2-5, 0-4, 0-5). The Racers handed UAB just its second loss in 14 games. **Megan Glosser** led the team with five hits for a .357 average on the week. Murray State travel to SIU Edwardsville for a pair on Tuesday before hosting Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (7-15 overall, 4-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped a pair at Belmont (0-3, 5-6 (8)) before going 2-1 against Tennessee Tech (4-1, 6-3, 1-4). Junior **Cheyenne Gipson** hit .353 with a pair of RBI while also stealing four bases last week. **Kaitlin Wallace** hit .500 for the week with a .600 slugging percentage. **Nicole Troncso** drove in three runs with a double in the 4-1 win over Tech. She finished with five RBI on the week and three of her four hits were doubles. **Shelby Kuryllo** recorded her second home run of the season with a three-run shot in the 6-3 victory over the Golden Eagles. The Redhawks were a perfect 10-for-10 on the base paths. They are 25-for-27 in stolen base attempts this season, surpassing their season total from last year. Southeast Missouri will host Evansville for a pair on Wednesday before traveling to Jacksonville State this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (9-16 overall, 1-2 OVC): SIU Edwardsville defeated Indiana State, 4-1, in its only game of the week. Freshman **Rachel Coonrod** went 2-for-3 and drove in the eventual game-winning run. Coonrod and sophomore **Taylor Tooley** are tied for the team lead with 22 hits. Senior pitcher **Erika Taylor** lowered her season ERA to 2.75 after allowing just one earned run in the win. She struck out 11 batters and walked four in the complete game effort. The Cougars will host Murray State for a doubleheader on Tuesday before traveling to Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE STATE (7-21 overall, 1-5 OVC): Tennessee State dropped games to Tennessee (2-16) and Western Kentucky (4-13) before being swept by UT Martin (4-6, 4-12, 3-6) last week. **Brittany Webb** hit .375 with a team-leading three RBI over the five games. Tennessee State will look to snap its five-game losing streak as it hosts Jacksonville State for a pair on Tuesday before traveling to Eastern Illinois this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (12-10 overall, 3-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech took two from Tennessee Wesleyan (8-0, 9-0) before going 1-2 against Southeast Missouri 91-4, 3-6, 4-1) Sophomore **Chanelle Spalding** started all five games and drove in a team-high five RBI last week. She recorded a .429 batting average with a double and a home run. Junior pitcher **Holly Thomas** improved to 8-4 on the season after going 2-1 last week. She struck out 20 in 16.0 innings of action. The Golden Eagles will host Eastern Kentucky for two on Tuesday before traveling to Murray State for three this weekend.

UT MARTIN (17-9 overall, 6-0 OVC): UT Martin split a doubleheader with Evansville (6-7 (8), 7-3) before sweeping Tennessee State (6-4, 12-6, 6-3) last week. Sophomore **Leah Taylor** hit .294 on the week with one triple and three home runs. She scored 10 runs and drove in seven while also stealing five bases. She stole four bases in one game to tie the school record. Junior pitcher **Chelsea Jones** went 3-0 last week with a pair of complete games. She struck out 20 and walked five in 17.0 innings of action. UT Martin will host Austin Peay for two on Tuesday before traveling to Eastern Kentucky this weekend.
