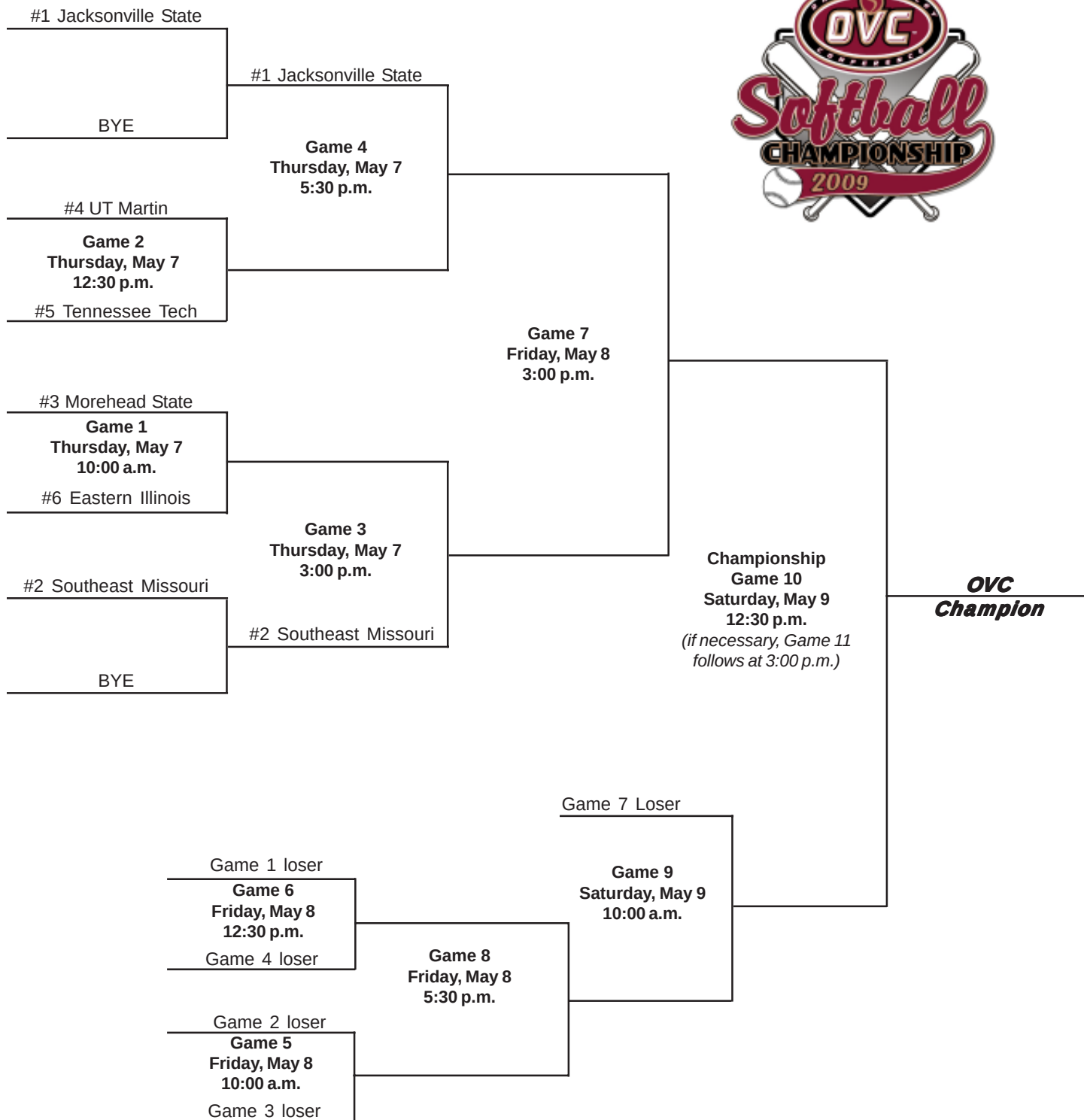

PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Jennifer Vasquez, OF, Jr., Placentia, Calif. - Southeast Missouri

Vasquez recorded a .932 slugging percentage and a .467 on-base percentage as she helped Southeast Missouri to the 15th straight win. She totaled 12 bases with four of her six bases hits for extra bases. Against Tennessee State, she collected multiple hits in all three games. She recorded four putouts while playing every inning in left field. Against EIU, Vasquez recorded an RBI on a sacrifice fly, that RBI would prove to be the game winner. For the week, Vasquez hit .462 with seven RBI and four runs scored.

2009 OVC SOFTBALL TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (15-38 overall, 4-19 OVC): Austin Peay split a doubleheader at Evansville (1-5, 3-2) before taking two of three from Eastern Illinois (7-6 (10), 3-11 (5), 6-5) to conclude the 2009 season. Junior **Brittany Williams** led the Lady Govs with a .375 batting average while stealing four bases. Junior pitcher **Meagan Williams** picked up two wins in relief. **Randal Davenport** was hit by a pitch in the first game of the EIU series, it made the sixth time she was hit by a pitch this year tying a school single-season mark. Austin Peay was walked by opposing pitchers 123 times this year, tying the single-season record. With Brittany Williams (12) and Davenport (11) both finishing in double figures in stolen bases, it marked the first time since 200 that the Lady Govs has two players steal at least 10 bases each.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (25-27 overall, 9-14 OVC): Eastern Illinois finished up the regular-season with four consecutive road games. The Panthers fell to Southeast Missouri (3-8) and went 1-2 against Austin Peay (6-7 (10), 11-3 (5), 5-6). EIU earned the sixth seed in the upcoming OVC Tournament. It will mark the third time in four years that the Panthers have qualified for the tourney under the helm of Kim Schuette. Eastern Illinois will face No. 3 Morehead State on Thursday at 10:00 a.m. CT.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (17-27 overall, 8-13 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to Miami (Ohio) (2-7), No. 18 Louisville (0-7) and went 1-2 against UT Martin (2-7, 0-5, 4-2) to close out the 2009 season. Junior **Shyenne Hussey** hit a two-run walk off home run in the series finale against the Skyhawks. Senior **Kalyn Fox** earned the win over UTM, allowing one run on four hits in three and one-third innings of relief work.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (38-11 overall, 19-2 OVC): Jacksonville State split a twinbill Middle Tennessee (5-6 (10), 9-5) and took two of three from Morehead State (8-0 (5), 2-3, 12-0 (5)) to close out the regular-season. Freshman **Meredith Sellers** hit .400 for the five games and drove in a team-high six runs. She had a three-RBI effort in the first game of the Morehead State series. The Gamecocks earned the top seed and the right to host the OVC Softball tournament. It marks the third time in five years the tourney will be held at Jacksonville State. As the No.1 seed, JSU receives a first-round bye and will play the winner of the UT Martin/Tennessee Tech contest.

MOREHEAD STATE (34-18 overall, 15-9 OVC): Morehead State went 1-2 in the its final regular-season at Jacksonville State, splitting the Saturday doubleheader (0-8, 3-2) before falling 12-0 five innings in the finale. Saturday's win snapped JSU's 14-game home conference winning streak and tied the MSU single season mark for wins with 34. Junior pitcher **Alex Gjevre** won her 24th game in the 3-2 win, pitching a complete game. Freshman **Janelle Givens**, who entered the game with just two career hits, hit her first career home run Saturday, which proved to be the game-winning run. Morehead State captured the third seed for the OVC Tournament and will face No. 6 Eastern Illinois on Thursday at 10:00 a.m. This is the first time MSU has qualified for back-to-back tournament appearances since 1999-2000 when the event went to a six-team tournament.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (27-19 overall, 16-8 OVC): Southeast Missouri defeated Eastern Illinois, 8-3, and took three from Tennessee State (9-1, 4-3, 8-7) to extend its winning streak to a season-best 15 games. It is the longest winning streak since 1998 and is the third longest in school history. Junior **Jennifer Vasquez** hit .462 with four runs scored and seven RBI last week. She also posted a .923 slugging percentage and a .467 on-base percentage. Freshman pitcher **Giana Zimmerman** picked up three wins and a save last week. She has now won her last 10 starts. She struck out 27 while holding opponents to a .159 batting average. Nicole Troncoso batted .533, collecting three multiple hits games including two three-hit efforts. She drove in four runs. **Renee Kertz** extended her hitting streak to four games while also scoring five times and driving in three. **Lauren Bradley** collected a multi-homerun game in her final home contests of her career. **Alex Ramirez** walked five times last week to tie the school record with 28 this season. Southeast Missouri earned the second seed in the OVC Tournament and receives a first-round bye. The Redhawks will face the winners of the Morehead State/Eastern Illinois contests on Friday.

SIU EDWARDSVILLE (40-10 overall): SIU Edwardsville swept doubleheaders with Central Arkansas (1-0, 3-0) and Saint Louis (2-0, 8-0) to give the Cougars 40 wins its first season at Division I. SIUE won its last six games, including shutouts in the last four. Senior **Kailin Colosimo** finished the season with a 19-4 record. She posted a 1.00 earned run average with 152 strikeouts.

TENNESSEE STATE (18-31 overall, 8-15 OVC): Tennessee State concluded the 2009 season with three losses to Southeast Missouri (1-9, 3-4, 7-8) last week. Junior **Bridget Metzger** hit .571 with three RBI and three runs scored. She hit her second home run of the season against Southeast Missouri. In game three of the series, she went 2-for-2 at the plate, with two walks and two RBI.

TENNESSEE TECH (24-29 overall, 10-12 OVC): Tennessee Tech earned the fifth seed in the upcoming OVC Tournament. The Golden Eagles will play No. 4 UT Martin on Thursday at 12:30 p.m. This marks the second straight time Tech has earned the fifth seed for the tourney. The Golden Eagles have advanced to the championship game of the tournament for the last four years.

UT MARTIN (33-21 overall, 13-10 OVC): UT Martin took two of three from Eastern Kentucky (7-2, 5-0, 2-4) last week to close out the regular-season. Junior **Megan Williams** accounted for five runs over the weekend, scoring three and driving in two. Williams' two RBI came in the second game of the series on her fourth home run of the year. Junior **Paij Lintz** tossed a three-hit shutout, striking out a pair in 7.0 innings of work. The Skyhawks returns to the OVC Tournament this year after a one year absence. This is the fifth time that UT Martin enters the tournament as the No. 4 seed. The Skyhawks have set a pair of home run records. As a team, they have launched a program-high home runs on the year and freshman **Jenny Bain** has hit 13 long balls to set a new single-season record. Bain's season home run record breaks the oldest record in UT Martin's history books, one that dated back to 1996.
