2011 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (9-30 overall, 4-13 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a pair to No. 18 Kentucky (0-16 (6), 0-13 (5)), fell to Tennessee State (1-10 (5)) and went 1-2 against Murray State (6-5, 12-2 (5), 14-3 (5)) last week. Senior **Randal Davenport** was hit by a pitch for the 15th time in her career in the second game against the Racers which set a new school record. After giving up double-figures in three of its first 33 games this season, Austin Peay has given up 10 runs in five of its last six games. Sophomore **Jessica Ryan** hit a home run in the first game against Murray State giving the Lady Gobs 20 for the season which matches last year's total. Austin Peay will host UT Martin on Tuesday before traveling to Jacksonville State this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (27-7 overall, 14-1 OVC): Eastern Illinois fell to Southern Illinois (0-2) before defeating SIU Edwardsville (1-0) and Eastern Kentucky (17-2 (5), 3-2, 7-1) last week. The Panthers hit four home runs last week to set a new single-season school mark for the second straight year. Junior **Hailee Hanna** had one of the team's four homers last week. She recorded a .545 batting average to go with a 1.439 slugging percentage. Over the five games, Hanna drove in five runs and scored once. Senior **Amber May** went 4-0 in the circle last week. She posted a 0.58 ERA as she allowed just two earned runs in 24.1 innings of work. She fanned 31 batters and held opponents to a .187 batting average. Eastern Illinois will host Southeast Missouri for a pair on Wednesday and UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (21-17 overall, 8-11 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to Morehead State (6-12) before dropping three to Eastern Illinois (2-17, 2-3, 1-7) last week. **Larkyn Wood** led the Colonels with a .417 batting average with two runs, four RBI and two stolen bases in the four games. Eastern Kentucky will be looking to snap its four-game losing streak at it hosts Tennessee Tech on Wednesday and welcomes SIU Edwardsville for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (27-10 overall, 12-3 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated UTEP (3-1) and Tennessee Tech (13-2 (5)) last week. Freshman **Hayden Crawford** paced the Gamecocks with a .600 batting average. She went 2-for-2 against UTEP with an RBI and a run scored. In the win over Tech, Crawford was 1-for-3 with a walk and a pair of RBI. Freshman **Tiffany Harbin** pitched all 12 innings for the Gamecocks. She tossed a complete-game win over UTEP which she retired the first 18 batters she faced to take a perfect game into the seventh inning. The Miners broke up the perfect game with a pair of bunts. Harbin struck out 18 batters over the two wins and held opponents to a .159 batting average. Jacksonville State will host Tennessee State on Tuesday, UAB on Thursday and Austin Peay this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (12-27 overall, 6-12 OVC): Morehead State defeated Eastern Kentucky (12-6) to take the season series before dropping three to UT Martin (0-1, 3-6, 2-6). Senior **Rebecca Butler** hit .500 last week with six hits. With 196 hits, she is now just two shy of setting the school career hit record. The Eagles have also set the team single-season home run record with 32 this year, bettering the old mark of 30 set last season. Junior **Ashley Boyd** made two appearances in the circle and didn't allow a run in seven innings while striking out six. The Eagle offense had five hitters above .300 and hit .300 as a team. Morehead State travels to Dayton on Wednesday, hosts Toledo on Thursday and entertains Tennessee State this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (13-20 overall, 6-10 OVC): Murray State swept a doubleheader with Belmont (3-2, 5-0) before going 2-1 at Austin Peay (5-6, 12,2, 14-3). Senior **Jenna Bradley** hit a pair of home runs last week, including the Racers second grand slam of the year in the series finale with Austin Peay on Sunday as Murray State scored 11 runs in the second inning. Bradley hit .375 over the five games with two home runs, six runs scored and nine RBI. As a team the Racers hit .323 for the week, with six players hitting .364 or higher. Junior **Chelsey Sullivan** picked up a pair of wins, including the shutout against Belmont, in three appearances in the circle. It marked the second time this season Sullivan had blanked Belmont. She struck out 12 batters in 14.2 innings of action. Murray State will host SIU Edwardsville on Tuesday and Memphis on Friday before traveling to Southeast Missouri this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (17-21 overall, 11-7 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 5-1 last week, including 3-1 in OVC play. The Redhawks picked up wins over Indiana State (10-8, 4-2) and Tennessee State (6-5, 5-3, 10-0) and fell at UT Martin (2-7). The program captured its 900th win with the 10-8 victory over Indiana State. Southeast Missouri recorded its first OVC series sweep since the 2009 season as the Redhawks took all three games from Tennessee State. As a team, the Redhawks batted .374 for the week. Junior **Renee Kertz** posted a .588 batting average, a .706 slugging percentage and a .667 on-base percentage. She drove in eight runs and scored three times over the six games. **Katilin Wallace** hit .526 with two doubles and five RBI while **Taylor Cowan** extended her hitting streak to 10 games and batted .389 with a home run and seven RBI. **Stefani Barnes** went 2-0 in the circle with a shutout over Tennessee State. Freshman **Alora Marble** tied the school record with her third save of the season. In 11.2 innings of work, she struck out 10 and went 1-0. Southeast Missouri will travel to Eastern Illinois on Wednesday before hosting Murray State this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (18-21 overall, 10-7 OVC): SIU Edwardsville fell to Eastern Illinois (0-1) before sweeping Tennessee Tech (2-0, 4-3, 6-5 (8)). Junior **Whitney Davis** recorded two walk-off game-winning RBI last weekend against Tennessee Tech. She hit .400 for the week with a team-high three RBI. Sophomore **Lindsey Coleman** posted two victories out of the bullpen for the Cougars. She didn't allow a run in 5.1 innings of work. **Erika Taylor** recorded her fourth 10-plus strikeout game of the season in the 2-0 victory over Tech. She needs 28 strikeouts to pass Sandy Montgomery (current head coach) on the all-time strikeouts list at SIUE. **Laurie Seibert** returned from a hand injury for two pinch hitting appearances. **Taylor Tooley** continues to lead the team with a .351 batting average. She was 5-of-11 last week. The Cougars will hit the road for next seven games beginning with Murray State on Tuesday and Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-33 overall, 4-16 OVC): Tennessee State defeated Austin Peay (10-1) before dropping three to Southeast Missouri (5-6, 3-5, 0-10) Freshman **Jasmine Brimm** went 2-for-3 with two steals and a walk in the opening game against Southeast Missouri. She recorded three RBI in the second game with the Redhawks. For the week, she hit .500 with one double, three RBI and four runs scored. She also stole four bases in four attempts. Tennessee State will travel to Jacksonville State on Tuesday, Memphis on Wednesday and Morehead State this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (15-18 overall, 6-11 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 0-4 last week, falling to Jacksonville State (2-13 (5)) and SIU Edwardsville (0-2, 3-4, 5-6). Sophomore **Chanelle Spalding** led the team with a .667 batting average to go with a home run, a double and two RBI. Senior **Callie Schmidt** drove in a team-best three RBI over the four games while also hitting one home run. The Golden Eagles will look to get back on the winning track as they travel to Eastern Kentucky on Wednesday and Kentucky on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (24-14 overall, 13-3 OVC): UT Martin defeated Southeast Missouri, 7-2, and swept a three-game series with Morehead State (1-0, 6-3, 6-2) last week to improve to 8-1 at home this season. Freshman **Amanda Brandenburg** hit .500 with six hits, including five for extra bases. She recorded three doubles and two home runs while driving in seven and scoring four times. Junior **Chelsea Jones** picked up wins in all three of her appearances in the circle last week. She earned the shutout in the 1-0 victory over Morehead State. Jones worked 21.0 innings and struck out 20 batters while walking just three. Jones now has 140 strikeouts this season and needs just 14 to move to third on the school's single-season list. UT Martin will host Austin Peay on Tuesday and Southern Illinois on Thursday before traveling to Eastern Illinois this weekend.
