Chrissy O'Neal, OF, Jr., Dallas, Ga. - Jacksonville State

O'Neal hit three home runs over the Gamecocks four games last week. She hit safely, scored and drove in at least one run in all four games. O'Neal posted a .529 on-base percentage, which led to a team-high eight runs scored. She also carried a 1.429 slugging percentage after belting three homers to go along with a double and two triples. O'Neal went 2-for-3 in the finale at UT Martin with a homer, triple, three runs scored and a stolen base. She opened the week at Chattanooga by going 2-for-4 a double, homer, walk, two runs scored and two RBI.

Gjevre allowed only one earned run in 19 innings pitched and posted a 4:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio on Morehead State's spring trip to northern Ohio. She also set the MSU career strikeout record in a 2-1 victory at Cleveland State, striking out nine in the game and moving into the first slot on the list with her 357th career K. She fanned nine batters and didn't allow an earned run against Akron. Gjevre struck out six without giving up an earned run in her outing versus Toledo.

2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (7-24 overall, 1-7 OVC): Austin Peay dropped the opening game against Tennessee State, 10-1, in six innings on Saturday and came back on Sunday to earn a doubleheader split (2-1, 6-7). Sophomore **Randal Davenport** moved into the leadoff spot last weekend and responded by going 4-for-8, including hitting her first double of the season. Sophomore **Tiffany Smith** recorded the Lady Govs' first triple of the season in the first game versus TSU. Senior **Ashley Elrod** picked up APSU's first Conference win of the season. For the week, she struck out 11 batters in 10.0 innings of work. Austin Peay will host Belmont for a pair on Tuesday before entertaining Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (19-12 overall, 6-3 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped a 5-1 contest at Southern Illinois to open up the week but rebounded to take 2-of-3 from Eastern Kentucky (5-0, 13-7, 1-4). Freshman **Hayley Pieper** posted a .300 batting average with four runs scored and four RBI. She hit her first career grand slam against EKU. She also stole four bases over the four games. The Panthers will step out of Conference play on Thursday as they host Butler for a twinbill and travel to SIU Edwardsville for a pair on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (11-16 overall, 2-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 2-5 week, splitting a doubleheader with Kent Sate (4-2, 14-6) and taking one-of-two from Eastern Illinois (0-5, 7-13, 4-1). Freshman **Diane Gallagher** led team with a .438 batting average over the five games. She scored four runs while driving in four and stole three bases. Senior **Chelsea Butler** earned both wins for EKU. She posted a 1.68 earned run averaged with 11 strikeouts in 16.2 innings of work. Junior **Shyenne Hussey** hit a two-run home run in the win over Eastern Illinois. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Morehead State on Wednesday before heading to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (21-9 overall, 6-1 OVC): Jacksonville State swept a doubleheader with Chattanooga (11-9, 5-4) and took two from UT Martin (6-3, 7-1) last week. Junior **Chrissy O'Neal** hit .429 over the four games with eight runs scored and six RBI. She recorded three home runs, two triples and one double. O'Neal hit safely, scored and drove in a run in all four games. Sophomore pitcher **Ashley Eliason** earned three of the Gamecocks four wins last week. She carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning against UT Martin. She struck out 13 batters in 15.0 innings of work last week. Jacksonville State will host Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (17-12 overall, 3-5 OVC): Morehead State went 3-3 on a Spring trip through northern Ohio. The Eagles fell twice to Akron (2-5, 4-8), split a doubleheader at Cleveland State (1-9 (5), 2-1) and defeated Toledo twice (7-3, 6-2). Junior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** set Morehead State's career strikeout record at CSU with nine K's in the second game, moving her past former MSU pitcher **Kari Quinn** with 357. She ended the week with 365 career punchouts. Gjevre, who went 2-1 with a 0.37 ERA during the trip, already owns the MSU single season mark with 146 and adding to it this year and also has the two top games (15 and 14) in school history. Junior **Bethany Ellis** led the Eagles at the plate with a .444 average and four doubles with four RBI during the week. Junior **Bianca Cardenas** hit .412 for the week. Freshman **Sam Woodall** and **Kayla Brill** each added their four home runs of the season. Morehead State will host Butler for a doubleheader on Tuesday, Eastern Kentucky for a single game on Thursday and travel to Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (12-10 overall, 3-3 OVC): Southeast Missouri defeated Tennessee Tech in the opening contest of a three-game series, 3-2, but dropped the next two (0-13, 1-6). Junior **Alex Ramirez** hit .500 with a 1.000 slugging percentage and a .625 on-base percentage. She reached base safely in all three games. She also hit a home run, scored a pair of runs and drove in two. Freshman pitchers **Giana Zimmerman** went 1-1 last week, striking out 19 in 13.0 innings of action. Sophomore **Nicole Troncoso** batted .375 with two RBI and extended her hitting streak to 12 games. Junior **Elise Sperakos** batted .333 scoring two runs and hitting two doubles. Southeast Missouri will travel to Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (27-6 overall): SIU Edwardsville defeated UIC, 10-9, in eight innings last week. Junior **Lauren Zembruski** went 4-for-5 with three RBI and four runs scored while freshman **Whitney Davis** went 3-for-3 with four RBI. The Cougars will travel to Missouri State for a single game on Thursday before returning home to host Eastern Illinois for doubleheader on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (13-14 overall, 5-4 OVC): Tennessee State took two-of-three from Austin Peay last weekend. Senior **Christy Hill** led the Tigers with a .400 batting average with three runs scored and four RBI. Sophomore pitcher **Caitlin Eaton** picked up the win in the first game against the Lady Govs and hit a home run in the series finale. Tennessee State will travel to Chattanooga on Wednesday before hosting UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (19-16 overall, 7-1 OVC): Tennessee Tech defeated Middle Tennessee, 4-3, before taking two-of-three (2-3, 13-0, 6-1) from Southeast Missouri. Tech hit two grand-slams in one game for the first time in team history and had three against one team in a weekend for the first time as well. The last time the Golden Eagles started out 7-1 in league play they won the OVC regular-season title and the tournament crown. Freshman **Whitney Cummings** hit her first career grand slam versus Southeast Missouri. On the week, she hit .429 with seven RBI, four runs scored two home runs and a double. Sophomore pitcher **Maddie Schmissrauter** went 2-0 with a 0.91 ERA last week. She pitched two complete games including a shutout while striking out 14 in 15.1 innings of work. Tennessee Tech will host UTEP on Tuesday, Western Kentucky on Wednesday and Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

UT MARTIN (18-14 overall, 2-6 OVC): UT Martin dropped both ends of a doubleheader with Jacksonville State last week (6-3, 7-1). After opening the season with the best start in program history, UT Martin has lost its last six consecutive games, which is the longest such streak of the year. The Skyhawks will travel to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
