Allie Barker, C, Sr., Gadsden, Ala. - Jacksonville State

Barker led Jacksonville State in almost every offensive category last week, picking up five extra-bas hits. She opened the week with a one homer, two RBI effort against South Alabama. In Saturday's doubleheader at Tennessee State, she went a combined 5-for-8 with a homer, three doubles and four RBI. In the opener of the twinbill, she was 3-for-4 with two doubles and three RBI while going 2-for-4 with a home run, a double and an RBI in the nightcap. Barker also became the fourth player in school history to record 30 home runs and 100 RBI in her career. She finished the week with as .462 batting average, scoring six runs and driving in six.

She also beat Tennessee-Wesleyan and Austin Peay and picked up the save on Sunday against APSU. For the week she tossed 21 innings and struck out 31 while walking eight and allowing just two earned runs.

2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (6-22 overall, 0-5 OVC): Austin Peay split a doubleheader with Middle Tennessee (0-5, 7-4) before dropping two to Western Kentucky (0-8, 0-4) and three to Tennessee Tech (1-4, 2-3, 2-5). Senior **Lacey Briscoe** picked up her first win in almost a year in the victory over Middle Tennessee last week in a 1 2/3 innings relief role, after seeing last season come to an early end with a shoulder injury that led to surgery. Freshman pitcher **Ashley Bolda**, despite going 0-2, struck out 18 hitters in 16 1/3 innings of work last week for an average of 7.7 strikeouts per inning. Bolda did pick up her first collegiate save versus MTSU, becoming only the 12th Lady Govs pitcher to record a save in her career. After playing 22 of its first 28 games away from home, Austin Peay will begin a string of eight straight home games starting Saturday versus Tennessee State.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (17-10 overall, 4-2 OVC): After dropping the first game of a home doubleheader to Drake last week, Eastern Illinois rattled off six straight wins. The Panthers defeated Drake (5-4), IUPUI (9-0, 8-4) and UT Martin (2-1, 5-4, 2-1) last week. Four of the six wins came via one-run victories, including two extra-innings games. The three Panthers wins over the Skyhawks were the first home victories over UTM since **Kim Schuette** became skipper. Junior **Denee' Menzione** led the team with a .406 batting average. She scored seven runs while driving in eight. Menzione also hit a pair of home runs over the seven games. Sophomore pitcher **Amber May** went 4-1 with a 0.80 ERA last week. She tossed 35.0 innings and struck out 21 while allowing just four walks. Eastern Illinois will hit the road this week, facing Southern Illinois on Wednesday and Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (9-13 overall, 1-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a doubleheader with Morehead State (2-1 (8), 7-12) before dropping a pair to SIU Edwardsville (0-6, 1-4). The Colonels won the first game against Morehead State in extra innings on a freshman **Diana Gallagher's** walk-off solo home run. The Eagles jumped out to a 9-0 lead in the fourth inning of game two before EKU battled back and brought the go-ahead run to the plate. However, MSU held on for a 12-7 win in the second game. Eastern Kentucky will host Kent State for a pair on Wednesday before entertaining Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (17-9 overall, 4-1 OVC): Jacksonville State fell to South Alabama, 6-2, before taking two-of-three from Tennessee State (5-3, 7-0, 2-3). Senior **Allie Barker** led the Gamecocks with a .462 batting average while scoring six runs and driving in six. She recorded five extra-base hits, including a pair of home runs. Senior **Karla Pittman** extended her streak of consecutive innings without an earned run allowed to 21.4 after going 2-0 last week. She struck out 14 and gave up just four walks in 16.2 innings of action. Jacksonville State will travel to Chattanooga for a pair on Tuesday before heading to UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (14-9 overall, 3-5 OVC): Morehead State split a doubleheader with Eastern Kentucky (1-2 (8), 12-7) before going 1-2 against Southeast Missouri (0-1, 4-7, 2-1 (10)). After having just four total extra-innings games last year and going 0-4 in those contests, the Eagles have already been involved in seven extra-inning games this season and are 5-2. Junior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** broke her own school single-season record with her 126th strikeout Saturday in the Eagles' 2-1 10-inning win over Southeast Missouri. She now has 365 career Ks and needs only 12 more to break the MSU's career mark. Sophomore third baseman **Rebecca Butler** hit two home runs last week, giving her five for the year and 11 for her career. That mark now ranks tied for second in school history. Freshman **Sam Woodall** hit a two-out, two-run walkoff homerun to lift MSU to the win over the Redhawks on Saturday. Morehead State has been a quick-starting team this season, outscoring its opponents 17-4 in the first inning. The Eagles will be on a spring trip this week in Ohio. Morehead State plays a doubleheader at Akron on Tuesday, at Youngstown State on Wednesday, at Cleveland State on Thursday and at Toledo on Friday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (11-8 overall, 2-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri swept a doubleheader with North Carolina A&T (8-7, 6-0) and dropped a pair to Elon (2-4, 1-8) before going 2-1 against Morehead State (1-1, 7-4, 1-2 (10)). Sophomore **Nicole Troncoso** totaled 14 bases among her 11 hits for a .538 slugging percentage last week. She posted a .458 batting average with three runs scored, two RBI and one home run. Freshman pitcher **Giana Zimmerman** appeared in four games last week, allowing opponents to a .198 batting average and just five extra base hits. She went 2-1 with an 0.89 ERA last week, striking out 25 in 23.2 innings of action. Junior **Alex Ramirez** drove in five runs during the week, while freshman **Shelby Stein** batted .308 and scored five runs. Senior Lauren Bradley made her first appearance of the year and batted .300 with a double and a home run during the week. Southeast Missouri will host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (26-6 overall): SIU Edwardsville split a doubleheader with Drake (4-2, 1-2) before taking two from Wichita State (2-1 (9), 11-3 (5)) and Eastern Kentucky (6-0, 4-1). Senior **Kaitlin Colosimo** broke the school career record for strikeouts in the first game against Eastern Kentucky and currently has 661 strikeouts in her career. The previous record was held by current Cougar head coach **Sandy Montgomery**. SIUE will host UIC for a doubleheader on Tuesday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-13 overall, 3-3 OVC): Tennessee State fell to Auburn (0-10) and Alabama State (2-6) before going 1-2 against Jacksonville State (3-5, 0-7, 3-2). Sophomore **Caitlin Eaton** led the Tigers with five hits and a .750 slugging percentage. She tallied her seventh double and eighth home run of the year. Tennessee State will travel to Memphis for a doubleheader on Wednesday before heading to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (16-15 overall, 5-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech split a doubleheader with Bradley (8-0, 1-5) and defeated Tennessee-Wesleyan twice (2-0, 7-0) and Austin Peay three times (4-1, 3-2, 5-2). The Golden Eagles have now won their last six contests. Freshman **Holly Thomas** tossed her first career no-hitter on Thursday when she blanked Tennessee-Wesleyan, 2-0. She followed that up with a two-hitter against APSU on Saturday and finished the week with a 3-1 record and a 2.13 ERA. Sophomore **Maddie Schmissrauter** was 3-0 with one save and a 0.64 ERA for the week. Freshman **Whitney Cummings** hit .500 for the week with three runs scored and five RBI. She had three doubles and one home run over the seven games. Sophomore **Lacie Coquerille** had a solid week, batting .353 with five RBI and seven runs scored. The Golden Eagles will travel to Middle Tennessee on Tuesday and head to Southeast Missouri on for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (18-11 overall, 2-4 OVC): UT Martin split a doubleheader with Evansville (5-1, 0-1) before dropping three to Eastern Illinois (1-2 (8), 4-5, 1-2 (10)). UT Martin is now on a four-game losing streak after getting off to the best start in program history. The losing streak is the longest of the season for UT Martin and the first time they have lost back-to-back games this year. Freshman **Jenny Bain** scored five runs and tallied seven hits with two doubles to go along with one RBI last week. Senior pitcher **Kara Harper** tossed 23.2 innings last week appearing in and throwing three complete games. She recorded a 0.59 ERA and struck out 13 batters. UT Martin will travel to Belmont for a pair on Wednesday before returning home to host Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
