Buch hit .429 as the Racers split a doubleheader with Western Kentucky and went 2-1 against Jacksonville State to grab the last spot in the OVC Softball Championship. Buch recorded two doubles, two home runs, four runs scored and six RBI last week. Her two-run homer on Saturday against Jacksonville State scored the finals runs in the Racers' win. She reached base four of five times in the 7-5 win in the finale with JSU. She finished the week with an on-base percentage of .526 and a slugging percentage of 1.000.

2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (12-40 overall, 7-23 OVC): Austin Peay went 1-2 against SIU Edwardsville to close out the 2011 season. The Lady Govs split the doubleheader on Saturday (2-6, 4-2) and fell in the finale, 4-3. Sophomore **Jessica Ryan** hit three home runs in the series, including tying a school single-game record with two in the second game. With its three home runs this weekend, Austin Peay finished the season with 30 which ties the school single-season record. Sophomore **Morgan Brewer** made three starts over the weekend to give her 43 appearances on the season which is the second most in program history.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (39-10 overall, 26-4 OVC): Eastern Illinois won the 2011 OVC regular-season crown outright as the Panthers swept Morehead State last week (2-1 (11), 7-1, 3-1). It marks the first regular-season title for EIU. The 39-10 overall mark is the best record in program history while 39 wins are the most since 1997 when EIU joined the OVC. The 26-4 league mark is also the best conference record in EIU history. Sophomore **Melise Brown** led the team with a .625 batting average and a 1.125 slugging percentage last week. She hit the game-winning two-RBI triple in the series finale with Morehead State. Senior **Amber May** picked up a pair of wins in the circle. She struck out 17 batters while walking just three in 17.2 innings of work. May gave up just two runs to post a 0.79 ERA. Eastern Illinois earned the top seed and the right to host the OVC Softball Championship. The Panthers will face the winner of SIU Edwardsville/Southeast Missouri game on Thursday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (24-27 overall, 11-18 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 2-1 against Southeast Missouri to end its 2011 season. The Colonels split the doubleheader (1-5, 8-0 (5)) on Saturday and won the finale, 9-2, in 12 innings on Sunday. Sophomore **Kristin Perry** picked up a pair of wins, including a complete-game shutout in the second game against the Redhawks. She didn't give up a run in 12.3 innings of work. Sophomore **Raquel Howes** came to bat twice in the seven-run 12th inning against the Redhawks. In her first at-bat, she hit a two-run home run and drew a bases loaded walk in her second trip to the plate. Her home run broke the ECU single-season record of 12 set in 1998 by Kelly Swanson. Howes finished 2011 with 48 RBI, missing the school mark of 50 by two. Five Colonels finished the season with a .300 or better batting average to help ECU lead the OVC. Senior **Shyenne Hussey** hit .412 in her final season to lead the team while Howes and **Ashley Dollins** (41) each drove in 40-plus runs. **Diane Gallagher** swiped 29 bases in 2001.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (36-18 overall, 21-9 OVC): Jacksonville State fell to UAB, 1-0, in nine innings before going 1-2 against Murray State (4-3, 3-6, 5-7) to close out the regular-season. **Hayden Crawford** led the team with a .500 batting average over the four games. She recorded five hits, two RBI and one home run. **Kristin Graham** made three appearances in the circle last week, posting a 0.49 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 14.1 innings of work. Jacksonville State earned the No. 2 seed in the upcoming conference tournament and will play the winner of the UT Martin/Murray State game on Thursday.

MOREHEAD STATE (19-36 overall, 10-19 OVC): Morehead State lost all three games at Eastern Illinois (1-2 (11), 1-7, 1-3) last week to conclude the 2011 season. Senior **Rebecca Butler** hit safely in all three games and finished her four-year career with the nation's longest hitting streak at 29 games. She also concluded her time at Morehead State with eight career batting records and several season and single game marks. She finished as the OVC leader in batting average in conference games at .475. Butler also tied the school single-season mark by hitting her 10th home run on Saturday. Two other batters, **Sam Woodall** and **Kayla Brill**, finished with batting averages better than .300.

MURRAY STATE (23-26 overall, 13-15 OVC): Murray State split a doubleheader with Western Kentucky (7-0, 2-8) before taking two-of-three from Jacksonville State (3-4, 6-3, 7-5) to grab the last spot in the OVC Softball Championship. The Racers posted a must-win in the finale with Jacksonville State on **Leslie Bridges'** two-run pinch-hit home run in the top of the seventh, the first of her career. Senior **Lauren Buch** batted .429 over the five games while also hitting a pair of home runs. She drove in six and scored four times last week. Junior **Chelsey Sullivan** posted a 1.97 ERA in three appearances. Murray State will be making their second straight trip to the OVC tournament. The Racers earned the sixth seed and will face No. 3 UT Martin on Thursday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (27-28 overall, 17-12 OVC): Southeast Missouri split a doubleheader with Saint Louis (5-1, 1-3) and went 1-2 against Eastern Kentucky (5-1, 0-8, 2-9 (12)) to close out the regular-season. Freshman **Alora Marble** was the winning pitcher in both games. She made three starts, going the distance in two. She held the opposing batters to a .184 batting average. She struck out 19 batters while walking just four in 25.0 innings of work. Southeast Missouri earned the No. 5 seed in the OVC Tournament and will face No. 4 SIU Edwardsville on Thursday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (28-28 overall, 19-11 OVC): SIU Edwardsville took two-of-three from Austin Peay (6-2, 2-4, 4-3) last week to conclude the regular-season. Senior **Kasey Schlafke** recorded the game-winning RBI with a home run in the series opener against Austin Peay. She is now tied for the team lead with seven home runs. Senior **Erika Taylor** became the school's all-time leader in strikeouts with 723 after a pair of double-digit strikeout efforts last week. She also picked up a pair of wins to give her 21 for the season. Taylor posted a 2.00 ERA with 22 strikeouts in 14.0 innings of work. SIU Edwardsville earned a spot in the OVC Softball Championship in its first year of eligibility. The Cougars are the fourth seed and will face No. 5 Southeast Missouri on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-43 overall, 5-24 OVC): Tennessee State dropped a pair of games to Murray State (0-16, 0-19) May 1 to close out the 2011 season. **Brittany Webb** recorded two of the team's five hits in the two games. **Tedra Alford** finished the season as the team leader in hits with 46 and home runs with four. The Tigers concluded the year with a 11-43 overall while going 5-24 in the OVC.

TENNESSEE TECH (22-26 overall, 13-16 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 1-2 at UT Martin to conclude the 2011 campaign. The Golden Eagles split the doubleheader (5-4, 2-3) on Saturday and fell, 1-0, in the finale on Sunday. **Whitney Cummings** drove in four of Tennessee Tech's seven runs in the series. Cummings also hit a pair of homers during the three games. Tennessee Tech finished the season with a 22-26 overall mark while going 13-16 in the OVC.

UT MARTIN (32-22 overall, 19-10 OVC): UT Martin went 2-1 against Tennessee Tech (4-5, 3-2, 1-0) last week to close out the regular season. UT Martin and Tennessee Tech have played 15 one-run games since 2002 with the Skyhawks leading 9-6 in those contests. Sophomore **Leah Taylor** had two stolen bases to give her 31 on the season which ties her for fourth place in UT Martin history. Freshman **Amanda Brandenburg** hit her team best 14th double of the year and is now tied for the most doubles in a single-season. Brandenburg also went 2-1 in the circle last week. She tossed a complete game shutout in the 1-0 win over Tennessee Tech. The 32 wins this year gives head coach Donley Canary his seventh 30-plus win season in the past 10 years. The Skyhawks earned the third seed in the OVC Softball Championship and will face No. 6 Murray State on Thursday.
