Hanley opened the season with a career-high 28 points against Southern Illinois. She followed that up with 21 points at Lipscomb. She became the 14th player in APSU history to reach the 1,000 career point plateau in the game with the Lady Bisons. Hanley scored seven points in the final three minutes against SIU to secure the win after the Salukis tied the game. She scored five points in the final two minutes at Lipscomb, tying the game with a traditional three-point play and adding a pair of game-sealing free throws. She made 10-of-18 field goals (.556) against Southern Illinois and added seven rebounds and five assists. She was 6-of-17 from the field at Lipscomb, making a trio of three-point field goals and finishing with seven rebounds and two steals.

Burgess recorded 19.0 points per game last week as she saw her first action in a Racer uniform after sitting out last year due to transfer rules. She tallied 20 points versus Indiana and had 18 against Evansville. She finished the week shooting 16-for-31 from the field to go with 15 assists and eight steals.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2011-12 campaign kicks off with Morehead State hosting Kentucky Christian in an exhibition game on Nov. 3. The regular-season begins on Nov. 11 with Conference play starting on Dec. 28. Nine different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 16.

Fourth to First: The past two seasons the team that has been selected to finish fourth in the Predicted Order of Finish has gone on to claim the regular-season crown. Eastern Illinois was selected fourth in the 2009-10 poll and went on to earn its first regular-season title while Tennessee Tech was predicted to finish fourth last year and won its 16th regular-season title.

16-game Conference Schedule: This season the 11 OVC women's basketball teams will play a 16-game Conference schedule which is a change from the 18 league games they played last year. This marks the first time the league has played 16 Conference games since 2004-05. The OVC played a 20-game conference schedule in 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08 and an 18-game schedule in 2008-09 and 2009-10.

OVC Women's Basketball: Taking Charge of Monday Night: This season OVC women's basketball will be featured on Monday nights. The league approved to move away from the men's/women's Thursday night doubleheaders and move the women's games to Monday night. During the season, the OVC website will feature coach and student-athlete interviews on a weekly basis. There will also be a trivia contest with a chance to win a t-shirt and all-session tickets to the 2012 OVC Women's Basketball Championship in Nashville, Tenn.

SIUE Plays Regular-Season Conference Schedule: SIUE will be playing a regular-season Conference schedule for the first time since joining the league in 2008. The Cougars are finishing up their reclassification from Division II. They will be able to win the OVC regular-season championship this season and will be eligible for postseason play next year. The Cougars will be included in all OVC Tournament tiebreaker scenarios (i.e. others teams records against them during the season). When it comes to seeding, SIUE will be skipped over in the final process (they will not receive a seed).

Belmont Joins the League in 2012-13: Belmont will officially become a member of the OVC on July 1, 2012 and its athletic teams will begin competing in the Conference in the 2012-13 season. Belmont competes in 17 sports (8 men's sports and 9 women's sports), 16 of which will compete in the OVC (the exception being men's soccer which is not sponsored by the OVC). The Bruins have competed in the Atlantic Sun Conference since 2001-02 and will compete in its final year in that league in 2011-12 before joining the OVC. Since 2001-02 Belmont has won 30 Atlantic Sun Championships, the second most in the conference. Bruins athletic teams have made recent NCAA Tournament appearances in men's and women's basketball, women's soccer, men's tennis and volleyball.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

2010-11 In Review: Eastern Illinois was selected to win the 2010-11 title but it was Tennessee Tech who won its 16th regular-season crown which is the most in Conference history. The Golden Eagles compiled a 23-8 overall mark and went 15-3 to capture the title and the top seed in the tournament. With the new tournament format, Tech received a double-bye into the semifinals where it defeated No. 5 Austin Peay, 65-56, to move into the championship game. Second-seeded UT Martin edged out the Golden Eagles, 82-76, to claim its first tourney title. Tennessee Tech's Sytia Messer earned OVC Coach of the Year honors after guiding her team to its 16th regular-season title. Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman repeated as OVC Player of the Year after leading the league with 21.4 points per game. Tennessee Tech's Tacarra Hayes and UT Martin's Jasmine Newsome shared the OVC Defensive Player of the Year honor while the Skyhawks' Heather Butler was named the Freshman of the Year. It marked the second year in a row the OVC had three women's basketball teams in the postseason. UT Martin earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Tennessee Tech earned the Conference's WNIT bid. Eastern Illinois was selected to play in the Women's Basketball Invitational.

Tennessee Tech in the Preseason WNIT: Tennessee Tech will participate in the Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Golden Eagles will travel to East Tennessee State on Nov. 11 for first round action. The Preseason WNIT features a three-game guarantee format. The event opens Nov. 11 with first-round games. Second-round games will be played Nov. 13-14, the semifinals will be Nov. 16-17 and the championship is set for Nov. 20. Teams that lose in the first two rounds will play consolation games on the second weekend, Nov. 18-19. All games are hosted by participating schools. Six different OVC teams have participated in the Preseason WNIT since its inception in 1994. Tech played in the tourney in 1997 where it fell to Clemson, 61-46, in the first round.

During the regular season there will be two teleconferences featuring the league's 10 head coaches. The teleconferences will take place on Jan. 11 and Feb. 8 at 10:00 a.m. CT. OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2-5 at Municipal Auditorium. After first round games were previously played on campus sites, now all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field gather at a single site for the entire tournament.

In 2011 the bracket shifted from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. The first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

This marks the 18th time in 19 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and seventh time the event has been held at Municipal Auditorium.

Team Notes

Austin Peay defeated Southern Illinois (76-70) and Lipscomb (61-58) to open up the season. It marked the first time since 2007-08 that the Lady Govs won consecutive non-conference games. Austin Peay opened up the season with back-to-back wins for the first time since 1997-98. Senior **Whitney Hanley** scored a career-high 28 points in the win over Southern Illinois and followed that up with 21 points at Lipscomb. She scored her 1,000th career point versus the Lady Bisons to become the 14th players in APSU history to reach that milestone. Junior **Leslie Martinez** opened her APSU career with a 10-point, seven-point effort versus SIU. She had seven points and three rebounds at Lipscomb. Freshman **Shelby Olszewski** came off the bench against the Lady Bisons to score 10 points and grab three rebounds. She also had three steals and one assist in the game. Sophomore **Nicole Olszewski** had back-to-back 10-point plus efforts, averaging 11.5 points and grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Southern Illinois. Senior **Jasmine Rayner** opened the season with 13 points and nine boards versus SIU. Austin Peay gets an eight-day break before traveling to nationally ranked Louisville on Nov. 22.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois opened up the 2011-12 season with a 93-32 win over Oakland City last week. The Panthers improved to 11-19 in season openers. EIU is now 6-2 in home openers under **Brady Sallee**. The 61-point victory was the largest margin of victory for an EIU women's basketball team since a 110-28 win over Brescia on Nov. 29, 2009. Senior **Chantelle Pressley** tallied her second career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds while freshman **Sabina Oroszova** posted her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 boards. It marked the first time since 2007 that two Panthers had recorded a double-double in the same game. All 12 players that saw action against Oakland City grabbed a rebound while nine players scored at least four points. Five different players scored in double figures, paced by **Jordyne Crunk** and **Kelsey Wyss** who both netted 15 points. Junior **Ta'Kenya Nixon** scored 12 points to mark the 49th time in her career she has reached double-digits in points. Eastern Illinois will travel to Bradley on Tuesday and host Illinois State on Monday.
