2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (5-16 overall, 0-2 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a pair to Mercer (6-0, 10-2) and lost both ends of a doubleheader with Jacksonville State (3-2, 8-1). Junior **Ashley Taylor** continues her hot hitting since returning to the lineup, going 4-for-11 (.364) for the week including hitting her first home run of the season. Sophomore **Ashley Alverson** also had her best hitting week of the season, going 3-for-10, with a home run and three RBI. The Lady Govs will host Middle Tennessee for a pair on Tuesday before traveling to Western Kentucky for two on Wednesday and will head Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (11-9 overall, 1-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois defeated Indiana State, 3-0, before going 1-2 against Tennessee State to open up Conference play. The Panthers took the series opener against the Tigers, 4-3, but dropped both ends of the doubleheader on Saturday (4-3, 11-6). Sophomore **Kiley Holtz** hit .462 over the four games with two home runs and five RBI. Sophomore pitcher **Amber May** recorded a 1.50 ERA with 24 strikeouts in 23.1 innings of work. Eastern Illinois will host Drake for a pair on Tuesday before traveling to IUPUI for a doubleheader on Wednesday. EIU will also host UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (8-10 overall, 0-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split its final four games at the Rebel Games, falling to Butler (7-8) and Robert Morris (1-0) before defeating Yale (6-5) and La Salle (8-3). The Lady Colonels also dropped a pair of games to Tennessee Tech (13-1, 4-3) to open up Conference play. Senior **Kalyn Fox** led the team with a .313 batting average last week while also being credited with each of EKU's wins in the circle. She finished the week with a 1.70 earned run averaged, giving up one walk and striking out six in 12.1 innings of work. Fox also scored a pair of runs and drove in three. Eastern Kentucky will host Morehead State for a twinbill on Tuesday and entertain SIU Edwardsville for a pair on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (15-7 overall, 2-0 OVC): Jacksonville State opened up league play with a pair of wins over Austin Peay last week. The Gamecocks defeated the Lady Govs, 3-2, in the first game and took the second contest, 8-1. Junior **Nikki Prier** hit .429 in the two games with three RBI and one home run. Senior pitcher **Karla Pittman** came in with the bases loaded and no outs in the third inning of the second game and struck out the side to start a five-inning relief effort that saw her allow just two hits and earn the win. Jacksonville State will host South Alabama on Thursday before traveling to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

MOREHEAD STATE (12-6 overall, 1-2 OVC): Morehead State had a busy week, playing six games and going 2-4. The Eagles fell twice to Kentucky (5-1, 4-3) and defeated Western Kentucky (4-0) at home before dropping two of three games at UT Martin (2-3 (8), 0-13 (5), 3-1 (10)). Junior pitcher Alex Gjevre struck out 33 batters in 29.0 innings of work last week and upped her season strikeout total to 97. That mark already ranks as the third highest in school history and is only 28 punch outs away from tying her own single-season record of 125. With 316 career Ks, she is also just 40 short of the MSU career mark of 356 set by former teammate Kari Quinn. Sophomore Rebecca Butler led the offense with a .389 batting average over the six-game span. Senior Bri Jones set Morehead State's career walk record with her 52nd against Kentucky. Freshman Kayla Brill and Sam Woodall each homered once last week with Brill's being her first collegiate round-tripper. Morehead State will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Tuesday and will travel to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Friday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (7-5 overall, 0-0 OVC): All of Southeast Missouri's games last week were cancelled due to inclement weather. The Redhawks will face Charlotte for a pair on Monday, North Carolina A&T for a doubleheader on Tuesday and Elon for a single game on Thursday. Southeast Missouri will also open up Conference play at Morehead State beginning on Friday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (21-5 overall): SIU Edwardsville went a perfect 8-0 at the Rebels Games in Florida last week. The Cougars picked up wins over Bryant (6-2), Penn (1-0), Youngstown State (6-0), Maine (3-2), Sacred Heart (9-2), Robert Morris (7-0), Wagner (8-7) and Florida A&M (8-0). SIUE has been receiving votes in two national polls (ESPN.com/USA Softball and UltimateCollegeSoftball. com) in just its first year of Division I. The Cougars will put its eight-game winning streak on the line as they host Drake for a pair on Wednesday and Wichita State for two on Thursday. SIUE will also travel to Eastern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-9 overall, 2-1 OVC): Tennessee State went 2-1 against Eastern Illinois (3-4, 4-3, 11-6) to kick off Conference play last week. Sophomore **Caitlin Eaton** recorded her sixth and seventh home runs of the year in the three-game series. She had hits in each game and tallied five RBI. Eaton recorded a solo homerun and a double in the second game of the series before notching a three-run shot in the 11-6 win over the Panthers. Tennessee State will host Auburn and Alabama State on Wednesday and will entertain Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

TENNESSEE TECH (10-14 overall, 2-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech opened up Conference play with a doubleheader sweep of Eastern Kentucky (13-1, 4-3) last week. Sophomore **Katie Betry** hit .714 in the twinbill with two runs scored and three RBI. Freshman pitcher **Holly Thomas** allowed just one run in the first game against Eastern Kentucky. She struck out five in the 5.0 innings of work. Tennessee Tech will host Bradley for a pair on Tuesday and welcome Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (17-7 overall, 2-1 OVC): UT Martin went 2-1 versus Morehead State (3-2 (8), 13-0 (5), 1-3 (10)) to open up Conference play. The Skyhawks are off to their best start in program history at 17-7. Chelsea Jones has eight home runs already this season which has her on track to hit 19 in the regular-season. Junior **Laura Roberts** went 4-for-9 at the plate during the three games. Three of her four hits were of the extra base variety with a pair of doubles and a home run. Senior pitcher **Kara Harper** tossed eight complete innings in the series opener, earning the extra inning win while giving up only two runs in the game with four strikeouts. She also went 2-for-5 at the plate over the weekend with a home run, four RBI, two runs scored and two walks. UT Martin will travel to Evansville for a doubleheader on Wednesday before heading to Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
