**Wood** led Eastern Kentucky to three wins in its first four games on a spring break trip to Florida. In addition to her .571 batting average, she posted a 1.143 slugging percentage and a .600 on-base percentage. In the two games on Sunday, Wood combined to go 6-for-7 with two home runs, five RBI and four runs scored. She had an RBI double in the bottom of the seventh that began a three-run rally to send the game against Loyola into extra innings. The Colonels won in the bottom of the eighth. In an 11-4 victory over Penn, Wood hit a pair of two-run home runs and finished 4-for-4 at the plate.

# 2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (3-13 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay went 1-2 at the Buzz Classic last week. The Lady Govs defeated Alabama State, 8-1, and fell to Mercer (8-0) and Kennesaw State (1-0). Junior right hander **Ashley Bolda** picked up her first win since her freshman year, pitching a complete game against Alabama State. She fanned five batters and walked just one. Senior **Tiffany Smith** hit a home run against Alabama State to give her three for the season. Austin Peay will open up OVC play this weekend as it travels to Morehead State.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-5 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois split a pair of games at the rain shorten Lipscomb Lady Bison Classic. The Panthers defeated Butler, 6-0, before falling to Appalachian State, 3-0. Senior **Melinda Jackson** went 2-for-2, hitting consecutive home runs to give her four RBI in the win over the Bulldogs. She finished the week with a 1.600 slugging percentage. Freshman pitcher **Stephanie Maday** picked up the shutout victory over Butler. She fanned a career-high 12 batters and scattered just four hits while allowing the Bulldogs to hit just .138 off her. Eastern Illinois will travel to the Rebel Games this week as the Panthers take on Columbia and Fairleigh Dickinson on Sunday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-5 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky has won three of its four games on its Spring Break trip to Florida for the Rebel Games. The Colonels have posted wins over South Dakota (6-2), Loyola (6-5 (8)) and Penn (11-4). The Colonels also fell to South Dakota, 6-8. Junior **Larkyn Wood** led the Colonels with a .571 batting average over the four games. She recorded five runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI. In the win over Penn, Wood went 4-for-4 at the plate with a pair of home runs. **Cassi Gipson** also hit a two-run shot against the Quakers. Eastern Kentucky continues play in the Rebel Games with Wagner and Bryant on Monday; and Sacred Heart and Yale on Wednesday. The Colonels also open up league play this weekend at home with Jacksonville State.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (8-6 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State defeated Kennesaw State, 11-1, in five innings before going 1-2 at the Buzz Classic. The Gamecocks defeated Akron, 4-1, and fell to Georgia Tech (4-3) and Penn State (6-4). Junior **Kristin Graham** posted a .833 slugging percentage and a .600 on-base percentage. She recorded a .500 batting average and had an extra-base hit in three of the four games, including a three-run home run against Kennesaw State. Graham went 3-for-3 with an RBI in the win over Akron. Jacksonville State will host Samford for a doubleheader on Tuesday and Kennesaw State for a single game on Thursday before opening up conference play at Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

**MOREHEAD STATE (6-10 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State swept Oakland in a doubleheader (8-7 (8), 2-0) on Friday and had its entire Comfort Inn and Suites Classic cancelled due to rain and cold temperatures in Morehead on Saturday and Sunday. In the opening game against OU, sophomore **Kayla Ashbrook** hit her third home run of the year, a three-run shot. Freshman **Stephanie Etter** collected three RBI as well as a bases-clearing double. **Sam Woodall** provided the game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the eighth. She also added two hits in the second game. In the nightcap, freshman pitcher **Kelsey McMurray** tossed her first career complete game shutout, limiting the Grizzlies to only two hits in a 2-0 victory. Head coach **Holly Bruder** went over the 100-win mark for her Morehead State career as well. Morehead State opens up OVC play this weekend as it hosts Austin Peay.

**MURRAY STATE (3-8 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State finished the weekend 1-4 at the DeMarnie Classic in Fullerton, Calif. The Racers picked up a 7-2 win over Iowa while falling to Cal State Northridge (6-4), Oregon State (7-3), Cal (8-0) and Stanford (14-2). **Stephanie Edwards** went 2-for-2 in the win with a double and a triple. **Meghan Sims** went 1-for-3 against the Hawkeyes with three RBI. Murray State will begin conference play this weekend as it travels to UT Martin.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-10 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri dropped games to Missouri (5-0), Missouri State (2-3) and Saint Louis (8-3) last week. Senior **Carmon Fowler** hit .300 for the Redhawks over the three games with a pair of RBI and one double. Southeast Missouri will host Southern Illinois on Wednesday before traveling to SIU Edwardsville to open up conference play.

**SIU EDWARDSVILLE (6-11 overall, 0-0 OVC):** SIU Edwardsville defeated Missouri State before falling to No. 24 Kentucky (2-0) and Wright State (5-2). The Cougars have now played four nationally-ranked teams this season. Freshman **Rachel Coonrod** collected a pair of hits in the win over Missouri State and continues to lead the Cougars with a .304 batting average this season. **Taylor Tooley** and **Briana Fulginiti** hit their first home runs of the season in the second inning against Missouri State. Senior right hander **Erika Taylor** tossed a two-hitter in the victory and held No. 24 Kentucky to just two runs on five hits. SIU Edwardsville will travel to Western Kentucky for two on Tuesday and Belmont for a pair on Wednesday. SIUE will see its first official OVC action this weekend as the Cougars host Southeast Missouri this weekend.

**TENNESSEE STATE (6-15 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee State dropped games to Elon (7-4, 6-2), Stetson (1-0, 3-0) and Binghamton (4-2) in the Stetson Tournament. Senior **Caitlin Eaton** hit a double versus Elon and recorded her third home run of the season versus Binghamton. She posted a hit in four of the five games last week. Eaton also scored three times. Tennessee State will travel to Tennessee Tech this weekend to open up conference play.

**TENNESSEE TECH (7-7 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech picked up wins over Middle Tennessee (6-0) and NC State (3-1) last week. Sophomore **Melody Christian** tallied five hits in seven at-bats over the two games. She drove in three runs on three hits and stole a pair of bases in the win over MTSU. She followed that up with a pair of hits against NC State. Junior **Holly Thomas** pitched her third shutout and fifth complete game of the season against the Blue Raiders. She struck out seven batters and allowed just one walk versus MTSU. Tennessee Tech will host Chattanooga on Tuesday, Bowling Green and Appalachian State on Wednesday, Western Kentucky on Thursday before opening up OVC play at home this weekend against Tennessee State.

**UT MARTIN (10-8 overall, 0-0 OVC):** UT Martin went 3-2 in the Stephens Industries Florida Gulf Coast University Tournament last week. The Skyhawks defeated Colgate (2-1), FGCU (1-0) and St. Francis (5-2) before falling to Dartmouth (4-3) and St. John's (9-7). Senior **Jordan Garrett** led the team with a .421 batting average. She drove in four runs and also swiped a pair of bases. Senior **Kate Vanderham** was 1-1 in her two appearances in the tourney. She sported a 1.38 ERA and recorded seven strikeouts. The Skyhawks will open up league play this weekend as it hosts Murray State.
