Long hit three home runs over two games for the Skyhawks in wins over No. 24 Southern Illinois and SIU Edwardsville. In the SIU game, Long connected on a first-inning grand slam that eventually turned into the winning runs. She also added a third-inning solo-homer to marked the first two home runs of the season for her and her first career multi-homer game. Against SIUE, Long hit another home run. She finished the week with a .500 batting average with three runs scored and six RBI.

2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (12-32 overall, 2-14 OVC): Austin Peay swept a twinbill with Alabama A&M (6-1, 12-0 (5)) before dropping three games to Southeast Missouri (1-4, 5-6 (9), 5-7 (5)). Junior **Ashley Taylor** became the 25th player in APSU history to record at least 100 career hits with her first hit against Alabama A&M. Junior **Brittany Williams** went over the 100 assist mark for the second straight year this past week making her only the third Lady Gov to do that in back-to-back seasons and the first since 1990. Junior **Daniella Hooper** recorded her first career triple in the game against Alabama A&M. Hooper finished the week with a .444 batting average to go along with two doubles and one home run. Austin Peay will host UT Martin for a single game on Thursday before traveling to Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (24-19 overall, 8-5 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped a pair to Saint Louis (10-11 (8), 2-19 (5)) before losing three to Morehead State (2-3, 2-6, 2-4). The Panthers set a new single-season home run record last week with 26 homers so far this year. Eastern Illinois will host Illinois on Tuesday, Southeast Missouri for a doubleheader on Thursday and Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (16-19 overall, 7-8 OVC): Eastern Kentucky won both ends of a doubleheader with Tennessee State (7-2, 4-3). The Colonels had three games cancelled due to weather last week. EKU trailed the Tigers 2-1 in the final inning of the first game before rallying with six runs in the seventh. Eastern Kentucky trailed 3-1 in the fifth inning of the second contest before scoring twice to tie and then won in 11 innings. Senior pitcher **Kalyn Fox** earned the win in both games. She tossed five and two-thirds innings of scoreless relief in the first game while giving up two hits, walking three and striking out four. In the second game, Fox came on in relief and shutout TSU over the final six and one-third innings. She walked one batter and struck out three while allowing only three hits. In the two games combined, sophomore **Cassi Gibson** went 4-for-7 (.571) with three runs scored, one RBI and one stolen base. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Kentucky for a single game on Wednesday and head to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (30-9 overall, 14-1 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated SEC foe Ole Miss, 5-1, before sweeping Tennessee Tech in a three-game series (8-0 (6), 8-0 (5), 4-0). The Gamecocks became the first team to hold Tech scoreless in a three-game OVC series while also holding its opponent scoreless in a three-game set for the first time in JSU history. Junior **Hillary Downs** had four extra base hits on the week, including a two-home run game versus Tennessee Tech on Saturday that tied the JSU school record for homers in a game. She also recorded two doubles on the weekend. Senior pitcher **Karla Pittman** extended her streak of innings without allowing an earned run to 26.2 last week. Pittman picked up three wins while striking out 17 batters in 20.0 innings of work. Jacksonville State will travel to Kennesaw State on Tuesday, host Ole Miss on Thursday and head to Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (29-14 overall, 11-7 OVC): Morehead State went 5-0 last week, running its current winning streak to 10 games. The Eagles defeated SIU Edwardsville (4-1), IUPUI (4-3) and swept their second straight OVC series with 3-2, 6-2, and 4-2 wins at Eastern Illinois. Junior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** improved to 21-7 overall and lowered her OVC-best ERA to 0.91 by going 4-0 last week. She became the first pitcher in school history to record a victory in all three games in a single OVC series. Gjevre has now won her last seven starts and allowed just four earned runs in the span of 47.1 innings. Senior **Bri Jones** played in her 197th career game on Sunday and needs just four more to break the school record. She also has already set the MSU career mark for at-bats with 625 and walks with 63. Sophomore **Rebecca Butler** had three multi-hit games last week and led the Eagles with a .467 batting average. She hit her team-high sixth homer of the year against SIUE. Junior **Bianca Cardenas** is riding a six-game hitting streak after hitting safely in all five games last week. Her bases-loaded triple in the second against SIUE broke a 2-2 tie and allowed MSU to win 6-2. Morehead State hosts Ball State in a doubleheader Tuesday and travels to Marshall for a pair in Thursday. The Eagles also host Austin Peay for a three-game series this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (18-19 overall, 7-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 5-0 last week to extend its winning streak to six games. The Redhawks took two from Saint Louis (5-4, 9-5) and swept a three-game series with Austin Peay (4-1, 6-5 (9), 7-5). Sophomore **Carmen Fowler** hit .500 over the five games with four runs scored and four RBI. Freshman pitcher **Giana Zimmerman** held opponents to a .164 batting average while striking out 24 batters in 20.0 innings of work. **Alex Ramierz** hit .412 and extended her hitting streak to six games. **Whitney Dupuis** went 2-0 with a 0.68 ERA in two relief appearances. Southeast Missouri will travel to Eastern Illinois for a doubleheader on Thursday and host Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series this weekend.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (34-9 overall): SIU Edwardsville defeated IUPUI (5-3) and fell to Morehead State (1-4) before splitting a doubleheader with UT Martin (2-5, 3-0). Senior pitcher **Kaitlin Calosimo** recorded her eighth shutout of the season in the win over UT Martin. She did not allow a hit until the sixth inning and struck out four. SIUE will host Western Illinois for a pair on Tuesday and entertain Bradley for a single game on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (17-26 overall, 7-12 OVC): Tennessee State split a doubleheader with Lipscomb (6-5, 1-9) before dropping two to Western Kentucky (2-3, 0-9) and two to Eastern Kentucky (2-7, 3-4). Senior **Melanie Cruz** hit .333 with two home runs and three RBI. The Tigers will host Middle Tennessee for a twinbill on Wednesday and Tennessee Tech for a single game on Thursday.

TENNESSEE TECH (23-26 overall, 9-9 OVC): Tennessee Tech swept a doubleheader with Belmont (6-3, 4-3) before dropping three games to Jacksonville State (8-0, 8-0, 4-0). It marked the first time that an OVC opponent held the Golden Eagles scoreless in a three-game series. Tennessee Tech will travel to Tennessee State for a single game on Thursday and UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend.

UT MARTIN (26-19 overall, 8-8 OVC): UT Martin defeated No. 24 Southern Illinois, 10-4, before splitting a doubleheader with SIU Edwardsville (5-2, 0-3). The win over SIU marked the first time the Skyhawks have defeated a ranked opponent. Senior **Greer Long** hit three home runs last week including a grand slam and a solo shot in the Southern Illinois game. Senior pitcher **Kara Harper** went 2-0 last week, striking out five batters in 13.0 innings of work. UT Martin will travel to Belmont for a pair on Tuesday and Austin Peay for a single game on Thursday before returning home to host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.
