Alex Ramirez, C, Jr., Corona, Calif. - Southeast Missouri

Ramirez hit .500 with a 1.083 slugging percentage to go along with a .700 on-base percentage as Southeast Missouri extended its winning streak to 11 games. She totaled 13 bases and walked eight times last week. She recorded 31 putouts and three assists playing every inning at catcher. In the second game with EIU, Ramirez went 1-for-2 with two walks, two runs scored and a three-run home run. In the opener against Eastern Kentucky, she came a triple short of the cycle as she went 3-for-4 with a single, double and home run. Ramirez finished the week with seven RBI and six runs scored.

Zimmerman held opponents to a .123 batting average as she went 3-0 with 23 strikeouts in 21.0 innings of work last week. She has now won sevens straight starts. In all three of her appearances last week, she tossed complete games and allowed just three extra base hits. In the series opener with Eastern Kentucky, Zimmerman allowed just three runs on seven hits while tying her school record with 13 strikeouts. In the series final with the Colonels, struck out seven batters and notched her 17th complete game in 21 starts this season.

2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (12-36 overall, 2-18 OVC): Austin Peay fell to UT Martin, 4-3, in nine innings before being swept in a three-game series with Morehead State (6-5, 3-2(9), 2-0). Junior **Brittany Williams** led the team with a .364 batting average, a .727 slugging percentage and a .522 on-base percentage. She also picked up four more walks last week to tie the school's single-season mark. In its last six games, Austin Peay has had three of those contests go nine innings. The Lady Govs only had one extra-inning contest among its firsts 42 of the season. With their three triples last week, the Lady Govs now have five on the season, marking the most since the 2005 season. Austin Peay will close out the season with a doubleheader at Evansville on Tuesday and a entertaining Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (24-24 overall, 8-11 OVC): Eastern Illinois lost both ends of a doubleheader with Southeast Missouri (6-2, 11-3 (6)) before dropping a trio of games to Jacksonville State (5-1, 2-0, 2-0). The Panthers have now lost 10 straight games. Eastern Illinois will travel to Southeast Missouri for a single game on Wednesday and will head to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (16-23 overall, 7-11 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell Kentucky, 7-0, before being swept in three-game series with Southeast Missouri (4-3, 8-5, 4-3). Freshman **Diane Gallagher** had three hits and three stolen bases while senior **Kalyn Fox** went 2-for-4 with a run scored in the first game against the Redhawks. In the second contest, the Colonels jumped out to a 2-0 lead and led 3-1 heading into the bottom of the second. Southeast Missouri took the lead with three runs in the bottom of the inning. Eastern Kentucky tied the score at 4-4 with a run in the fourth, but the Redhawks scored once in the bottom half of the inning to take the lead for good. In the series finale, EKU jumped out to a 3-0 lead but the Southeast Missouri scored in each of the last three innings to complete from behind the win. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Miami (Ohio) for two on Tuesday and to Louisville for a single game on Wednesday before returning home to host UT Martin in a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (35-9 overall, 17-1 OVC): Jacksonville State went 5-0 last week with wins over Kennesaw State (4-2), Ole Miss (4-3) and Eastern Illinois (5-1, 2-0, 2-0) to clinch its second straight OVC regular-season title. The Gamecocks have now won their last 18 games which breaks the school record of 17 set by the 2005 team. Junior **Hillary Downs** hit a pair of home runs in the contest with Ole Miss, including a walkoff in the bottom of the seventh. She finished the week with a .429 batting average to go along with three stolen bases. Sophomore **Ashley Eliasson** made two starts and tossed complete-game shutouts in each. She struck out 10 batters in 15.0 innings of work. Jacksonville State will travel to Middle Tennessee for a pair on Tuesday before returning home to host Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (33-16 overall, 14-7 OVC): Morehead State went 4-2 last week, defeating Ball State (7-5) and taking three from Austin Peay (6-5, 3-2 (9), 2-0). The Eagles also dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Marshall (0-2, 0-5). With the sweep of Austin Peay, Morehead state ran its OVC winning streak to 11 games. The Eagles have now swept three consecutive league series and have won 19 of their last 23 games overall. MSU's 33 wins are just one shy of tying the single-season mark for wins set by the 2008 team. Junior **Courtney Seiler** led the team with a .417 batting average last week before an injury forced her to miss the final game of the APSU series. Sophomore **Rebecca Butler** hit a walk-off home run to lead off the ninth inning of the second game of the series with the Lady Govs. Freshman Sam Woodall connected on her fifth homer of the year on Saturday. Junior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** picked up her conference-leading 23rd win in the circle Sunday, allowing only two hits to the Lady Govs. Morehead State travels to face Southern Illinois on Thursday and finishes the regular-season with a three-game series at Jacksonville State this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (23-19 overall, 12-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri took both end of a twinbill with Eastern Illinois (6-2, 11-3) and swept Eastern Kentucky in a three-game series (4-3, 8-5, 4-3) to extend its winning streak to a season-best 11 games. Its the longest winning streak since 1998 and is tied for the sixth longest in school history. Junior **Alex Ramirez** hit .500 with a 1.083 slugging percentage and a .700 on-base percentage. She drove in seven runs while scoring six. She came a triple short of hitting for the cycle in the opener against Eastern Kentucky. Freshman pitcher **Giana Zimmerman** went 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA. She struck out 23 batters in 21 innings of work. **Whitney Dupuis** batted .600 as she hit safely in all five games including recording her first career home run versus Eastern Kentucky. Dupuis also went 2-0 in the circle for her fifth straight win of the season. **Jennifer Vasquez** hit .467 and extended her hitting streak to nine games while collecting six RBI including recording her second career grand slam. Southeast Missouri will host Eastern Illinois for a single game on Wednesday before traveling to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (36-10 overall): SIU Edwardsville split a doubleheader with Western Illinois (0-4, 4-1) and defeated Bradley, 5-1, last week. Senior pitcher **Kaitlin Colosimo** picked up her 16th and 17th wins in the circle last week while striking out 12 batters. In the win over Western Illinois, junior **Lauren Zembruski** hit her seventh home run of the season. The Cougars will host Central Arkansas for a twibill on Tuesday and Saint Louis for a pair on Wednesday.

TENNESSEE STATE (18-28 overall, 8-12 OVC): Tennessee State dropped a pair to Middle Tennessee (0-12, 0-3) before picking up a 4-3 win over Tennessee Tech. Sophomore **Brittany Webb** drove in three runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to lift TSU past Tech. She finished the week with a .375 batting average. Sophomore pitcher **Caitlin Eaton** went 1-1 with 11 strikeouts in 14.0 innings of work last week. Tennessee State will close out the regular-season as it welcomes Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (24-29 overall, 10-12 OVC): Tennessee Tech fell to Tennessee State, 4-3, and went 1-2 at UT Martin (4-7, 1-0, 0-5) last week. Sophomore **Callie Schmidt** drove in the winning run in the top of the fourth inning in the victory over UT Martin. Freshman **Holly Thomas** earned the victory over the Skyhawks allowing just one hit. Tennessee Tech will travel to Vol State for a doubleheader on Tuesday and to Kennesaw State for a pair on Thursday.

UT MARTIN (31-20 overall, 11-9 OVC): UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Belmont (11-2, 7-5), defeated Austin Peay (4-3 (9)) and took two of three from Tennessee Tech (7-4, 0-1, 5-0) last week. Senior pitcher **Kara Harper** picked up four wins for the Skyhawks, all complete game showings, and moved only two wins away from matching the school's single-season wins mark. She struck out 16 batters and walked only four in 29.0 innings of action. UT Martin will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting this weekend.
