Guffey scored 52 of her 64 points this week at the Coors Rocky Mountain Invitational. She was one point shy of tying her career record with 36 points against Colorado State in a come-from-behind victory. Guffey, who earned all-tournament honors for her efforts, scored 21 of her 36 points in the first half versus CSU. She shot 57.9 percent from the field for the week, including going 12-of-18 against CSU. She also had a season-high five rebounds, 12 field goals and five three-pointers versus the Rams.

Hamilton scored in double figures for her fourth and fifth consecutive games last week as she averaged 13.0 points over the two contests. She recorded 4.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.0 assists per outing last week. Hamilton put up 15 points and shot 50 percent from three-point range in the win over Texas-Arlington. Against Marshall, she scored 11 points and grabbed seven rebounds. For the week, she hit six three-pointers and shot 1.000 (4-for-4) percent at the free throw line.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winningest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016)

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay defeated Belmont at home, 49-48, before falling to Miami (64-51) and Chicago State (62-53) in the Miami Thanksgiving Tournament. The Lady Govs were turnover prone the entire week, averaging 28.3 turnovers per game. They averaged just 19.7 turnovers in the season's first three games. Austin Peay made 42.9 percent of its field goals against Miami, snapping a nine game streak where it had not made more than 40 percent of its shots. Senior **April Thomas** was the only player to score more than 10 points in all three games during the week averaging 12.3 points and 7.7 rebounds, including a 13-point, 10-rebounds double-double against Belmont. Junior **Nicole Jamen** was named to the all-tournament team after averaging 11.0 points and 10.0 rebounds over the two games. Austin Peay kicks off Conference play this week as it travels to Southeast Missouri on Thursday and Eastern Illinois on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCSports.TV.

Eastern Illinois went 3-1 last week, beating SMU, 71-65, in overtime and finishing as the runner-up at the Courtyard Marriott Florence Thanksgiving Classic hosted by the University of Cincinnati. The Panthers defeated Savannah State (62-40) and Mississippi Valley State (73-50) before falling to host Cincinnati, 52-47, in the championship game. EIU has now beaten an NCAA Tournament Participant (Miami and SMU) in each of its first two home games and has won nine straight at Lantz Arena. Senior **Megan Edwards** led the team against SMU with 19 points including five three-pointers. The Panthers held Savannah State to 40 points, matching EIU's best defensive effort of the program's OVC era (1997-present). Senior **Rachel Galligan** scored in double-figures in all four games, averaging 14.3 points. She posted an 11-point, 10-rebound performance in the overtime win against SMU.
