2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (6-22 overall, 1-7 OVC): Austin Peay split a twinbill with UT Martin (7-6 (9), 0-6) before going 1-2 against Eastern Michigan (3-8, 1-3 (8), 5-4) last week. With her double against EMU, senior **Tiffany Smith** became the sixth Lady Gov to record at least 30 doubles in her career. Junior **Amy Mills** led the team with a .389 batting average, including going 3-for-3 in the win over Eastern Michigan. Mills recorded a pair of doubles and drove in four over the five games. The Lady Govs will host No. 11 Tennessee on Tuesday, marking the first nationally ranked team to visit Clarksville since 1995. Austin Peay will also welcome Tennessee State on Thursday before traveling to Southeast Missouri this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (19-5 overall, 6-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois swept Tennessee State (10-0 (5), 13-0 (5), 10-3) to remain undefeated in OVC play and run its win streak to 14 straight victories. The Panthers 19-5 overall mark is its best start since they began competing in Division I in 1983. Eastern Illinois hit eight home runs over the three-game series and is just six homers shy of tying last year's school-record. Sophomore **Melisa Brown** hit .700 for the series with one double, two home runs and six RBI. She also scored five runs. Freshman **Stephanie Maday** tossed the first no-hitter since EIU joined the OVC in 1997. She struck out eight in five innings of work to get the win. The Panthers will travel to SIU Edwardsville for a pair on Wednesday and Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (18-11 overall, 5-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a pair of doubleheaders with Tennessee Tech (3-4, 3-2) and UT Martin (7-8, 9-4) last week. Junior Diane Gallagher broke the school record for career stolen bases in the second game with Tennessee Tech. In the win over UT Martin, junior **Larkyn Wood** went 1-for-2 with two runs, two RBI and a walk. She finished the week with a pair of doubles and four RBI. Sophomore **Kristin Perry** earned both of EKU's wins. She tossed a pair of complete games in the wins over Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. Perry fanned 10 in 14 innings of work. In the two games on Saturday, Eastern Kentucky and UT Martin combined for 28 runs. Eastern Kentucky will host Morehead State for a doubleheader on Wednesday before traveling to Tennessee State this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (23-8 overall, 10-1 OVC): Jacksonville State swept a doubleheader with Tennessee State (8-3, 3-1), fell to Middle Tennessee (2-4) and went 2-1 against Southeast Missouri (6-7, 8-5, 13-8) last week. Junior **Kristin Graham** posted at least one hit in all six games, including at least one extra base hit in four of them. She hit .500 over the six games with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and 10 runs scored. Sophomore pitcher **Hilary Phillips** earned both wins in the series with Southeast Missouri. She allowed just one unearned run and struck out seven in eight innings of work against the Redhawks. Jacksonville State will host Southern on Tuesday, Tennessee Tech on Wednesday and travel to SIU Edwardsville this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (9-21 overall, 3-6 OVC): Morehead State saw its losing streak stretch to 10 games as the Eagles fell to Miami University (1-8, 4-8) and SIU Edwardsville (3-7, 3-4, 2-7) last week. Senior **Rebecca Butler** hit .529 for the week and set the school record for doubles (39) at Miami. Butler had previously set the school career RBI mark (108) last weekend. **Kayla Brill**, **Elizabeth Wagner** and **Kayla Ashbrook** all recorded home runs last week. Wagner hit .400 as well. Morehead State registered 27 hits in the SIUE series but left 29 runners on base. Morehead State will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a pair on Wednesday and host Murray State for a three-game series this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (6-17 overall, 2-8 OVC): Murray State split a pair of doubleheaders with SIU Edwardsville (4-6, 3-0) and Tennessee Tech (11-18, 8-0 (5)) last week. Senior **Lauren Buch** homered in three of the four games last week. She hit her first career grand slam in the first game with Tech. Buch reached base eight times against the Golden Eagles, drawing five walks, two hits and was hit by a pitch. She hit .556 for the week with seven RBI and seven runs scored. **Chelsea Sullivan** tossed a seven inning shutout in the win over SIUE while **Shelby Kosmecki** blanked Tennessee Tech. **Jenna Bradley** also hit three home runs on the week. Murray State will hit the road as the Racers travel to Evansville for a twinbill on Wednesday and Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (9-18 overall, 5-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri split a doubleheader with Evansville (2-4 (8), 9-0) and went 1-2 against Jacksonville State (7-6, 5-8, 8-13). The Redhawks picked up their first ever victory over the Gamecocks in 22 tries. Junior **Renee Kertz** hit .500 with a 1.143 slugging percentage last week. She reached base on 11 of her 16 plate appearances. Kertz recorded three home runs, four runs scored and eight RBI over the five games. Freshman **Alora Marble** allowed just one hit and struck out three in the shutout victory over Evansville. Marble also picked up the win over JSU in relief. **Shea Cothren** struck out a career-high six in the series finale with Jacksonville State. **Carmen Fowler** hit .471 with three doubles and five RBI on the week. **Evan Sallis** batted .421 as she recorded three multi-hit games. **Nicole Troncoso** extended her hitting streak to a season-high nine games while **Taylor Cowan** hit two home runs and scored six times. Southeast Missouri will host UT Martin for a pair on Wednesday and Austin Peay for a three-game set this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (13-17 overall, 5-3 OVC): SIU Edwardsville split a doubleheader with Murray State (6-4, 0-3) before sweeping its first ever OVC series with Morehead State (7-3, 4-3, 7-2). Senior **Kasey Schlafke** hit .463 over the five games with one home run, two doubles, four runs scored and six RBI. She raised her average in OVC play to .364. Senior **Erika Taylor** earned three wins last week and struck out a total of 31 batters. She fanned a career-high 14 in the series finale with Morehead State. Taylor, 10-8 overall, now has collected 10 or more wins and 125 or more strikeouts in each of her four seasons as a Cougar. She is now eighth on the school's all-time wins list with 59 and third on the all-time strikeouts list with 590. With two more home runs this week, sophomore **Taylor Tooley** needs one more to become the 17th player in school history to collect 10 or more home runs. The Cougars will host Eastern Illinois for a doubleheader on Wednesday and Jacksonville State for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE STATE (7-27 overall, 1-10 OVC): Tennessee State fell to Jacksonville State (3-8, 1-3) and Eastern Illinois (0-10 (5), 0-13 (5), 3-10) last week. **Brittany Webb** led the team with two RBI on the week while **Tedra Alford** posted a squad-best six hits, including two doubles. The Tigers will look to snap its 10-game losing streak as they travel to Austin Peay for a doubleheader on Thursday and Eastern Kentucky for a three-game set this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (14-12 overall, 5-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech split doubleheaders with Eastern Kentucky (4-3, 2-3) and Murray State (18-11, 0-8 (5)) last week. Sophomore **Melody Christian** recorded five hits in 10 at-bats last week. She also recorded six walks and a team-best six hits. She finished the week with five stolen bases in six attempts. Tennessee Tech will travel to Jacksonville State on Wednesday and host Eastern Illinois this weekend.

UT MARTIN (19-11 overall, 8-2 OVC): UT Martin split doubleheaders with Austin Peay (6-7 (9), 6-0) and Eastern Kentucky (8-7, 4-9) last week. The loss to Austin Peay snapped the Skyhawks' 23-game home winning streak. The Skyhawks are now 4-3 in extra inning games and 6-5 in one-run decisions. Senior **Kate Vanderham** was 3-for-4 in the win over EKU. She also hit a 3-run home run in the loss to the Colonels. Vanderham ran her hitting streak to 10 games last week. Junior **Chelsea Jones** went 1-1 with 14 strikeouts in the circle last week. UT Martin will travel to Southeast Missouri on Wednesday and to non-conference foe Georgia this weekend.
