THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-PLAYERS

Ta'Kenya Nixon, G • Jr., 5'8 • Michigan City, Ind. • Eastern Illinois

Nixon averaged 17.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals/game as Eastern Illinois split a pair of games. In a home win over Illinois-Chicago, the sophomore scored 19 points on 4-of-8 field goal shooting, but hit 10-of-12 from the free throw line including two with 15 seconds remaining to push the Panthers to the lead and seal the 63-62 victory. She also had five assists and four steals in the victory over UIC. In a road loss to Indiana State to begin the week, Nixon scored 15 points, had eight rebounds, two assists and three steals.

Alex Jones, F • So., 6'1 • Elizabethtown, Ky • Eastern Kentucky

In two games last week, Jones averaged 19.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 steals/game for Eastern Kentucky. In a home victory over West Virginia State, Jones scored 31 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to go along with three steals and a blocked shot. In the game Jones hit 10-of-11 shots from the field and 11-of-15 from the free throw line in 31 minutes of play. In a road loss to Central Arkansas later in the week Jones had eight points, seven rebounds and four assists. For the week the sophomore hit 72.2 percent (13-of-18) from the field.

NEWCOMER

Brittany Darling, C • Jr, 6'5 • Curtice, Ohio • Tennessee Tech

Darling averaged 7.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in a pair of road games last week for Tennessee Tech. In a 56-55 victory over Drake, Darling had 13 points and 10 rebounds in addition to hitting the game-winning shot to give the Golden Eagles the one-point victory. With two seconds left to play, Darling grabbed an offensive rebound and put in the winner off the glass to stun Drake and lift Tech to its fourth road victory of the season. Overall the junior made 6-of-8 (75%) shots in that game. To begin the week she had two points and four rebounds in 12 minutes of action against nationally-ranked Kentucky.

FRESHMAN

Heather Butler, G • Fr., 5'6 • Medina, Tenn. • UT Martin

In three road games against quality competition last week Butler averaged 17.3 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.7 assists/game while hitting all eight of her free throw attempts. She led the Skyhawks in scoring in each game last week, beginning with a 12-point effort at Missouri to begin the week. She then added 20 points at SEC powerhouse Vanderbilt and also in a 63-60 victory over Evansville, the first win for the UTM program over the Purple Aces in 12 years. In that win she added six rebounds, three assists and a steal while hitting 4-of-6 from 3-point range. Butler played all 40 minutes of all three games last week and leads the OVC in minutes played (37.7/ game) this season. She also leads the league in scoring (19.4 points/game).

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

2009-10 in Review: Morehead State was selected to win the 2009-10 title but it was Eastern Illinois who won its first regular-season crown after being predicted to finish the season fourth. The Panthers compiled a 23-11 overall mark and went 16-2 in the OVC to capture the title and the top seed in the league tournament. Eastern Illinois defeated No. 8 Tennessee State, 73-56, in the first round and topped fourth-seeded UT Martin, 65-51, in the semifinals. Third-seeded Austin Peay upset the top-seeded Panthers, 69-60, in the championship game to win its second straight OVC Tournament title. UT Martin's Kevin McMillan was named the OVC Coach of the Year after leading his team to a fourth place finish after being predicted to place 10th. Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman was named the OVC Player of the Year after leading the league with 19.6 points per game. She also broke an OVC single-season record with 121 three-pointers made which is the fourth best single-season total in NCAA Division I history. Eastern Illinois' Ta'Kenya Nixon was named the OVC Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year becoming the first player in league history to earn both honors in the same season. Nixon led the league with 2.1 steals per game while also putting up 14.0 points each time out. The 2009-10 season was the first time the OVC had three teams in the postseason. Austin Peay earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Eastern Illinois earned the conference's WNIT bid. Morehead State was selected to play in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitational.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

Starting with the 2011 tourney, all Eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville.

The bracket also shifts from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). Team Notes

Austin Peay fell to Lipscomb, 63-58, and Bowling Green, 69-42, last week. After entering the week ranked 60th nationally in field-goal percentage, Lady Govs set season lows for field-goal percentage in consecutive games. Against Lipscomb, Austin Peay was held to 31.9 percent from the field and 26.9 percent against BGSU. Austin Peay recorded a season-high 53 rebounds against Lipscomb, including 23 offensive. The Lady Govs followed that with a 40-rebound effort versus the Falcons. APSU has grabbed 40 or more rebounds just three times this season. Junior **Whitney Hanley** led the team with 18 points against Lipscomb while junior **Jasmine Rayner** posted her season's first double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Sophomore **Meghan Bussabarger** ran her streak of double-digit scoring outings to four with a team-best 14 points versus Bowling Green where she also had seven boards. Austin Peay will host Eastern Kentucky on Sunday in a game that can be seen on OVCSports.TV.

Eastern Illinois dropped a 59-50 contest at Indiana State before defeating Illinois-Chicago, 63-62, last week. Sophomore **Ta'Kenya Nixon** recorded 17.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game last week. Against UIC, she had 19 points, including knocking down two free throws with 15 seconds left that gave the Panthers the win. Freshman **Jessica Parker** averaged 7.0 points off the bench last week.
