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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

2009-10 in Review: Morehead State was selected to win the 2009-10 title but it was Eastern Illinois who won its first regular-season crown after being predicted to finish the season fourth. The Panthers compiled a 23-11 overall mark and went 16-2 in the OVC to capture the title and the top seed in the league tournament. Eastern Illinois defeated No. 8 Tennessee State, 73-56, in the first round and topped fourth-seeded UT Martin, 65-51, in the semifinals. Third-seeded Austin Peay upset the top-seeded Panthers, 69-60, in the championship game to win its second straight OVC Tournament title. UT Martin's Kevin McMillan was named the OVC Coach of the Year after leading his team to a fourth place finish after being predicted to place 10th. Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman was named the OVC Player of the Year after leading the league with 19.6 points per game. She also broke an OVC single-season record with 121 three-pointers made which is the fourth best single-season total in NCAA Division I history. Eastern Illinois' Ta'Kenya Nixon was named the OVC Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year becoming the first player in league history to earn both honors in the same season. Nixon led the league with 2.1 steals per game while also putting up 14.0 points each time out. The 2009-10 season was the first time the OVC had three teams in the postseason. Austin Peay earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Eastern Illinois earned the conference's WNIT bid. Morehead State was selected to play in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitational.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

Starting with the 2011 tourney, all Eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville.

The bracket also shifts from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. Austin Peay remained unbeaten in OVC home openers during the **Carrie Daniels** era (5-0) with its 70-60 victory against Eastern Kentucky. The Lady Govs held the Lady Colonels to just 18 first-half goal attempts as they posted a 13-point halftime lead which they held on to for the win. APSU forced ECU into 22 turnovers, its third highest total this season and won the rebounding battle by a solid 47-29 margin. Senior **Darcie Warner** scored 16 first-half points, accounting for half of the Lady Govs opening period. Warner finished the game with 17 points. Junior **Whitney Hanley** grabbed eight rebounds and dished out five assists to go with seven points. Junior **Jasmine Rayner** snapped out of her recent shooting slump with a 5-for-8 shooting effort and finished with 12 points and nine rebounds. Austin Peay will host Morehead State on Tuesday. Jacksonville State fell to Georgia State, 59-47, before snapping its seven-game losing streak with a 62-48 win over Southeast Missouri. The 14-point win marked the largest margin of victory over an OVC foe since a 12-point win over UT Martin in 2008. The Gamecocks recorded a season-best 14 steals in the win, which ranks nine in Jax State's NCAA Division I era. In the last two games, JSU has registered 25 steals after posting 11 at Georgia State. Junior **Brittany Wiley** tallied back-to-back 16-point outings against Georgia State and Southeast Missouri. She also pulled down 14 rebounds for the week. Senior **Zenobia Pitts**, who made her first start of the season versus Southeast Missouri, sparked JSU in the win with her 15 points and seven steals, matching the school single-season record for steals in a game. Team Notes

Morehead State won its fifth straight game with a 62-58 victory over Tennessee State last week. The Eagles trailed the Lady Tigers 54-45 with 7:34 left in the game, but did not allow TSU to hit another field goal as they outscored the Lady Tigers 16-4 down the stretch. Morehead State is now 8-3 in the first 11 games for the second straight year. A win over Austin Peay on Tuesday would give the Eagles only their third start of at least 9-3 since 1981-82. Junior **Courtney Lumpkin** scored a career-high 23 points while sophomore **Ashar Harris** rerecorded her sixth double-double of the season with 12 points and a game-high 13 rebounds. Senior **Chynna Bozeman** hit a trio of three-pointers to give her 298 career triples. She is now tied for 25th on the NCAA Division I career list for three-pointers made. She also had five steals and is now only three away from setting the school record with 199. Morehead State will travel to Austin Peay on Tuesday in a game that can be seen on OVCSports.TV.
